AA. INTERIOR MINISTER MUNONGO RETURNED ELISABETHVILLE FROM KAMINA, HELD PRESS CONFERENCE 9 MARCH, DISTRIBUTED REPORT BY GRAND CHEF KASONGO DIEMBO BLAMING RECENT KAMINA INCIDENT ON UNATIONS AND CHARGING ULTIMATUM DELIVERED BY TELEPHONE, ALSO ASKING JOINT UNATION KATANGA INQUIRY OR, IF UNATIONS UNWILLING, INTERNATIONAL RED CROSS. MUNONGO DELIVERED VIOLENT DIATRIBE AGAINST UNATIONS STATING THEIR AIM WAS TO SABOTAGE ADOULA/TSHOMBE MEETING. HE CHALLENGED ONUC OFFICER IN CHARGE DISPROVE HIS STATEMENTS AND INVITED HIM TO ACCOMPANY HIM TO PLACES CONCERNED TO JUDGE FOR HIMSELF. HE INVITED PRESS CORRESPONDENTS TO FACT FINDING TRIP KOLWEZI, KAMINA, KABONDO KIANDA, BUKAMA, LUENA, LUBUDI, JADOTVILLE, ELISABETHVILLE, ALSO INVITED UNATIONS' PARTICIPATION. WHEN ASKED BY PRESS, CHIEF CIVILIAN OFFICER REPEATED DENIAL ULTIMATUM AND CONFIRMED UNATIONS' VERSION KAMINA INCIDENT.
