... I am sending you herewith up to date lists of basic and background

Since Documents have reached saturation point (we have been rather
successful in submitting most documents on time) it has been decided that
no more long documents will be submitted here. I shall, therefore, send
you all documents as they come in from now on.

I am air mailing to you today the following books which the Documents
Officer will need in Geneva :

I am also sending you my box of cards. All information on current
documents will be found in these cards. ~~Ma~~ Such information is no longer
entered in several books. I have found this system to work admirably and
I am anxious that it be kept in proper order. It is a very simple system.
When a number is allocated to a document, a card is made out for that
number and tagged with a black signal on the left hand corner. When the
document is actually submitted, full details are entered on the card, the
black signal is removed and a brown one put in the centre. When the
document comes out, the brown signal is removed and the appropriate colour
(tabled in the lid of the box) put on the right hand side of the card.
This shows at a glance, how many documents have to be submitted, how many
are submitted, but not yet out and how many are out in which languages.

You will also be receiving one copy of each document that has been issued
within the past few days. These are for the master files.

SUBJECT: The ~~Title~~ of the Polish communications concerning the report of the Ad Hoc Committee on Statelessness and Related Problems

Date 5 June 1950

During my telephone conversation with a member of your staff it came to my attention that the communication of the Government of Poland is being reproduced for circulation (under Council resolution 248 (IX B) as a governmental "Comment" on the report of the Ad Hoc Committee on Statelessness and related Problems. The number given to this document is E/1703/Add 1, which is the number of the series of governmental comments.

The Division of Human Rights had submitted this document as a "communication" from the Polish Government and not as a "comment". The reason for this was the express desire of the Permanent Representative of Poland to the United Nations (see the letter of Mr. Katz-Suchy dated 3 May in SOA 325/5/02(1)) to circulate the communication of his Government as a communication and not as a comment since his Government does not consider it a comment under Council resolution 248 (IX B).

If you are interested in further elaboration of this point, you may look into Mr. Humphrey's letter of 19 April 1950, to Mr. Cordier and the comments of Mr. Cordier upon this letter (see SOA 329/5/02(1)), as well as Mrs. Myrdal's letter to Mr. Katz-Suchy of 1 May 1950 (50/1491/CAH).

In view of the nature of this case, I am confident your Office would like to issue the letter of Mr. Katz-Suchy as a "communication" and not as a "comment".
