UNCLAS BULE 921-GARDINER KHIARY FROM GAVIOLA -DAILY REPORT -

1. NINE PERSONS ARRESTED SEPT 14 AND FIVE EMPLOYEES CONSEIL MONETAIGE SEPT 18 (SEE SUMMARIES THOSE DAYS) HAVE BEEN RELEASED BY PROCUREUR ETAT FOR LACK OF EVIDENCE . CONGENEXTRA MOSOKO HAS INSTRUCTED SURETE NOT TO ORDER ARRESTS BASED UPON VAGUE DENUNCIATIONS ; SINCE THE AUTHORITIES ARE THUS DISCREDITED AND THE POPULATION GETS PANICKY.
2. COMSPECIAL FOR MANIEMA ARRIVED IN BUKAVU AND SAID REPORTS ABOUT ILLEGAL ARRESTS IN KALIMMA WERE GROSSLY EXAGGERATED. BUT DEPUTY KITITWA ARRIVED LAST NIGHT FROM KALIMA AND SUSTAINED WAREGAS WERE PERSECUTED AT INSTIGATION OF LASSIRI. HE HIMSELF MANAGED TO ESCAPE WHEN THEY ARRESTED COMDISTRICT KAMAKANDA .
3. CONGENEXTRA MOSOKO SENT HIS CHEF DE CABINET TO KINDU TO INVESTIGATE AND HAVE KAMAKANDA TRANSFERRED TO BUKAVU .
4. AT THE APPEAL OF AUTHORITIES SOME MONITEURS HAVE STARTED WORKING BUT STRIKE PREVENTS MOST SCHOLS FROM REOPENING (BULE 919 REFERS)

1. ¹⁰⁸neuf personnes arrêtées le 14 septembre et les 5 employés du Conseil monétaire le 18 septembre (voir rapports de ces dates) ont été remis en liberté par procureur état par manque d'évidence. Comgenextra Mosoko a donné instructions à Sûreté de ne pas donner l'ordres d'arrestation basées sur de vagues dénonciations, cela faisant tort aux autorités et sèment la panique parmi la population.

2. Commissaire spécial pour Maniema est arrivé à Bukavu et a déclaré que les rapports d'arrestations illégales à Kalima étaient exagérés outre mesure. Cependant le député Kititwa est arrivé hier-soir de Kalima et a soutenu que les Warega étaient persécutés à l'instigation de Lassiri. Il réussi lui-même à s'échapper lorsqu'ils arrêterent le commissaire de district Kamakanda.

3. Comgenextra Mosoko a envoyé son chef de cabinet à Kindu pour mener enquête et faire transférer Kamakanda à Bukavu.

4; A l'appel des autorités, quelques moniteurs ont recommencé à travailler mais la grève empêche la plupart des écoles de se rouvrir (ref. BULE 919)

1. COMSPECIAL SAMOUDZOU RETURNED FROM MANIEMA AND NORTH KIVU.
2. HE SAID THE REPORTED MASSACRES IN KALIMA ARE EXAGGERATED BY INTERESTED POLITICIANS FROM MWENGA WHO ALSO WOULD LIKE TO LOIN MANIEMA, PARTICULARLY DEPUTY KITITWA AND SHABUNDA COMDISTRICT KANDAKANDA FOR WHOM ORDER OF ARREST WAS ISSUED BUT WENT TO HIDING.

ACCORDING TO REPORTS SOME SOLDIERS WOULD HAVE FOLLOWED THEM.

3. IN KILOTSHE TEMPORARY CAPITAL OF NORTH KIVU HE RECEIVED PETITION OF MASISI ELECTORS WITH ALMOST A THOUSAND SIGNATURES ASKING FOR REFERENDUM TO JOIN KIVU CENTRAL. THREE INSTITUTORS WERE

1. Commissaire spécial Samoudzou est revenu de Maniema et Nord Kivu.

2. Il déclara que les massacres signalés à Kalma sont exagéré par politiciens intéressés de Mwenga qui voudraient également s'unir au Maniema, en particulier le député Kititwa et Shabunda, commissaire du district de Kandakanda dont l'ordre d'arrestation avait été donné mais qui s'est caché. D'après certains rapports, des soldats les auraient suivis.

3. A Kirotshe, capitale provisoire du Nord Kivu, il reçu une petition des electeurs Masisi portant près de 1000 signatures, réclamant un referendum pour s'unir au Kivu central. Trois instituteurs furent arrêtés et accusés d'activité politique mais une foule ~~xxxxxx~~ se déclaina sur la police, les libérant.

4. A Rutshuru et Goma, la majorité du peuple est également en faveur d'un rattachement avec le Kivu central. Si tendance continue, le Nord Kivu sera réduit à 3 territoires séparés.

5. Samoudzou a également rencontré des députés du Kivu central et leur a conseillé de préparer une pétition pour leur province, qui soit soumise dès que le parlement sera réuni.

6. Comgenextra Mosoko rendit visite au secrétaire d'état Lunyasi à l'hotel où il se trouve en surveillance et donna son accord à ce que Lunyasi parte pour Léo le 18 septembre/

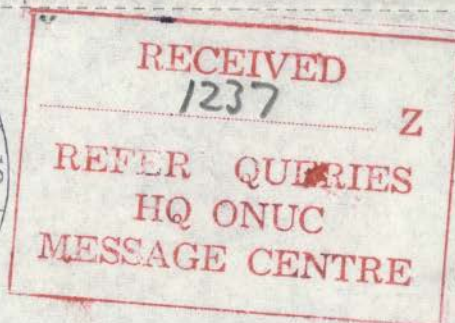

With reference to your memorandum of 15 June 1964, I wish to advise you that I have no objection to Mr. Beatty-Seville's transfer to Leopoldville provided that it is understood that no time can and will be provided by the other staff of the field office for clearing up the pending accommodation cases. I am certain you will realize that with the limited number of staff in our field offices and the many daily problems they are facing, it would be a physical impossibility for such staff to cope with other work, except their regular duties.

If, therefore, you expect that some services would have to be provided locally, I would suggest that Mr. J. Beatty-Seville be kept in Bukavu for this purpose or, alternatively, that you arrange for someone from your Section to visit Bukavu, if and when needed.

In any event, as Mr. Beatty-Seville's main task is in the liquidation of accommodation claims resulting from past usage, his salary would not be chargeable against the Civilian Operations Budget.
