REYOUR LU 135. SINCE MOST DIRECT ROUTE TO KABINDA VIA BAKWANGA NOT AT PRESENT OPEN. REESTABLISHMENT ROAD COMMUNICATIONS LULUABOURG KABINDA DEPENDS ON SITUATION LUSAMBO. A STRONG UN PATROL IS NOW ENROUTE TO LUSAMBO TO CHECK ON SITUATION AS IT APPEARS, THERE ARE STILL 200-300 KALONJIST SOLDIERS THERE UNFRIENDLY TO UN. WE UNDERSTAND KALONJI HAS INSTRUCTED THEM RETURN BAKWANGA BUT THEY NEED AIR TRANSPORT, THEY NEED AIR TRANSPORT AS ROAD PASSES THROUGH HOSTILE VILLAGES. OUR PATROL WILL GO AS FAR AS PANIA MUTOMBO TO CHECK ON REPEATED REPORTS OF KILLINGS AND PILLAGE BY KALONJISTS. DEPENDING ON PATROLS REPORT, WE HOPE SEND SUPPLY CONVOY TO KABINDA NEXT WEEK. 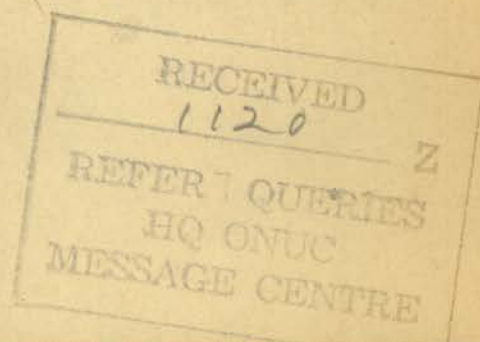
