1. FOLLOWING RECEIVED FROM NEW YORK : QUOTE . FOLLOWING NOTE DATED 26 JAN. FROM UK. QUOTE THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO THE UNITED NATIONS PRESENTS HIS COMPLIMENTS TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS AND HAS THE HONOUR TO REFER TO HIS NOTE VERBALE OF THE 13TH OF DECEMBER, 1961, IN WHICH HE REQUESTED ANY INFORMATION WHICH THE UNITED KINGDOM GOVT MAY HAVE ABOUT CERTAIN NON-CONGOLESE MILITARY PERSONEL IN KATANGA.

THE LIST ENCLOSED WITH THE SECRETARY-GENERAL'S NOTE INCLUDED SIX MEN STATED TO BE OF BRITISH NATIONALITY. AFTER CHECKING WITH THE PASSPORT OFFICE IN LONDON, IT HAS BEEN POSSIBLE TO CONFIRM THAT EDWARD LEWIS RETALLICK IS IN FACT A BRITISH SUBJECT. HE WAS BORN ON THE 26TH OF MAY, 1927, AT HERTFORD ENGLAND, AND WAS ISSUED WITH A PASSPORT (No D 163449) IN SALISBURY, SOUTHERN RHODESIA, IN 1959.

THE PASSPORT OFFICE HAVE NO TRACE OF HERBERT POMFRET OR OF VOLLARD.

WITHOUT FURTHER DETAILS AND CHRISTIAN NAMES THE PASSPORT OFFICE CANNOT BE CERTAIN ABOUT MICHALSKI SINCE THERE ARE MANY MEN OF THIS NAME. IF THE UNITED NATIONS WERE ABLE TO PROVIDE FURTHER DETAILS, THE PASSPORT OFFICE WOULD WILLINGLY SEARCH THEIR RECORDS.

THERE REMAIN WRENACRE AND WICKSTEED/. ACCORDING TO THE INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO THE UNITED KINGDOM GOVERNMENT, WRENACRE WAS KILLED IN SEPTEMBER IN THE COURSE OF THE FIGHTING IN KATANGA. AS REGARDS WICKSTEED, THE RHODESIAN FEDERAL IMMIGRATION AUTHORITIES WERE SOME WHILE AGO ALERTED SO THAT HIS PASSPORT MIGHT BE WITHDRAWN ON HIS NEXT VISIT TO THE FEDERATION. WICKSTEED LANDED AT NDOLA ON JANUARY 13, HAVING FILED A FLIGHT PLAN TO JOHANNESBURG VIA SALISBURY. ON THAT OCCASION THE RHODESIAN FEDERAL IMMIGRATION AUTHORITIES ASKED HIM TO SURRENDER HIS PASSPORT BUT HE REPLIED THAT AS AIRCREW HE DID NOT NORMALLY CARRY A PASSPORT BUT THAT HE WOULD RETURN TO KATANGA TO OBTAIN IT. HE ACCORDINGLY CANCELLED HIS ONWARD FLIGHT AND RETURNED TO KIPUSHI. HE HAD NOT RE-ENTERED THE FEDERATION BY JANUARY 16, THE DATE OF THE LATEST REPORT ON THIS SUBJECT WHICH THE UNITED KINGDOM GOVERNMENT HAVE RECEIVED FROM THEIR HIGH COMMISSIONER IN SALISBURY . UNQUOTE.

ABOVE INFORMATION SHOULD BE ADDED TO RELEVANT PARAS OF LISTS OF FOREIGN MILITARY PRESUMED TO BE STILL AT LARGE IN YOUR AND RAJAS POSSESSION (TWO EXTRA COPIES TAKEN TO EVILLE BY DUMONTET FOR HIS OWN USE TODAY). WE HAVE NO FURTHER INFORMATION RE POMFRET AND VOLLARD APART FROM DETAILS ON LISTS. AS REGARDS MICHALSKI (PARA 111 OF LISTS), HE IS ALSO LISTED BY MIL.INFO. AS STATELESS OF POLISH ORIGIN. WAS REPORTED TO BE ONE OF THREE FOREIGN OFFICERS FROM BUKAMA WHO TOOK TRAIN TO KAMINAVILLE WITH VIEW TO SURRENDERING TO ONUC AT KAMINA IN EARLY SEPTEMBER. HOWEVER MICHALSKI NEVER IN FACT SURRENDERED

The following officers will constitute the United Nations members of the Joint Commission decided upon to work with representatives of the Katangese Gendarmerie for the general purpose of relieving tension in Elisabethville city:

- (a) Lt. Col. Ryan, 36th Irish Battalion
- (b) Major Dhar, Indian Brigade Headquarters
- (c) Capt. Mulatu, Ethiopian I.O.
- (d) Lt. von Bayer, Swedish I.O.

As indicated in the Secretary-General's cable No. 819, the Commission should be kept as informal as possible and should be confined strictly to local situations and to the military level. Nevertheless, the closest liaison should be maintained with the Civilian Representative in Elisabethville on all aspects of the Commission's work.

The explicit reason for setting up this Commission is to reduce tension in Elisabethville in an attempt to return life in the city to normal as quickly as possible.

We should, at this stage, be in a position to withdraw our troops from many of the trenches and similar positions which they now occupy. They are suffering considerable hardship by having to live indefinitely in these conditions and the time is now opportune to move them into permanent accommodation. This can be accomplished for the two-fold purpose of:

- (a) improving the lot of our troops, and
- (b) making a 'concession' to Tshombe and the Gendarmerie.


This latter gesture could be used for bargaining purposes.

It is not my intention to surrender any single one of the positions we now occupy in Elisabethville, but I consider that the troops can be moved from many of the positions they man at present to a nearby location from which they can be summoned at short notice if necessary to man what we may regard as their battle stations, that is, the positions they now occupy.

The fullest use of these exchanges with the Gendarmerie Officers should be made in order to acquire detailed information about the Gendarmerie, that is, their present strengths, locations, activities, armament and equipment, and their command set-up.

Every effort should be made during these exchanges to improve relations between the Katangese Armed Forces and the United Nations Force in Elisabethville for the aforesaid purposes. Only existing tensions should be discussed and it should be clearly understood that any arrangement made with the Gendarmerie is subject to ratification from this Headquarters.

The matter of giving technical aid may not be discussed for the time being. This aspect of assistance to the Gendarmerie will naturally have to be first discussed with the appropriate Central Government authorities. I shall be grateful for a report on the outcome of each of your meetings with the Gendarmerie representatives.

WE HAVE FOUND THAT THIRD NAME ON LIST, PEVENAGE ROGER, BELGIAN, DESCRIBED AS BCK RAILWAY WORKER, BORN 11 MARCH 1930, PASSPORT G 478730, ALLOWED TRANSIT LIVINGSTONE ON 8 JANUARY DESTINATION PRESUMABLY KATANGA, IS SAME PERSON AS PEVENAGE ROGER NIEDOS (SURNAME FIRST) BELGIAN VOLUNTEER IN KATANGA GENDARMERIE GARRISON AT LUENA WHERE HELD RANK OF ADJT CHIEF UNTIL HE SURRENDERED TO ONUC ON 2 SEPTEMBER 1961 AND WAS REPATRIATED FROM KAMINA TO BRUSSELS ON 7 SEPTEMBER 1961, UNDER PARA A2 SECCO RESOLUTION. DETAILS ON ABOVE MENTIONED LIST CAME UNOFFICIALLY FROM BRITISH EMBASSY HERE WHICH CONTACTED LIVINGSTONE IMMIGRATION AUTHORITIES. GENDARMERIE CAREER AND OTHER DETAILS REVEALED IN FILE ESTABLISHED BY MILITARY INFORMATION AFTER INTERROGATION OF PEVENAGE AT KAMINA PRIOR REPATRIATION. THERE IS NO DOUBT ABOUT IDENTIFICATION OF PERSON CONCERNED. BOTH SOURCES QUOTE SAME NAME, DATE OF BIRTH, AND PASSPORT NUMBER.

2. WISH ALSO TO MENTION ANOTHER CASE OF EXPELLED MERCENARY'S RETURN TO KATANGA. THIS IS CASE OF DE GREEF, JACQUES, BELGIAN, REPATRIATED FROM EVILLE BY ONUC ON 4 SEPTEMBER 1961 BUT BACK IN KATANGA AT NZILO III ECOLE DES SOUS-OFFICIERS AB AT 6 OCTOBER 1961. OUR EVIDENCE IS AN

1. ANC from Stan approached Kongolo 29 Dec, did not make direct attack on town but bombarded with mortar fire which caused little damage and few casualties and which continued sporadically throughout night 29/30.
2. On 30 Dec Katanga gendarmes (approximately 1800) withdrew gradually and ANC did not enter until 31st. During period of gendarmes' withdrawal, various tribal groups within town fought amongst themselves and possibly up to 100 Congolese were killed.
3. ANC entered Kongolo 31st starting immediately to pillage, loot and rape. Entire civilian population fled except inmates of Mission then composed of 19 Belgian fathers, one Dutch father, one Dutch brother, one French doctor, one Belgian trader, 2 or 3 Congolese fathers, some 30 Congolese nuns and some 30 Congolese seminarians.
4. At 2.30 p.m. ANC tried to arrest Europeans in the Mission but this did not take place because of disagreements among various ANC elements. At 3.30 p.m. ANC returned to Mission and took everyone to military camp. Europeans were placed in cells and Africans kept under guard in other buildings. At mid-night a lorry was brought by ANC on top of which a bed had been made and some soldiers tried to rape senior nuns but were prevented from doing so by other ANC.

5. On morning 1 Jan small group of ANC, apparently drunk and drugged, interrogated Europeans and beat them after having stripped them in front of nuns and seminarists and ^{thereafter} ^{then} returned to cells.
6. At 9.30 a.m. one ANC NCO and four soldiers dragged Europeans from their cells and only two of the four ANC, using machine guns/automatic rifles, shot them. ANC then allowed Balubakat Jeunesse to cut bodies and transport pieces to river in which they were thrown.
7. Father Jules Garnon who was in last cell was protected by other ANC claiming they wanted to interrogate him further because he knew where white mercenaries were hidden.
8. At 2 p.m. Pakassa arrived, prevented Garnon from being further questioned and shot and moved him following day to better accommodation. Two days later Pakassa returned Garnon to Mission. Pakassa also arranged for release of all sisters and seminarists.
9. It is believed NCO and 4 ANC, who were responsible for murder of 22 Europeans, are known to Pakassa and Major Baba. Pakassa had sufficient authority to prevent continuation of murders but not enough to take disciplinary action. ANC Sgt. Augustin, wireless operator at ANC HQ Kongolo, is most likely person to identify culprits if sufficient protection is given him. Congolese fathers stated their belief, from talks with ANC, atrocities occurred because of anti-European pep talk given to the soldiers by Lundula.
10. Since 1 Jan Balubakat Jeunesse and some ANC made numerous attempts to arrest Garnon and were prevented in each case from doing so by Baba and Pakassa. Pakassa also reported to have saved lives of three priests who had been wounded in Lubunda Mission and were taken to Kasongo hospital. Pakassa also gave orders if missionaries who fled after Sola Mission was destroyed should return, they must not be harmed.

11. When in Kongala Lawson was given following which he believes is false from ANC : "Civilian population fled six months ago because of atrocities by Katanga gendarmes. Europeans killed by retreating gendarmes on 30 Dec and ANC buried bodies".

12. Other erroneous version states missionaries were fighting with gendarmes against ANC.

13. At present following troops are in Kongala ;

(a) Small HQ commanded by Major Gaba with direct wireless to Stan only

(b) 2 Coy, 19th battalion

(c) 2 Coy, 16th battalion

(d) 1 Coy, 12th battalion

Above troops completely undisciplined, poorly equipped but with sufficiency of ammunition.

No real coordination in between these coys appear to exist. Main activity would seem to be looting and burning.

Reinforcements now arriving into Kongala by Air Congo from 5th Battalion.

14. Some 100 Balubakete now in Kongala claiming to be "Civil Army of Region" mostly armed with bows and arrows, not poisoned. People in Mission terrified of these and even ANC nervous of their presence. If ANC should leave it is feared this group would murder all present occupants of Mission.

15. Kongala practically destroyed with stacks of loot in houses occupied by ANC some of which sent back already along line to Stan. African section of town looks as if hit by hurricanes. ANC becoming restless desirous to move on to pillage and loot further.

16. Present inmates of Mission in great danger and should be evacuated. This considered hazardous because of likely strong opposition from Balubaket.

17. ~~The~~ ^{only} airfield can take OC3s with full load ~~only~~ but ground very soft because of heavy rains.
18. Lawson does not recommend stationing ONUC troops in Kongala ^{as} and their upkeep there would prove difficult.
19. It was through wireless operator Lawson learned of Father Darnon being still alive. Lawson requested Gaba's permission to take him along back to Stan on board the first Air Congo plane which arrived 23 Jan. Gaba agreed and both Lawson and Darnon immediately left. Because of radio difficulty pilot decided to land at Unamkura where they stayed over night. Following morning plane flew to Kindu as pilot had been ordered to do.
20. Early morning 24th a UN A/C was sent to Kindu, landed safely and took Lawson and Father Darnon back to Léo via Lulu.
21. Other info collected by Lawson during his expedition which he could not confirm:
- (a) ANC in North Katanga all from 3rd Groupement divided into three groups based at Kasongo, Kongala and Ayille with no inter-communication but only direct contact to Stan;
 - (b) Kindu garrison from 20th battalion commanded by a Lieutenant;
 - (c) Kindu situation potentially dangerous because of tension caused by transit of troops and attitude of Stan authorities against Europeans. Kindu fathers report they have been threatened by transitting ANC who have declared they will massacre them in same way as those of Kongala. Because no civil a/c presently landing at Kindu there is great shortage of food supplies and other essentials.
22. Lawson confirms names of murdered Europeans as given up to and including No 16 in our L-164. Others are : Father Walter Eillyne (Dutch); Fathers Théodore Schildermans and Joseph Postelmans (both Belgian); Brother Bernulphs (Dutch); Dr. Marseu (French); Trader Melkebeek (Belgian).

1. As previously proposed by Urquhart and endorsed by Liner International Committee of Red Cross and Unations have jointly designated very high level commission of inquiry into all circumstances of death in Elisabethville of Red Cross Delegate Olivet and companions. Commission is composed of Judge Björn Kjellin, President of Court of Appeal of Malmö Sweden as Chairman, Professor Leopold Breitenacker, Director of Institute of Forensic Medicine Vienna and President of International Society of Forensic Medicine and Colonel Roost, Swiss ballistic expert.
 2. I request you instruct ONUC Elisabethville to furnish every possible administrative and evidentiary assistance. You should impress upon all civilian and military personnel concerned the urgency of full cooperation with Commission for protecting Geneva Convention emblem and ambulances and consequent necessity of producing any witnesses or items of evidence requested. Since ONUC and Member States are committed to principles of Geneva Conventions only by frank cooperation can the good name of Unations and Member States concerned be protected.
 3. Commission will hold preliminary session for few days in Geneva to work out terms of reference and financial and administrative arrangements. Spinelli will notify you directly of size of party and ETA Elisabethville. We hope secretarial and verbatim reporting assistance can be supplied by European Office. We realize and have reminded Spinelli of limitations in present circumstances on facilities ONUC can provide in Eville. If at all possible it would be desirable for ONUC to furnish housing for

Commission members in order to relieve them of too frequent and prejudicial approaches from some elements of local population. ICRC Representative in Bville may be able to assist.

4. Agreement with Red Cross provides for designation by each party of Observer to attend Commission proceedings. In view of his previous acquaintance with this case and his negotiations with ICRC Vice-President I hope you can name Urquhart for this purpose, particularly as period of inquiry should not extend beyond his remaining stay there.

HAVE CONSULTED SENIOR MEMBERS OF SECRETARIAT ON THESE MATTERS. THERE IS AMONG THEM FULL AGREEMENT THAT AN EFFORT SHOULD BE MADE TO DO SOMETHING ON BEHALF OF SURVIVORS OF ONUC TROOPS WHOSE LIVES HAVE BEEN LOST IN ELISABETHVILLE AND ELSEWHERE IN THE COURSE OF THE OPERATION. THE SECRETARY-GENERAL HAS NAMED A COMMITTEE TO PROPOSE WAYS AND MEANS OF TAKING EFFECTIVE ACTION.
