UNFICYP 1289 RECEIVED VIA UK MISSION 16 AUGUST 1974.

AT 1600 Hours. Nicosia district. Fighting continues in area of school at WD283924 and road junctions it commands. Artillery, mortar and air strikes continue. Turks have released 99 Greek Cypriot refugees who say they have been held in Turkish sector bound hand and foot without food and water since their capture on 14 August. They also say that a number of young Greek Cypriot girls have been detained in the Turkish sector. UN have protested to Turkish authorities and asked for their release. In Larnaca district Turkish tanks have again entered the British SBA but withdrew to the southwest without incident. Paphos district. There have been allegations that six Turkish Cypriots (not five as previously reported in our 1208 of 14 August) including one child, were murdered by National Guard, not killed during fighting. Similar allegations made by VPO about deaths in Ayios Ioannis (see our 1262). In both cases local National Guard say Eoka B irregulars were involved. UN investigating.

All other districts nothing to report.
