

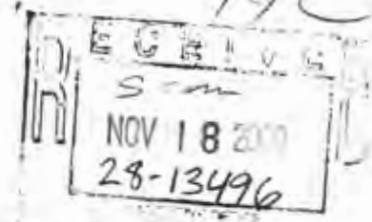

We are pleased to announce a Presidents' Group Round-Table Conference-Luncheon that will take place in Brussels on **Wednesday 3rd December 2008**.



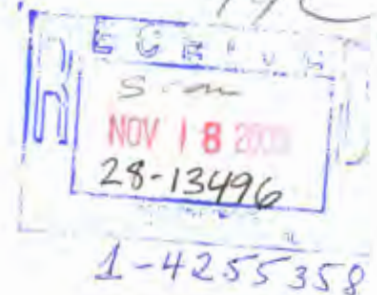
