Subject: Training of gendarmes

..... It is an honour to present to you the results of the final exams of the 519 gendarme students whose training course started on 31 July 1995.

On a total of 519 candidates, 516 took the exam. Out of these 516 candidates only 56 didn't get the average pass, which is 50/100.

Due to the efforts provided by these students, the exam commission has proposed to accepted their graduation.

This brings the total number of gendarme students trained by UNAMIR to 922.

Hand-outs in french and in english have been distributed to the students. Also a document compilation of all topics for each training subject is being assembled and will be handed-over to the Chief of Staff of Gendarmerie as soon as possible.

..... It is an honour to present to you the results of the final exams of the 301 gendarme students whose training course started on 19 December 1994.


Out of the 301 candidates only 10 didn't get the average pass, which is 10/20.
