SUBJECT: URGENT REQUIREMENT OF FOOD AND MEDICINE FOR DISPENSARY CRETE ZAIRE - NIL

REFERENCE: HUMANITARIAN OFFICERS CONFERENCE ON 03 MAR 95 (REPORT OF SEVERE HUMANITARIAN PROBLEMS DIRECT TO HAC)

1. PLEASE BE INFORMED THAT THE DISPENSARY IN RUTSIRO 3183 (CENTRE DE SANTE CRETE ZAIRE - NIL) IS RUNNING OUT OF FOOD AND MEDICINE. THIS DISPENSARY IS NORMALLY LOOKED AFTER BY CARITAS. CARITAS PROVIDED THE LAST FOOD DISTRIBUTION ON 26 FEB 95. ON 01 MAR 95 ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM CARITAS VISITED THE SCENE BUT NO ACTION HAS TAKEN PLACE SO FAR. PLEASE SEE ENCLOSED LIST OF URGENT REQUIREMENTS. 2

2. PLEASE BE ALSO INFORMED THAT IN KIVUMU COMMUNE THREE BRIDGES ARE BROKEN DOWN AND THEREFORE THE AREAS OF KIBANDA 5178 AND BWIRA 4981 ARE CUT OFF FROM ANY VEHICLE MOVEMENT. LOCATIONS OF BROKEN DOWN BRIDGES ARE AS FOLLOWS: GR 5073, GR 5475 AND GR 5774.

3. YOUR KIND CONSIDERATION AND ACTION REGARDING THESE MATTERS WOULD BE HIGHLY APPRECIATED.

SUBJECT: SITREP COVERING PERIOD 151800 FEB TO 161800 B FEB 95.1. GENERAL SITUATION. CALM.2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. NTR.3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.A. RPA.

(1) CONTINUING WITH FOOT AND MOBILE PATROLS AND MANNING OF CHECK POINTS.

(2) TRAINING IS IN PROGRESS IN KIBUYE.

B. RGF. NTR.C. OTHERS. NTR.4. OWN ACTIVITIES.

A. A PATROL WENT TO GISOVU (GR 2852) TO VISIT THE BOURGEMEISTER. THE BOURGEMEISTER'S DETAILS ON HIS COMMUNE ARE RATHER SKETCHY. HE SAID HE ONLY HAD FIRM DETAILS ON TWO OF HIS SECTUERS. GENERALLY THIS COMMUNE WAS FOUND TO BE STILL LACKING IN MOST ESSENTIALS. NGOS ARE PRESENT BUT MORE ARE REQUIRED.

B. A SECOND PATROL WENT TO MWENDO (GR 4559). THE GENERAL SITUATION IN THIS COMMUNE IS STILL VERY CALM. THE ROAD FROM BIRAMBO (GR 4673) TO MWENDO, ALTHOUGH RECEIVING REPAIRS FROM "FOOD FOR WORK" IS STILL VERY BAD. AS THIS IS THE ONLY ROAD INTO THE COMMUNE THIS MAY BE THE REASON WHY THERE ARE VERY FEW NGOS IN THE AREA. THERE IS LITTLE IN THE WAY OF ESSENTIALS SUCH AS POWER, WATER AND AGRICULTURE COOPERATIVES.

C. A THIRD TEAM WENT TO THE MARA PENINSULA (GR 2068). THEY WERE TOLD THAT BANDITS ENTER THIS AREA QUITE FREQUENTLY. ON 14 FEB, THIRTY BANDITS ENTERED BY BOAT BUT WERE REPELLED BY THE RPA IN THIS AREA. THE LOCALS STATED THAT SOME OF THE LOCALS LEFT WITH THE BANDITS (WILLINGLY). AGAIN THIS AREA HAS BEEN NEGLECTED BY THE NGOS. WHILE THE LOCALS CAN TRAVEL TO MABUGA (2463) TO RECEIVE SOME AID THERE IS LITTLE EFFORT IN THEIR SECTUER.
