

A. UNAMIR'S CLOSURE CEREMONY WAS PERFORMED WITH DIGNITY AND HONOUR AT ITS HEADQUARTERS AT 1700 HOURS ON 08 MAR 96. THE RWANDAN FOREIGN MINISTER DR. ANATESE GASANA PARTICIPATED AND WITNESSED THE GUARD OF HONOUR ALONG WITH THE SRSG AND THE ACTING FORCE COMMANDER. MEMBER OF THE DIPLOMATIC CORPS, SEVERAL MINISTERS AND SENIOR OFFICERS OF THE GOVERNMENT WERE PRESENT ON THE AUSPICIOUS OCCASION.

B. THE SRSG IN HIS SPEECH STATED THAT RWANDA HAS TRANSFORMED ITSELF FROM DEVASTATION TO REVIVAL, FROM DEGRADATION TO DIGNITY AND FROM TERROR TO SECURITY. THIS IS A MAJOR ACHIEVEMENT OF THE UN MILITARY CONTINGENT IN RWANDA AND THIS ACHIEVEMENT WILL FORM A ROLL OF HONOUR IN THE ANNALS OF UN'S PEACEKEEPING HISTORY. THE SRSG EXPRESSED HIS PROFOUND SENSE OF GRATITUDE, TO THE GOVERNMENT AND PEOPLE OF RWANDA FOR THE SUPPORT GIVEN TO UNAMIR. IN HIS CONCLUDING REMARKS, THE SRSG STATED THAT UNAMIR IS DEPARTING WITH A SENSE OF PRIDE AND SUCCESS. IN DOING SO, UNAMIR SHARES WITH RWANDA-ITS HISTORY, ITS TRAGEDY AND ITS REVIVAL.

C. SPEAKING ON BEHALF OF RWANDA GOVERNMENT, THE FOREIGN MINISTER THANKED UNAMIR FOR THE CONTRIBUTION IT HAD MADE TOWARDS THE REHABILITATION AND RECOVERY OF RWANDA AND IN PARTICULAR, STRESSED THE NEED FOR FRIENDSHIP AND COOPERATION BETWEEN RWANDA AND THE UNITED NATIONS.



A. THE SRSG ATTENDED THE HEADS OF AGENCIES MEETING AT THE UNDP OFFICE AND HAD A USEFUL EXCHANGE OF VIEWS WITH REGARD TO UN AGENCIES' ACTIVITIES IN RWANDA. THERE AFTER, HE MET WITH MR.ADEDE OF ICTR AND DISCUSSED ADMINISTRATIVE AND SECURITY MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE TRIBUNAL. THE CHIEF OF COMMUNAL POLICE CALLED UPON THE SRSG AT HIS OFFICE AND SOUGHT UN ASSISTANCE FOR TRAINING PROGRAMMES AND LOGISTICS.

B. IN THE AFTERNOON, MR. MPONDO OF UNESCO MET WITH THE SRSG AND DISCUSSED THE FORTH COMING VISIT OF THE DIRECTOR GENERAL FOR UNESCO AS WELL AS UNESCO'S COOPERATION FOR UNAMIR RADIO. THE SRSG ALONG WITH ACTING FC, ALSO ATTENDED A BRIEFING ON THE ROUND TABLE ACTIVITIES IN RWANDA.

C. FINALLY THE SRSG MET WITH THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF BURKINA FASO MR. OUEDRAGO ABLASSE WHO IS ALSO THE CHAIRMAN OF OAU COUNCIL OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS MINISTERS AND DISCUSSED THE BUJUMBURA PLAN OF ACTION AS WELL AS DEVELOPMENTS CONCERNING THE OAU CONFERENCE IN ADDIS ABABA.

D. RADIO RWANDA REPORTED THAT, THE GOVERNMENT HAS ACCEPTED, THAT A SMALL POLITICAL OFFICE OF THE SRSG IN RWANDA, REMAINS IN RWANDA WITH A FEW PERSONNEL. IT FURTHER REPORTED THAT, THE DEPUTY CHIEF PROSECUTOR OF THE INTERNATIONAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA, JUDGE HONORE' ROKOTOMANA, HAS REQUESTED THE RWANDAN GOVERNMENT TO COOPERATE WITH THE TRIBUNAL IN PROVIDING CONCRETE EVIDENCE AGAINST THE SUSPECTED PERPETRATORS OF THE RWANDAN GENOCIDE.

B. THE ACTING FC ALSO GAVE AN INTERVIEW TO THE STAFF CORRESPONDENT OF THE JAPANESE DAILY NEWSPAPER, THE YOMIURI SHIMBUN, AND DISCUSSED ISSUES RELATED TO THE SECURITY SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY AND CLOSURE OF UNAMIR.



(1) SECTOR 2 (GITARAMA) - IT WAS REPORTED FROM NYABIKENKE COMMUNE THAT TWO BUSINESSMEN WERE ATTACKED ON 24 FEB 96 AND ROBBED OF 400,000 FRW. THE ROBBERS ARE SAID TO HAVE BEEN ARRESTED IN KIGALI ON 29 FEB 96.

(2) SECTOR 5 (GISENYI) - IT WAS REPORTED FROM RAMBA COMMUNE (GR 4893) THAT SEVEN ARMED MEN SHOT AT TWO PERSONS RIDING ON A MOTOR BIKE ON 29 FEB 96 CAUSING MINOR INJURIES. MOTIVE UNKNOWN. INVESTIGATION BY RPA IN PROGRESS.

6. POLITICAL.

A. THE SRSG HELD A MEETING OF SENIOR STAFF MEMBERS OF UNAMIR AND TOOK STOCK OF THE SITUATION REGARDING UNAMIR'S PHASE OUT. THEREAFTER, A BRIEFING WAS GIVEN TO THEM ON THE OUTCOME OF THE AFRICAN FOREIGN MINISTERS MEETING IN ADDIS ABBA, WHERE HE WENT, TO ATTEND. LATER, THE SRSG GAVE AN INTERVIEW TO RADIO/TV RWANDA WITH REGARD TO THE FUTURE ROLE OF UNITED NATIONS IN THE COUNTRY, AS WELL AS UNAMIR'S WITHDRAWAL AFTER THE 8 OF MARCH. IN THIS CONTEXT, HE STATED THAT THREE OPTIONS CONCERNING THE FUTURE PRESENCE OF UN HAVE BEEN FORWARDED TO THE GOVERNMENT AND TILL DATE THERE HAS BEEN NO RESPONSE FROM THAT SIDE. WHEN ASKED ABOUT THE DISPOSAL OF UNAMIR EQUIPMENT, THE SRSG EXPLAINED, THAT PRIORITY GOES TO THE USE OF THIS EQUIPMENT FOR PEACE KEEPING OPERATIONS ELSEWHERE. SECONDLY THIS EQUIPMENT IS ALSO MEANT TO BE GIVEN TO UN AGENCIES OPERATING IN RWANDA AND OF COURSE A PART OF THE EQUIPMENT WILL BE HANDED OVER TO THE GOVERNMENT OF RWANDA AS INDICATED EARLIER. WITH REGARD TO UNAMIR'S PHASE OUT, THE SRSG STATED THAT THE MANDATE EXPIRES ON 8 MARCH AND THE COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL OF UNAMIR WOULD FOLLOW ACCORDING TO THE SCHEDULE GIVEN IN THIS REGARD.

B. IN THE AFTERNOON, MR. ADEDE ICTR CALLED UPON THE SRSG AT HIS OFFICE AND DISCUSSED THE SECURITY SITUATION IN REGARD TO THE TRIBUNAL'S OPERATIONS IN RWANDA. FINALLY THE SRSG PARTICIPATED IN THE MEETING OF THE AMBASSADORS AND BRIEFED THEM ABOUT FUTURE UN PRESENCE IN RWANDA AS WELL AS ON THE OUTCOME OF AFRICAN FOREIGN MINISTERS MEETING IN ADDIS ABBA.





A. IN SECTOR 3 (BUTARE), ON 25 FEB 96 THE COUNCILLOR OF MEYAMBE SECTOR IN RWAMIKO COMMUNE (GR 4914) WAS KILLED BY UNKNOWN PERSONS.

B. IN SECTOR 3 (BUTARE), ANOTHER COUNCILLOR, OF A SECTOR IN MUKO COMMUNE (GR 3742), HIS WIFE, TWO CHILDREN AND ANOTHER MEMBER OF HIS FAMILY (MAKING A TOTAL OF FIVE) WERE KILLED ON 26 FEB 96 BY AN UNKNOWN PERS.

C. IN SECTOR 5 (GISENYI), ON 27 FEB 96 IN NKUMA COMMUNE (GR 4724) SOME ARMED MEN ATTACKED A SHOPKEEPER AND LOOTED HIS GOODS.

D. IN SECTOR 5 (GISENYI), ON 28 FEB IN CYABINGO COMMUNE (GR 6525) THE COMMUNE ACCOUNTANT RESIDING NEAR THE COMMUNE CENTRE WAS SHOT BY SOME ARMED MEN. HE IS BEING TREATED AT RUHENGIRI HOSPITAL.

6. POLITICAL.

A. RADIO RWANDA VEHEMENTLY DENIED ALLEGATIONS WITH REGARD TO THE ATTEMPTED ASSASSINATION OF THE FORMER INTERIOR MINISTER SETH SENDASHONGA, AS BEEN PLANNED BY THE RWANDAN GOVERNMENT. THE GOVERNMENT'S POSITION WAS CLARIFIED BY SAYING, THAT THE ALLEGED ASSASSINATION IS NOT AN EXCEPTION, AS SUCH INCIDENTS HAS ALSO BEEN TAKING PLACE BY RWANDAN REFUGEES IN ZAIRE, WHERE MILITIAS, FORMER FAR AND GENOCIDAL POLITICIANS LIVE.

B. THE RADIO FURTHER REPORTED THAT EIGHT PROSECUTORS INCLUDING TWO GENERAL PROSECUTORS OF KIGALI WERE SWORN IN YESTERDAY SO AS TO UNDERTAKE GENOCIDE TRIALS. IN AN APPROPRIATE MANNER. IT MAY BE RECALLED THAT THE ASSISTANT PROSECUTOR OF KIGALI AS WELL AS THE PRESIDENT OF THE TRIBUNAL OF THE PREMIER INSTANCE HAVE BOTH BEEN SUSPENDED FROM THEIR POSTS AND HAVE YET TO BE INFORMED OFFICIALLY OF THEIR SUSPENSION OR REASONS FOR IT. THE TRIBUNAL OF THE PREMIER INSTANCE DEALS WITH CIVIL CASES MOSTLY PROPERTY DISPUTES. THE ASSISTANT PROSECUTOR MR. MUNYIAGISHAL THEN SEEN UNDER HOUSE ARREST SINCE 23 FEB 96. HUMAN RIGHTS IS FOLLOWING THE MATTER VERY CLOSELY. IN A SIMILAR CONTEXT, RADIO RWANDA ALSO REPORTED, THAT, THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT HAS INDICATED ITS INTENTION TO REVISE ITS LAWS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, SO THAT RWANDAN GENOCIDE SUSPECTS WHO LIVE IN FRANCE COULD BE ARRESTED AND BE TRANSFERRED TO ARUSHA FOR TRIALS.

2. OVERVIEW. NSTR.

3. RPA. IN SECTOR 5 (GISENYI) ON 24 FEB 96, AN OLD MAN WAS SHOT DEAD BY THE RPA WHEN HE REFUSED TO STOP ON CHALLENGING DURING CURFEW HOURS. ANOTHER PERSON WAS SHOT FOR BREAKING CURFEW IN GATONDE COMMUNE, CYIBUMBA SECTOR (GR 6520). HR INFORMED.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. IN SECTOR 2 (GITARAMA), ON THE NIGHT OF 15 FEB 96, BANDITS RAIDED RUGALIKA (GR 9574) AND KINYAMI (GR 9177) SECTORS OF RUNDA COMMUNE AND STOLE A BICYCLE AND 6,000 FRW, FOOD ITEMS AND AN UNSPECIFIED AMOUNT OF MONEY FROM THE LOCALS. THERE HAS BEEN NO ARREST SO FAR.

B. IN SECTOR 5 (GISENYI), ON 24 FEB 96 IN RUREMBO SECTOR (GR 6520) ONE PERSON SUSTAINED INJURIES WHEN SOME PERSONS THREW A GRENADE INTO THE HOUSE WHILE ATTEMPTING TO BREAK-IN. THE VICTIM IS ADMITTED AT RUHENGARI HOSPITAL.

6. POLITICAL.

A. RADIO RWANDA REPORTED THAT HUMANITARIAN ORGANIZATIONS, "AFRICA RIGHTS", "MEMORIAL", HAVE CRITICIZED THE FRENCH JUDICIAL SYSTEM FOR ITS POOR PROCEDURES IN FOLLOWING UP SUSPECTS OF THE 1994 GENOCIDE. THE RADIO FURTHER REPORTED THAT THE RWANDA REFUGEES REPRESENTATIVES WHO WERE ON A FACT FINDING MISSION IN GITARAMA AND RUHENGARI, RETURNED TO ZAIRE TO EXPLAIN TO THE REFUGEES IN THE CAMPS THAT SECURITY CONDITIONS IN RWANDA WERE QUITE SATISFACTORY AND CONTRARY TO WHAT HAVE BEEN TOLD BY INTIMIDATORS IN THE CAMPS.

B. RWANDA UNITED NATIONS CONTINGENCY PLAN FOR REPATRIATION OF REFUGEES FROM BURUNDI, TANZANIA AND ZAIRE HAS BEEN RELEASED AND OUTLINES ACTIVITIES TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY UNHCR WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF UN AGENCIES, OTHER INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION AND NGOS IN SUPPORT OF THE GOVERNMENT OF RWANDA, S EFFORTS TO REPATRIATE THE RETURNEES FROM THE AFOREMENTIONED COUNTRIES.






