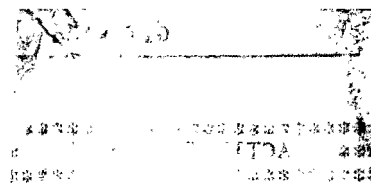

A. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED RUTSIRO GR (3989) AND MUHIRA GR (3886) SITUATION IN GENERAL IS CALM .THE TEAM VISITED THE TWO DISPENSARIES IN RUTSIRO THEY HAVE INADEQUATE FOOD STOCKS .

B. SECOND MILOB TEAM VISITED MUTUNTU GR (3653) SITUATION CALM ALTHOUGH LOCAL ARE LIVING IN FEAR .THE TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT ONE LOCAL WAS ARRESTED THIS WEEK BECAUSE HIS BROTHER WHOM THEY INTENDED TO ARREST WAS ABSENT. THE TEAM FURTHER LEARNED THAT ON 20 MAY 95 RPA SOLDIERS BROKE INTO A SHOP IN MUTUNTU AND TOOK AWAY AN DISCLOSED AMOUNT OF MONEY FROM THE WIFE OF THE SHOP OWNER .THEY PROMISED TO COME BACK .

THE MILOB TEAM IN MUTUNTU WAS FURTHER INFORMED THAT RPA SOLDIERS WHO WERE ARMED MADE AWAY WITH ONE MILLION FRANCS FROM A LOCAL OF GAKUTA SECTOR OF GISOVU COMMUNE THREE WEEKS AGO .THE MATTER WILL BE INVESTIGATED FURTHER .

There they spoke to the staff and this covered a 43 year's old lady who had been shot by the RPA. apparently they were doing a house search in NGOMA for interahamwe and she fled out the back of the house when they entered. as it was dark they saw a person end living and fired. once they realised it was a woman they took her to the hospital for treatment. This will be investigated further.

ONE FOOT PATROL IN KIBUYE NOTICED A SMALL CALIBRE ARTILLERY PIECE AT GR 263726. IT APPEARS TO BE A ZU-1. IT IS NOT SITED AND UNDER A TARP. NO AMMUNITION WAS SEEN AND IT WAS UNDER TARP SO EXACT TYPE IS NOT KNOWN.

ONCE AGAIN OUR PATROLLING WAS SEVERELY HAMPERED AS WE ONLY HAD ONE VEHICLE TO PATROL.

A. THIS PATROL WENT SOUTH TO RWAMATAMU COMMUNE, BUTEMBO SECTOR(1155). AT 250030 MAY 95 APPROXIMATELY TEN BOATS WITH AT LEAST A TOTAL OF THIRTY PEOPLE LANDED AND EXCHANGED GUNFIRE WITH THE LOCAL RPA. IT IS UNSURE AS TO WHAT THEIR AIM WAS BUT AS THEY LANDED WITH WEAPONS IT CAN BE ASSUMED THAT IT WAS NOT BANDITRY. APPARENTLY THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES ON EITHER SIDE AND THE ATTACK WAS SUCCESSFULLY DEFENDED BY THE RPA.

THE SAME VILLAGERS REPORTS THAT THERE ARE APPROXIMATELY TWO LANDINGS A WEEK IN THIS AREA. DURING SOME OF THESE LANDINGS THE VILLAGERS REPORT THAT SOME OF THOSE LANDING ARE WEARING UNIFORMS.

A. ONE PATROL WENT TO GISOVU(2952) IN GISOVU COMMUNE. THE PREFECT WAS ADDRESSING THE PEOPLE OF MABUGA(2463)(SEE BELOW). AT THE COMMUNE HEADQUARTERS THE BOURGEMEISTER SPOKE TO THE MILOBS AND GAVE A RATHER ROSY PICTURE OF THE AREA. HE SAID THERE ARE NO ARRESTS AND PEOPLE ARE HAPPY. THE PEOPLE, HOWEVER, PAINT A DIFFERENT PICTURE.

THERE ARE 10 RETURNEES FROM KIBEHO IN THIS COMMUNE

B. A SECOND TEAM WENT TO NYARABUYE(3567) AND GITESI(2871). THE TEAM FOUND THE AREAS CALM BUT THE PEOPLE ARE STILL HARASSED BY RPA AND THEIR LIVESTOCK IS STOLEN. THEY ALSO SAID THE HARVEST WILL NOT BE SUFFICIENT IN THEIR AREAS AND THEY WILL NEED ASSISTANCE IN THIS MATTER.

IN GITESI THERE IS A SEVERE LACK OF DRINKING WATER. ICRC WILL BE SPOKEN TO REGARDING THIS PROBLEM.

5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES: 40 IDPS IN NYABISHABA CAMP WERE MOVED TO BWAKIRA COMMUNE BY UNHCR.

12 IDPS WERE MOVED TO GISOVU COMMUNE FROM CYANGUGU TODAY.

6. CIVILIAN AFFAIRS: THE PREFECT AND SOUS-PREFECT FROM GITESI COMMUNE SPOKE TO THE PEOPLE OF MABUGA(2463). THE SUBJECT OF THEIR TALK WAS RECONCILIATION AND SECURITY ALONG THE LAKE.

7. LOGISTICS : UNAMIR VEH'S 1080, 1071, 1051, 1082, 1069 AND 1278 ARE IN THE WORKSHOP AWAITING MAINTENANCE/REPAIR. COMMUNICATION IN CHANNEL 10 IS FUNCTIONING BUT WE WOULD OBVIOUSLY PREFER TO HAVE OUR OWN CHANNEL AS BEFORE.

SUBJECT: SITREP COVERING PERIOD 211800 TO 221800 MAY 95.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE SITUATION IS CALM ALTHOUGH FEAR AND APPREHENSION OF INSECURITY PREVAILS AMONG THE LOCALS IN THE PREFECTURE AS BEFORE.

4. OWN ACTIVITIES.

A. ONE JOINT MILOB/HR PATROL WENT SOUTH TO THE COMMUNES OF GISOVU AND RWAMATAMU. THE MAJORITY OF THE INFORMATION WAS GATHERED FROM THE SECTOR CHIEF OF MUGOZI SECTOR(1857), LEONARD HITIMDNA.

SINCE THE BOURGEMEISTER OF RWAMATAMU HAD HIS VEHICLE ACCIDENT(THREE WEEKS AGO) THE HUTU POPULATION HAS FELT VERY THREATENED. THE RPA ARE IN CONTROL AND DO AS THEY WISH. YESTERDAY AN RPA SOLDIER NAMED TADDE BADLY BEAT A CITIZEN BECAUSE HE REFUSED TO ACCUSE THE SECTOR CHIEF, HITIMDNA, OF GENOCIDE. MILOBS SAW THE BEATEN INDIVIDUAL AND THE EVIDENCE OF A SEVERE BEATING, COMPLETE WITH ROPE MARKS AROUND THE NECK, WERE VISIBLE.

FOUR OTHER INDIVIDUALS WERE ARRESTED LAST WEEK, ALL ACCUSED OF GENOCIDE.

HE ALSO STATED THAT EVERY HUTU IN THE AREA IS WAITING TO BE ARRESTED. THERE ARE CONSTANT BEATINGS BUT THE PEOPLE ARE BEING REFUSED ENTRANCE DUE TO THE RPA GUARDS POSTED OUTSIDE.

B. A SECOND JOINT MILOB/HR PATROL WENT EAST TO THE COMMUNE OF BWAKIRA. THERE MAIN THRUST WAS TO MEET THE BOURGEMEISTER IN BWAKIRA BUT HE WAS QUITE ELUSIVE THROUGHOUT THE DAY (THREE DIFFERENT EXCUSES WERE GIVEN, ALL OF WHICH SEEMED QUITE UNLIKELY).

THERE ARE TWO RETURNEES FROM KIBEHO; THE MAN HAS BEEN ARRESTED AND THE WOMEN HAS NOT. AT KALINDA HOSPITAL THERE ARE TWO PRISONERS, ACCUSED OF RAPE, THAT WERE SEVERELY BEATEN BY THE COMMUNAL POLICE.

THE SECTOR CHIEF FROM MUGUNDA (3088) THAT WAS ARRESTED HAS BEEN RELEASED BUT HE IS NO LONGER THE SECTOR CHIEF.

THE PRIEST FROM THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN BWAKIRA THAT WAS BEATEN ARRESTED AND ACCUSED OF GENOCIDE, HAS BEEN RELEASED.

C. A THIRD PATROL WENT NORTH TO THE TOWN OF RUTONDE (5880). THERE THEY SPOKE WITH THE SECTOR CHIEF WHO INFORMED HIM THAT THERE WERE NO MORE BEATINGS, ARRESTS OR HARASSMENT OF LOCALS. THE LOCALS TOLD ANOTHER STORY. THE LOCALS ARE STILL BEING TOLD NOT TO TALK TO UNAMIR FOR FEAR OF BEATINGS. LAST WEEK THERE WERE SOME ARRESTS (NUMBER UNCONFIRMED). AN RPA SOLDIER, FROM THE AREA BUT POSTED IN RUHENGARI, HAS BEEN RETURNING TO THE AREA, STEALING LIVESTOCK AND SELLING IT.

5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES: TOMORROW, THE IDPS IN NYABISHABA CAMP WILL BE MOVED TO BWAKIRA COMMUNE.

THE OTHER INCIDENT INVOLVED A WOMEN WHO WAS APPARENTLY MARRIED TO A HUTU WHO FLED TO ZAIRE. THE RPA SAID SHE HAD TO DIVIDE HER BELONGINGS BETWEEN HER AND THE MAN'S GIRLFRIEND/SECOND WIFE(UNCLEAR). SHE REFUSED AND WAS BEATEN. SHE IS NOW IN THE MURUNDA HOSPITAL AND HER BELONGINGS HAVE SUBSEQUENTLY BEEN DIVIDED.

NO CHANGE IN THE STATUS OF FIVE IDP CAMPS WHICH ARE EXISTING SINCE BEFORE THE WAR. AT THE TIME OF WRITING THIS SITREP NO OTHER PATROL HAS REPORTED BACK. SECTOR HQ IS PRESENTLY ENGAGED IN RECOVERY OF THE STOLEN VEHICLE 1069. DETAILED REPORT AND SITREP AS WELL WILL BE FORWARDED BY SECTOR HQ LATER.

- B. ONE MILOB TEAM ATTENDED THE RE-BURIAL CEREMONY IN BWAKIRA COMMUNE . THE MILOB TEAM DISCOVERED THAT A BUS BOGGED DOWN IN THE SLUSH HAD BLOCKED THE ROAD FROM RUGABANO GR(4266) TO BIRAMBO GR (4673) AT A BRIDGE GR (4366) AND THAT ONLY SMALL VEHICLES AND

PEDESTRIANS COULD PASS .THE MILOB TEAM REPORTED THAT IT COULD NOT PROCEED TO MUTUNTU GR (3552)AS THE ROAD WAS IN BAD CONDITION OWING TO HEAVY RAINS LAST NIGHT.SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM IN THE COMMUNE.

C. SECOND MILOB TEAM PATROLLED KIVUMU COMMUNE SITUATION IS CALM .THE TEAM LEARNT THAT RPA ARRESTED FIVE PEOPLE ON 11 MAY 95 IN GASEVE SECTOR IN 5579 .THE REASONS FOR THEIR ARREST COULD NOT BE ESTABLISHED. THE TEAM COULD NOT REACH RUTONDE SECTOR GR(5880) AS THE BRIDGE AT GR (5278) HAD COLLAPSED OWING TO HEAVY RAINS .

D. OUR VEHICLE UNAMIR 1069 WAS SNATCHED AT GUNPOINT ON THE WAY FROM GITARAMA TO KIBUYE BY RPA AT 1345 HOURS. TWO MOTOROLA HANDSETS WHICH WERE IN THE VEHICLE ARE REPORTED MISSING. HOWEVER THE VEHICLE HAS SINCE BEEN RECOVERED BY GITARAMA MILOB TEAM.

E. ONE TEAM PATROLLED THE AREA OF RUTUNGURA IN 3275. ONE WOMAN WAS BEATEN TO DEATH REPORTEDLY BY A CRIMINAL LAST EVENING WHO HAS SINCE BEEN ARRESTED AND DETAINED AT MABANZA PRISON. THE TEAM ALSO PATROLLED THE AREA OF RUKARAGATA 1955 AND REPORTED SITUATION CALM APART FROM SHORTAGE OF FOOD.

F. TRANSPORTED RELIEF MAIZE FROM GITESI COMMUNE TO MABANZA.

5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES: CARITAS AND ICRC VISITED KIBUYE PRISON AND DISCOVERED THAT THEY HAD NO FIREWOOD FOR COOKING AT THE PRISON .MILOBS HQ HAS MADE ARRANGEMENTS TO PROVIDE FUEL FOR CARITAS VEHICLE TO FERRY FIREWOOD TO THE PRISON.

6. CIVILIAN AFFAIRS: NTR.

7. LOGISTICS : UNAMIR VEH'S 1080, 1071, 1051, 1082, AND 1278 ARE IN THE WORKSHOP AWAITING MAINTENANCE/REPAIR. COMMUNICATION IN CHANNEL 10 IS FUNCTIONING BUT WE WOULD OBVIOUSLY PREFER TO HAVE OUR OWN CHANNEL AS BEFORE.



UN RESTRICTEDSITUATION BRIEF3A MILOB GPINTRODUCTION

DURING THIS BRIEF THE FOLLOWING POINTS WILL BE COVERED:

- A. OVERALL SITUATION
- B. HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE OFFERED BY UNAMIR TO LOCAL ADMINISTRATION
- C. THE ANALYSIS OF FUTURE IN THE COMING MONTHS.

OVERALL SITUATION

THIS BRIEF COVERS THE PERIOD OF 06 APRIL TO PRESENT.

THE OVERALL SITUATION IN THIS PREFECTURE REMAINS CALM BUT TENSE. THE NUMBER OF OVERALL ARRESTS HAS DECREASED RECENTLY; HOWEVER, IT SEEMS THAT MORE INFLUENTIAL INDIVIDUALS ARE NOW BEING TARGETED(I.E. TEACHERS, MEDICAL STAFF AND LOCAL ADMINISTRATORS IN THE COMMUNES AND SECTORS). IN ADDITION THE NUMBER OF KILLINGS HAS ALSO DECREASED.

THE ISSUE OF PRISONS IS STILL A GROWING CONCERN. PRESENTLY THERE ARE 1112 INMATES IN THE KIBUYE PRISON AND THE NUMBER OF PRISONERS IN THE LOCAL JAILS IS ALSO QUITE ALARMING. WHILE WE HAVE BEEN GIVEN ACCESS TO THREE OF THE PRISONS WE ARE DENIED ACCESS TO THE SMALLER PRISONS IN THE COMMUNES. ICRC AND HUMAN RIGHTS ARE ALSO HAVING DIFFICULTIES IN THIS AREA: ICRC IN LOCATING SOME OF THE SMALLER PRISONS (SMALLER THAN COMMUNE) AND HUMAN RIGHTS IN GAINING ACCESS TO COMMUNE PRISONS.

THE FUNCTIONING OF THE SMALL NUMBER OF NGOs IN THIS PREFECTURE HAS BEEN FURTHER HAMPERED BY SEARCHES OF THEIR PREMISES AND THE THEFT OF THEIR VEHICLES. BOTH OF THESE ACTS ARE BEING PERPETRATED BY THE RPA. WHILE THIS HAS HAD AN OBVIOUS NEGATIVE EFFECT ON THEIR ABILITIES AND PERFORMANCE IT HAS BROUGHT THEM CLOSER TO THE MILOBS AND THE MALAWI COY. THEY EAGERLY ATTEND OUR SECURITY BRIEFINGS AND THIS HAS HELPED IN COORDINATION OF THE SUPPORT WE CAN PROVIDE THEM.

HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE PROVIDED BY UNAMIR

DURING THE LAST MONTH WE HAVE PROVIDED SUPPORT TO LOCAL INFRASTRUCTURE AS THE PREVIOUS REQUEST TO UNAMIR HQ HAS BEEN TIME CONSUMING AND, IN THE END, QUITE FRUITLESS.

WE HAD REQUESTED SOME ROAD WORK TO BE DONE IN THE AREA OF KIVUMU(5573) TO INCREASE MOBILITY OF THE NGOS AND THE LOCALS. A RECCE WAS DONE SOME WEEKS AFTER THE REQUEST AND NOTHING HAS TRANSPIRED SINCE. THE SAME HAD HAPPENED AT THE LOCAL ORPHANAGE WHERE A RECCE WAS CARRIED OUT BUT NO FOLLOW UP WAS DONE. WE END UP LOOKING QUITE EMBARRASSED.

SOME SUPPORT WE HAVE PROVIDED:

- USING MALAWI TRUCKS, MILOBS HAVE COORDINATED THE TRANSPORT OF FOODSTUFFS FOR WFP. THIS WAS DONE IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE BOURGEMEISTERS AND THE PREFECT WHO WERE COMPLAINING OF SLOW MOVEMENT OF FOOD. APPROXIMATELY 30 TONNES OF FOOD HAS BEEN MOVED RECENTLY
- WE ARE ALSO COORDINATING THE REPAIRING OF THE GITARAMA-KIBUYE ROAD. WE HAVE ORGANIZED LOCALS IN KIVUMU TO SPREAD GRAVEL PROVIDED BY FORCE ENGINEER COY.
- WE TRANSPORT LOCAL ADMINISTRATORS AROUND THEIR COMMUNES AND SECTORS.
- WE TRY TO GET INVOLVED WITH LOCAL CULVERT REPAIR WORK IN THE TOWN OF KIBUYE.

ASSESSMENT OF THE PRESENT SITUATION AND FOR THE FUTURE

THE PRESENT SECURITY SITUATION IN THIS PREFECTURE HAS CHANGED SINCE 06 APRIL. WHILE THE RECONCILIATION THAT IS PREACHED BY THE GOVERNMENT IS NOT MATERIALIZING THE RAMPANT ARRESTS HAVE DECREASED. THE HUTU POPULATION HONESTLY FEEL THAT RECONCILIATION IS NOT REQUIRED BECAUSE THE FRGF WILL RETURN AND SAVE THEM FROM WHAT THEY SEE AS OBVIOUS PERSECUTION AND HARASSMENT AT THE HANDS OF THE TUTSI RPA. THE RPA ALSO FEEL A GENUINE HATE TOWARDS ANYONE WHO MAY HAVE POSSIBLY AIDED IN THE GENOCIDE AND THE ONLY SOLUTION FOR THEM IS DEATH. WITH THESE TWO PREMISES THE ONLY POSSIBLE RESULT IS FURTHER UNREST WHICH AT SOME TIME WILL BOIL OVER. IN THE MEAN TIME, SHOULD THE FRGF DECIDE TO RETURN, THEY WILL HAVE GREATFUL COMPLIANCE FROM THE VAST MAJORITY OF THIS PREFECTURE.

REGARDING THE SUSPENSION OF AID THAT HAS ARISEN AS A RESULT OF THE KIBEHO INCIDENT, WE THINK THE RPA WILL ATTEMPT TO PROJECT A MORE FAVOURABLE IMAGE THROUGHOUT THE PREFECTURE AND COUNTRY IN AN EFFORT TO ALLAY INTERNATIONAL CONCERNS. HOWEVER, SHOULD THE AID NOT BE FORTHCOMING AFTER THREE OR FOUR MONTHS, THE PREVIOUS LEVEL OF VIOLENCE WILL IN ALL LIKELIHOOD NOT ONLY RETURN BUT INCREASE AND COULD BE DIRECTED AT UNAMIR.

A. ONE PATROL WENT SOUTH TO THE COMMUNE OF GISOVU AND THE TOWNS OF GIKO(2252) AND NYAKABINGO(2652). IN THE SECTOR OF GIKO THE SECTOR CHIEF, MR. NZABAHIMANA, HAS BEEN ARRESTED AND IS PRESENTLY IN THE KIBUYE PRISON. THERE WAS NO REASON GIVEN FOR HIS ARREST. ANOTHER MAN, MR. UKUEYEMUYE, A HUTU, WAS ARRESTED FOR STEALING CATTLE. HE SAID HE WAS INNOCENT BUT THE AUTHORITIES SAID HE SHOULD NOT HAVE THE CATTLE HE HAD. THREE WEEKS AGO FOUR MEN WERE ARRESTED IN NYAKABINGO. THEY ARE ACCUSED OF PARTICIPATING IN THE GENOCIDE.

WHEN ASKED OF THE GENERAL FEELING OF UNAMIR THE LOCALS STATED THAT THEY ARE VERY THANKFUL WE ARE HERE AND THEY THINK THAT WITHOUT US THEY WOULD BE IN MORE DANGER THAN THEY ALREADY ARE.

B. A SECOND TEAM WENT TO BWAKIRA COMMUNE AND THE TOWN OF MAGUNDA(4369). THERE THEY MET WITH THE NEW SECTOR CHIEF. DURING THE LAST TWO WEEKS EIGHT PEOPLE HAVE BEEN ARRESTED, ALL ACCUSED OF PARTICIPATING IN THE GENOCIDE. ON RETURN THEY PASSED THROUGH THE TOWN OF NGOMA(2159) WHERE THE LOCAL MASS GRAVES ARE BEING EXHUMED FOR TOMORROW'S RE-BURIAL CEREMONY. THE LOCAL HUTU POPULATION ARE QUITE APPREHENSIVE BECAUSE THEY FEEL THIS ACTION OF DIGGING UP THE BODIES BRINGS BACK A LOT OF OLD HATRED BETWEEN THE TWO SIDES. THEY HAVE NOTICED IN THE PAST TWO DAYS A LOT OF RESENTMENT SHOWN BY THE RPA.

C. THE SWISS DISASTER RELIEF VEHICLE THAT WAS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED AS STOLEN HAS BEEN RETURNED TO THEM; HOWEVER, IT IS IN AN EXTREMELY BAD STATE. THE DRIVER OF THE VEHICLE, AND SDR EMPLOYEE, STATED THAT HE HAD TO DRIVE RPA SOLDIERS AROUND THE COUNTRY.

UN RESTRICTED5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

A. THE PREFECT HELD A MEETING WITH ALL THE NGOS IN KIBUYE TODAY TO DISCUSS BETTER RELATIONS WITH THEM. IN ATTENDANCE WERE: UNHCR, SWISS DISASTER RELIEF, ICRC, ENFANTS DU MONDE, HUMAN RIGHTS, MSF, WFP AND SOLIDARITE. THE MEETING, CHAIRED BY THE PREFECT WAS USEFUL IN AIRING SOME VIEWS BUT THE PREFECT WAS STILL EVASIVE IN SOME ISSUES(I.E. PRISONS). THE MAIN ISSUES DISCUSSED WAS THE DEVELOPMENT OF A BETTER WORKING RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE NGOS AND LOCAL AUTHORITIES. THE PREFECT STRESSED TRANSPARENCY OF ACTION BUT IT REMAINS TO BE SEEN WHETHER IT WILL BE ON BOTH SIDES.

MILOBS HAVE BEEN ASKED TO CONTINUE AND TO INCREASE IF POSSIBLE, THEIR SUPPORT TO WFP. THIS WAS EAGERLY AGREED TO BY THE HUMANITARIAN OFFICER WHO TOOK THIS OPPORTUNITY TO REITERATE OUR ABILITY AND DESIRE TO HELP ANY OF THE NGOS WHO NEEDED LOGISTICAL SUPPORT.

THE PREFECT AGAIN ASKED IF THE ROAD FROM KIBUYE TO GITARAMA COULD BE IMPROVED BY UNAMIR.







ALTHOUGH ARRESTS HAVE TAKEN PLACE IN THE PAST MONTHS THERE HAVEN'T BEEN MANY IN THE PAST WEEK. THE SITUATION AS FAR AS FOOD AND WATER IS NOT VERY GOOD. THE LOCALS DO NOT HAVE ENOUGH FOOD (NGOs WILL BE NOTIFIED) AND THE WATER IS RETRIEVED FROM HOLES IN THE GROUND (AGAIN NGOs WILL BE NOTIFIED BUT IT IS UNLIKELY THEY HAVE THE EQUIPMENT. WE WILL TRY AND OFFER OUR HELP IN THIS MATTER).

C. A THIRD PATROL WENT TO NYABUYE (GR 3567). THE PATROL FOUND ONLY WOMEN IN THE TOWN AND THEY WERE QUITE NERVOUS. AT KIRAMBO (GR 3565) THERE WERE 10 ARRESTS ON 18 APR. TWO NAMES GIVEN WERE THAT OF THE HEAD TEACHER IN THE AREA AND A NURSE AT THE LOCAL CLINIC.

ONE LADY, THAT SPOKE TO THE MILOB TEAM AT KAYENZI (GR 3470) THAT WERE INVESTIGATING THE SHOOTING DEATH OF A LOCAL LAST WEEK, WAS ARRESTED BY THE RPA.

THE CLINIC IN KAYENZI, RUN BY MSF, TREATED SIX PEOPLE THERE WHO HAD BEEN BEATEN BY RPA. THE SERIOUS CASES WERE SENT TO KIBUYE.

THE FOLLOWING IS A CHRONOLOGICAL ACCOUNT OF WHAT APPEARS TO HAVE TRANSPIRED DURING THIS CORDON AND SEARCH OPERATION THROUGHOUT THE TOWN OF KIBUYE:

AT 191900APR THERE WAS A LARGE MEETING AT THE LOCAL CAMP WHERE IT IS BELIEVED SOME TYPE OF ORDERS OR ADDRESS WAS GIVEN.

THE CORDON AND SEARCH OPERATION BEGAN IN EARNEST AT APPROXIMATELY 0300. THE LOCAL HOUSES WERE SEARCHED BY THE RPA. LATER REPORTS FROM MILOBS CONFIRM THE ACTION WAS CONDUCTED PROFESSIONALLY AND NOTHING WAS STOLEN.

AT 0515 THE HUMAN RIGHTS HOUSE WAS SEARCHED. THE OCCUPANTS INSISTED THAT THE HOUSE COULD NOT BE SEARCHED BUT THE RPA CONTINUED THEIR SEARCH REGARDLESS. AGAIN THEIR BEHAVIOR WAS VERY PROFESSIONAL.

AT 0600 - 0645 THE REST OF THE NGO/UN AGENCIES WERE SEARCHED. THE FOLLOWING NGOS WERE SEARCHED: ICRC, WFP, UNHCR, MEDICINS DU MONDE, ENFANTS DU MONDE AND SDR.

AT 0615 A MILOB DOING PT SPOTTED THE SDR COMPOUND FILLED WITH RPA AND RETURNED TO GET ANOTHER MILOB AND VEHICLE. UPON ARRIVAL AT THE SDR COMPOUND WE WERE TOLD IT HAD BEEN A SEARCH FOR ARMS. THE SOLDIERS THEN MOVED ON TO THEIR NEXT LOCATION. THEY WORKED IN PLATOON SIZE GROUPS(30-40) AND IT APPEARED TO BE DONE AT COY LEVEL.

AT 0630 TWO PATROLS WERE DISPATCHED TO THE TOWN TO INVESTIGATE THE SITUATION THERE. THEY FOUND THE SAME HAD HAPPENED THROUGHOUT THE TOWN.

AFTER THE MORNING BRIEF AT 0800, FOUR PATROLS WERE SENT TO FOUR AREAS IN THE TOWN TO TALK TO THE LOCALS AND FIND OUT HOW THEY WERE TREATED. THEY WERE TREATED WELL.

BY 0930 THE SITUATION IN KIBUYE WAS QUITE CALM AND NORMAL.

THE RPA LO SAID, LATER IN THE DAY, THAT THE SEARCH WAS NOT AIMED AT THE NGOS BUT AS THEY WERE GOING TO SEARCH THE POPULATION(PRESUMABLY IN PREPARATION FOR THE UPCOMING PRESIDENTIAL VISIT ON THE 26TH) THEY WOULD TAKE THE OPPORTUNITY TO SEARCH THE NGOS. WHEN ASKED WHY THEY SEARCHED ALL THE AGENCIES, EVEN THOSE THAT THEY WERE NOT SUPPOSED TO, HE REPLIED THAT HIS IO INFORMED HIM THAT NGOS IN THE COUNTRY WERE BRINGING IN ARMS AND/OR HARBOURING CRIMINALS AND FRGF. HE ALSO SAID AS TO NOT TIP OFF THE NGOS THAT WERE TARGETED THEY WOULD SEARCH ALL OF THEM.

THE PREFET, SECURITY OFFICER AND LOCAL COMMANDER WERE CONSPICUOUSLY ABSENT FOR COMMENT THE WHOLE DAY. THERE IS A MEETING WITH THE LOCAL COMMANDER TOMORROW AT 1000HRS.

THEY ARE TIED AND A BAR IS PLACED THROUGH THE BACK OF THEIR ARMS AND RPA DRAG THEM THROUGH THE STREET TO SHOW EVERYONE WHAT HAPPENS TO THOSE THAT ARE IMPLICATED IN THE GENOCIDE.

THE FINAL OBSERVATION CONCERNS THE RPA IN THIS AREA, WHO, UPON SEEING UNAMIR VEHICLES, INSIST ON FOLLOWING THEM. TODAY THE PATROL WAS FOLLOWED BY VEHICLE AND ON FOOT AS THEY WENT THROUGH THE VILLAGES TALKING TO THE LOCALS. THE RESULTS WERE OBVIOUS. WHILE THE TEAM LEADER WAS TALKING WITH THE CHEF DE SECTOR THE RPA ARRIVED AND THE CONVERSATION STOPPED. THEY THEN PROCEEDED TO FOLLOW THE TEAM THROUGHOUT THEIR PATROL. THIS IS NOT THE FIRST TIME THE RPA HAS DONE THIS AND IT APPEARS TO BE SOP IF THEY SEE US.

B. A SECOND TEAM WENT TO MABANZA COMMUNE AND THE SECTOR OF KIBINGO (GR 2980). APPARENTLY INTERAHAMWE LANDED, BY CANOE, ON THE COAST OF THIS SECTEUR EARLY THIS MONTH. (EXACT DATE AND LOCATION COULD NOT BE CONFIRMED) THEY WERE GIVEN FOODSTUFFS BY THEIR RELATIVES AND STOLE FOOD FROM OTHERS. THEY SAID THEY WOULD BE BACK. THIS IS THE FIRST INCIDENT OF LANDINGS THIS FAR NORTH IN THE PREFECTURE. ON APRIL 13 FOUR PEOPLE WERE ARRESTED IN BUGIMA (GR 3081) AND ONE WAS ARRESTED IN RUSHOKA (GR 2878).

THERE ARE MORE DISTURBING REPORTS ABOUT THE RPA CAMP IN SURE (GR 2879). THESE REPORTS AGAIN INDICATE THE EXISTENCE OF HOLES INWHICH PRISONERS ARE KEPT. THE LOCALS TALK ABOUT RPA ARRESTING THEM AND HARASSING THEM FOR MONEY.

C. ONE TEAM PATROLLED THE AREA OF MPEMBE (1766) AND MARA (2068). THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS FOUND CALM, HOWEVER SOME LOCALS ARE STILL SPENDING THEIR NIGHTS OUT IN THE FIELDS, BECAUSE OF FEAR BECOMING ARRESTED. MR HABARUREMA WAS ARRESTED ON 12 APR 95 IN MPEMBE. HE IS ACCUSED OF HAVING TAKEN PART IN THE GENOCIDE AND IS DETAINED AT RPA CAMP IN MPEMBE. LAST WEEK (DATE UNKNOWN) BANDITS LANDED AT MPEMBE AND TOOK ONE FAMILY WITH THEM. IN REFERENCE TO YESTERDAYS SITREP CONCERNING THE KILLING OF ONE MAN BY RPA IN MURANGARA (2267) THE FOLLOWING INVESTIGATION TOOK PLACE: ON THE 12 APR 95 AT APPROXIMATELY 1300 HRS AT MARA (2068) RPA SOLDIERS WENT TO ARREST MR HATEGEKA WHO WAS ACCUSED OF HAVING TAKEN PART IN THE GENOCIDE. THE MAN STARTED TO RUN AWAY, HOWEVER RPA SOLDIERS GAVE CHASED HIM TO A TOP OF A HILL AND IN THE PROCESS HE FELL DOWN AND DIED. HIS BODY WAS TAKEN FROM MARA TO MURANGARA TO HIS HOME WHERE THE DECEASED HAS BEEN BURIED. NO INFORMATION COULD BE GAINED FROM RPA SO FAR. INVESTIGATION STILL IN PROCESS.

5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. THE WFP REP, FRANCIS, WHO WAS PREVIOUSLY EXPELLED FROM THE PREFECTURE, RETURNED YESTERDAY AND HAD A DISCUSSION WITH THE PREFECT. THE PREFECT SAID THAT HIS WHOLE EXPULSION HAD BEEN A MISUNDERSTANDING AND THAT HE REALLY DIDN'T INTEND FOR FRANCIS TO LEAVE.

AT RUTSIRO COMMUNE A NEW DISPENSARY WILL START OPERATING MOST LIKELY NEXT WEEK. LOCATION: RUTSIRO VILLAGE (3988). THIS DISPENSARY WILL BE SPONSORED BY MEMISA. NO FURTHER DETAILS AVAILABLE UP TO NOW.

6. CIVIL AFFAIRS. A MEETING OF THE BOUGEMESTRES OF RWAMATAMU, GISOVU AND GISHYITA COMMUNES TOOK PLACE AT THE SUB PREFECTURE AT GOMA TODAY. THE PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING IS UNKNOWN.

7. LOGISTICS. UNAMIR VEH'S 1080, 1071, 1051 AND 1278 ARE IN THE WORKSHOP AWAITING MAINTENANCE/REPAIR. AT PRESENT THE MALAWI COY HAVE TWO WATER BLADDERS IN KIBUYE BUT THERE IS NO PUMP TO DRAW THE WATER INTO CONTAINERS. WE REQUIRE A PUMP TO AVOID THE UNHYGIENIC METHODS OF TAKING WATER FROM THE BLADDERS THAT IS NOW EMPLOYED. WE HAVE TWO VEHICLES IN THIS LOCATION THAT ARE GROUNDED DUE TO LACK OF SPARE TIRES OR AN ABILITY TO REPAIR THE FLAT ONES. 4. OWN ACTIVITIES.
 - A. ONE TEAM WENT SOUTH TO THE COMMUNE OF RWAMATAMU TO INVESTIGATE THE APPARENT LANDINGS THROUGHOUT THE PAST WEEK. THE SIT IS AS FOLLOWS:
 THERE HAS BEEN THREE KNOWN LANDINGS IN THE PAST FIVE DAYS IN THE AREAS OF: RWABISINDU (GR 1759), KILIMBI (GR 1049) AND NYABINAGA (GR 1351). IN ALL CASES THE LANDINGS WERE UNSUCCESSFUL AS THE RPA WERE ON HAND TO MEET THEM. THE RPA DENIED ANY PRISONERS WERE CAPTURED. THE EARLIER REPORTED LANDINGS AT BUTEMBO AND GITISIMBWE COULD NOT BE VERIFIED AS ACCESS WAS IMPASSABLE DUE TO ROADS AND BRIDGES.

AN RPA MEDICAL SGT WAS GIVEN A RIDE TO KIBUYE BY THE TEAM AND HE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING INFO: DURING THE LAST MONTH 4 RPA WERE KILLED BY INTRUDERS AND 15 WERE WOUNDED(NOW IN KIGALI HOSPITAL). HE ALSO STATED THAT THE GROUPS ARE NOW LANDING WITH MORTARS AND MGs.

NOTE: THERE APPEARS TO BE TWO TYPES OF LANDINGS IN THE PREFECTURE. THE LANDINGS IN RWAMATAMU COMMUNE ARE AGGRESSIVE AND ARE ARMED FOR COMBAT. THE OTHER LANDINGS, WHICH ARE TAKING PLACE IN GISHYITA AND GITESI COMMUNE, ARE LESS DELIBERATE AND CONFRONTATIONAL AND COME MAINLY FOR FOOD.

B. A SECOND PATROL WENT EAST TO THE COMMUNE OF MWENDO, SPECIFICALLY THE TOWN OF MUTUNTU(GR 3554). THE GENERAL SITUATION HERE APPEARS TO BE WORSENING WITH EVERY VISIT. THE LOCAL PRIEST, JEAN BAPTISTE, A EXPAT WHO HAS BEEN IN THE AREA FOR APPROXIMATELY 20YRS, APPEARS TO BE HOLDING EVERYTHING TOGETHER THERE. HE IS DUE TO RETURN TO FRANCE FOR A THREE MONTH LEAVE IN JUNE. WHEN THIS HAPPENS THE SITUATION WILL DEFINITELY DETERIORATE.

THE RPA IN THIS AREA APPEAR TO HAVE A FREE HAND. THEY COERCED A LOCAL TEACHER INTO SELLING HIS MOTORCYCLE TO THEM FOR A SMALL AMOUNT AND THEN THREE DAYS LATER DEMANDED THE MONEY BACK.(OF COURSE THEY KEPT THE BIKE)

THERE APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN ANOTHER DEATH IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE DOUBLE MURDER IN MWENDO PREVIOUSLY REPORTED. A MAN, SHOT BY RPA WAS TAKEN TO THE MUTUNTU HOSPITAL BUT DIED ENROUTE. HE SAID THAT WHEN HE WAS SHOT THE SON HAD ALREADY BEEN KILLED. ANOTHER STRANGE PIECE OF INFORMATION SURROUNDING THIS INCIDENT IS THAT SOME LOCALS SAY THAT THE RPA WERE TRAVELLING IN AN ICRC VEHICLE.

AT THE HOSPITAL IN MWENDO, ONE PRISONER WAS BROUGHT IN WITH LASH MARKS ON HIS BACK AND ANOTHER LADY WAS BROUGHT IN HAVING BEEN WOUNDED BY THE RPA(NO DETAILS WERE GIVEN AS TO WHEN AND WHY).

THERE ALSO APPEARS TO BE A SO-CALLED "KING" OF MWENDO THAT HAS TAKEN SOME PICTURES DURING THE GENOCIDE AND IS BLACKMAILING PEOPLE IN THE COMMUNE BY SAYING HE WILL SHOW THE PICTURES TO THE RPA IF HE IS NOT PAID SOME MONEY. THE PEOPLE WHO HE BLACKMAILS SAY THEY DIDN'T DO ANYTHING BUT THEY PAY HIM BECAUSE THEY ARE AFRAID.

C. A THIRD PATROL WENT TO THE COMMUNE OF GISHYITA, SPECIFICALLY THE SECTEUR OF MARA(GR 2068). YESTERDAY BANDITS CAME FROM IJWE TO STEAL CATTLE. WHEN THEY LEFT THEY TOOK THEIR FAMILY WITH THEM.

THERE ARE STILL A LOT OF INCIDENTS OF TUTSIS STEALING CATTLE FROM HUTUS(they see themselves as the rightful owners).

THE NUMBER OF ARRESTS IN THIS AREA HAS NOT SUBSIDED; THERE WERE TWO ARRESTS HERE LAST WEEK.

YESTERDAY A MAN WAS KILLED IN MURANGARA (GR 2267) WHILE "FLEEING" FROM THE RPA. THIS WILL BE INVESTIGATED TOMORROW.

D. IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE KILLING IN KAYENZI ON 9 APR, THE BOURGEMEISTER OF GITESI WAS ASKED WHAT INFORMATION HE HAD REGARDING THE INCIDENT. HE SAID THAT THE MAN HAD BEEN ARRESTED BY THE RPA BUT WHEN HE WAS BEING QUESTIONED HE ATTACKED THE RPA SO THEY SHOT HIM.

5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. THE WEEKLY SECURITY CONFERENCE WAS HELD TODAY. THE "COOLING OFF" PERIOD FROM 6-10 APR APPEARS TO BE OVER. TWO INCIDENTS OF THEFT IN KIGALI WERE REPORTED. ONE WAS AT THE ICRC COMPOUND WHERE FOUR HOUSES WERE ROBBED. RPA ENTERED THE HOUSES TIED UP EVERYONE AND PROCEEDED TO STEAL WALLETS AND JEWELRY. ONE OF THE EXPATS SPOKE SWAHILI AND OVERHEARD THE RPA SAY, "SO, WHAT DO WE DO WITH THEM NOW?" SUGGESTING THEY BE KILLED. ALL THEIR PASSPORTS WERE CHECKED AND THEY LEFT A GRENADE ON THE DOOR HANDLE AND TOLD THEM NOT TO LEAVE. THEY THEN MOVED ON TO THE OTHER THREE HOUSES, TAKING THE GRENADES AS THEY LEFT.

A SECOND INCIDENT TOOK PLACE AT IOM. THEY HAD A PAYROLL OF \$60,000 US STOLEN. THE INTRUDERS WORE UNIFORMS, KNEW NAMES AND THE LOCATION OF THE MONEY.

A REPRESENTATIVE FROM CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES IN KIGALI CAME BY TO VISIT THE PREFECT AND DISCUSS FOOD DISTRIBUTION. THE PREFECT STATED THAT THE PREFECTURE NEEDED FOOD FOR 4000 PEOPLE. THROUGH DISCUSSION WITH UNHCR, MILOBS AND WFP ONLY APPROXIMATELY 600 COULD BE ACCOUNTED FOR. THE REP SAID HE WAS GOING TO GO TO THE PREFECT AND TELL HIM THE FOOD WOULD NOT BE COMING FROM KIGALI BECAUSE HE DID NOT HAVE THE SUBSTANTIATION TO WARRANT IT.

THE BOURGEMEISTER STATED THAT HE HAD INVESTIGATED THE INCIDENT THE DAY AFTER IT HAPPENED AND IT WAS HIS IMPRESSION THAT THE ATTACKERS, ALTHOUGH DRESSED IN A MISMATCH OF MILITARY CLOTHING AND PORTING AK-47s, WERE REFUGEES FROM THE CAMPS IN 4A.
 WHEN ASKED IF IT MIGHT HAVE BEEN RA HE SAID THAT HE WAS SURE IT WAS BANDITS FROM THE CAMPS.
 ONE MILOB WAS AT BOTH INQUIRIES AND IT IS HIS OPINION, DERIVED FROM THE FEAR OF THE LOCALS, THAT THE ATTACKERS WERE RPA.

C. A THIRD TEAM WENT TO KAYENZI (GR 3470) TO INVESTIGATE PROPERLY THE KILLING OF A MAN ON 9 APR 95. A LOT OF THE WITNESSES THAT WERE IN THE AREA AT THE TIME OF THE SHOOTING REFUSED TO GIVE DETAILS BUT ONE INDIVIDUAL WHO ASKED NOT TO BE NAMED GAVE THIS ACCOUNT:

AT 1500 THE RPA WENT TO KIRAMBO VILLAGE (GR 3765) TO ARREST NDAGIJE (AGED 20-30YRS) FOR SUSPECTED GENOCIDE INVOLVEMENT. HE WAS TAKEN TO KAYENZI TO BE SPOKEN WITH. WHILE THERE HE WAS BEATEN BY THE SOLDIERS. DURING THE BEATING HE HIT BACK AT THE SOLDIERS. THE LOCAL RPA COMMANDER THEN ORDERED THAT NDAGIJE BE SHOT. HE WAS SHOT IN THE BACK.

THE TEAM THEN TRAVELLED TO MABANZA TO TALK WITH THE BOURGEMEISTER. ALTHOUGH KAYENZI IS IN GITESI COMMUNE THE TOWN IS ONLY 2KMS FROM MABANZA. NOT SURPRISINGLY, THE BOURGEMEISTER IN MABANZA REFUSED TO GIVE COMMENT AS IT DID NOT HAPPEN IN HIS COMMUNE. AT THE GITESI COMMUNE OFFICE THE BOURGEMEISTER WAS NOT AVAILABLE AND THE ASSISTANT DID NOT KNOW ANYTHING ABOUT THE INCIDENT.

THE RPA LO IN THIS LOCATION WAS ASKED ABOUT THE INCIDENT AND HE REPLIED THAT HE HAD INVESTIGATED AND THERE HAD BEEN A SHOOTING IN KAYENZI BUT THAT IT WAS A LOCALLY MOTIVATED KILLING AND HAD NOTHING TO DO WITH THE RPA.

D. THE UNHCR REP REPORTED TODAY THAT WHILE IN RWAMATAMU COMMUNE TODAY HE HEARD OF FOUR SEPARATE LANDINGS THAT HAD TAKEN PLACE LAST WEEK:

- a. BUTEMBO (GR 1253)
- b. NYABINAGA (GR 1351)
- c. GITSIMBWE (GR 1052)
- d. KILIMBI (GR 1049) HERE TWO INTRUDERS WERE ARRESTED.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE OVERALL SITUATION THROUGHOUT THE PREFECTURE IS CALM. THE TENSION BUILT UP BEFORE THE ANNIVERSARY IS STILL PRESENT BUT NOT AS INTENSE.

4. OWN ACTIVITIES.
 - A. ONE PATROL WENT EAST TO THE TOWN OF NIANGA (GR 5622) TO INSPECT THE DISPENSARY. THE ROUTE WAS EXTREMELY TREACHEROUS AND SLOW.

THE FACILITY IS RUN BY MSF. THEY AVERAGE NUMBER OF OUTPATIENTS IS 100. IN THE CLINIC THERE IS A SEVERE SHORTAGE OF MATTRESSES. PRESENTLY THERE ARE 47 BEDS WITHOUT MATTRESSES. WHILE THEY HAVE AMPLE MEDICINE THEY ARE VERY SHORT-STAFFED.
 - B. TWO OTHER PATROLS WERE ALSO SENT OUT; HOWEVER DUE TO THE HEAVY RAINS THE ROADS WERE IMPASSABLE AND THE PATROLS HAD TO RETURN.
 - C. THE SITUATION REPORTED BY MALAWI COY REGARDING THE KILLING OF A MAN IN KAYENZI (GR 3470) WILL BE FURTHER INVESTIGATED BY MILOBS TOMORROW.

D. THE OPS O RETURNED FROM CYANGUGU TODAY. HE HAD BEEN THERE TO INVESTIGATE THE SITUATIONAL TRENDS THAT WERE PREVALENT IN 4C SOME MONTHS AGO AND SEE IF THEY APPLY TO 3A. HE FOUND THERE TO BE LITTLE IN THE WAY OF A PATTERN BETWEEN THE TWO AREAS. ONE INTERESTING ASPECT WAS THE PERCENTAGE OF INCIDENTS THAT ARE BELIEVED TO BE PERPETRATED BY THE RPA. TWO MONTHS AGO IT WAS ALMOST 90% BUT NOW IS ONLY 10-15%. IN THIS SECTOR WE ARE STILL FINDING THE INCIDENTS TO BE 90-95% RPA INDUCED.

THE ONE FACTOR THAT SEEMS TO SPERATE THE TWO SECTORS IS THE PROXIMITY OF 4C TO ZAIRE(INCLUDING IJWE) AND BURUNDI. MORE DETAILS OF THE LIAISON VISIT WILL BE FORWARDED TO YOUR HQ TOMORROW IN A SEPARATE REPORT.
