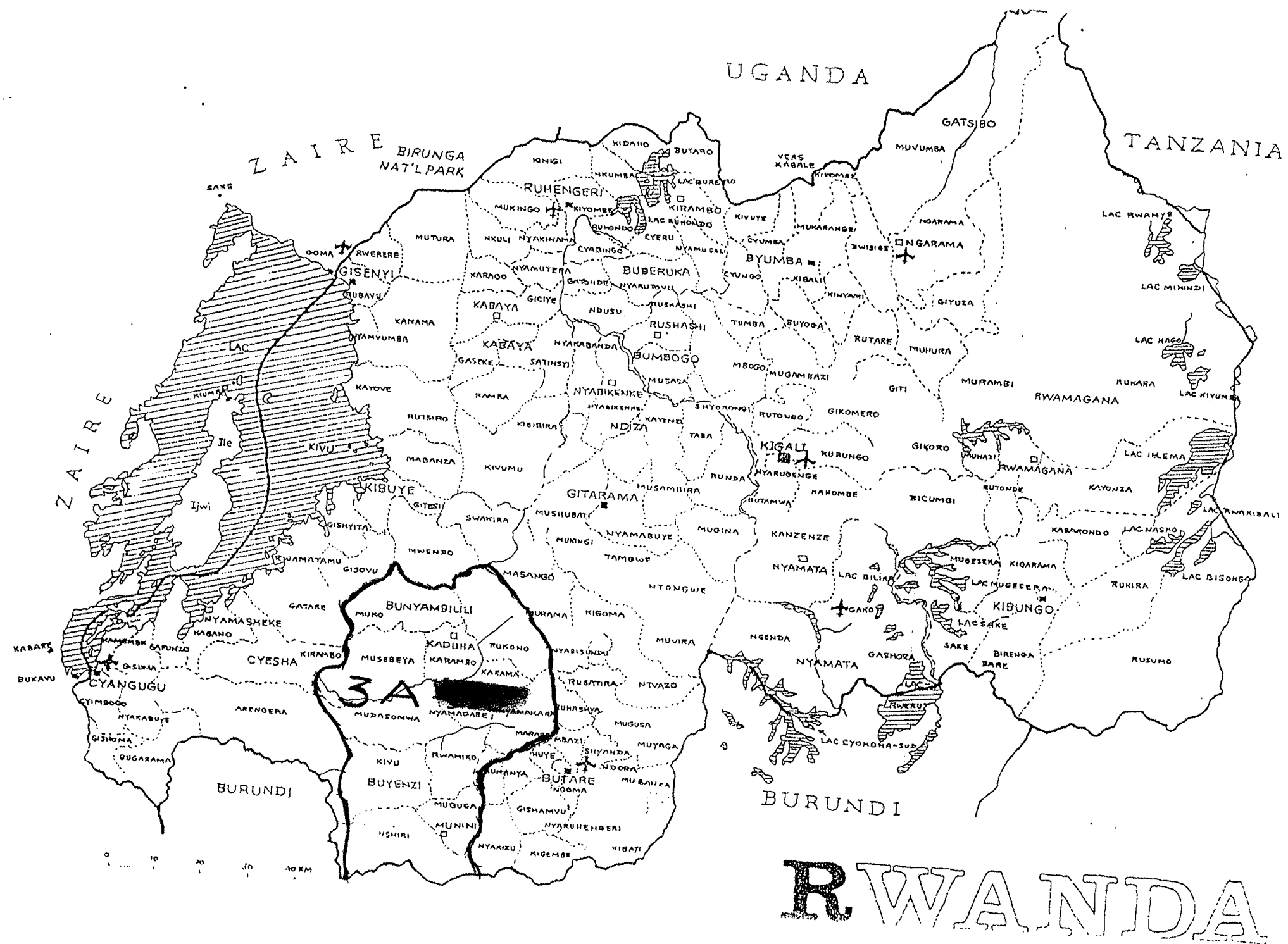
SHORT BRIEF OF SECTOR 3 A

1. The sector owes its boundaries with a population of 485114 before the war and 419005 till date. The French Forces occupied this area and created a French Humanitarian Protection Zone around CYANGUGU, GIKONGORO AND KIBUYE. They possessed strength with highly mobile troops and paratroopers including substantial amount of weaponry and equipment. They pulled out of this area in August 94. It may be of interest to know that the French Hq in South West Rwanda was in this TACTICAL HQ.

2. The French occupation in Gikongoro brought in confidence and led to a large concentration of mostly Displaced Persons in this Prefecture. Which belong to the Hutu tribe. When RPA captured Kigali and was slowly taking control of the whole country, reprisal against this camps was a definite possibility and UNAMIR decided to move troops in this area. The move of the troops was preceded by deployment of Military Observers. The job of the Milobs included confidence building reporting of security situation, monitoring movement of all the forces and any cease-fire violations. Also to locate IDP camp in the remote areas of the prefecture, Identify accessible routes and escort NGO'S to the camps to offer HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE.

3. It will be interesting for you to know that it was the MILOBS, in this sector who escorted COY strength of RPA soldiers and the PREFECT into this PREFECTURE to enable the GOVERNMENT established its authority in this HUTU dominated area. That is why the MILOBS enjoy a very good working relationship with the local Authority.

4. The prefecture have 13 communes with 125 sectors. All the local administration have started operating in all the communes.

2. **Movement and concentration.**


