Haitians Nationals ie: Tortures, Hangings, and Deaths.

ACDESSA and UHA are illustrating some of these cases: On February 11, 2015, a Dominican  
Newspaper  
Noticias sin reported that a young Haitian Men Jean Claude Harry found hanged from a tree in a  
Santiago Park.Dominican Republic.

On July 2015, in Banica Dominican Republic, 26 Haitian Nationals were attacked by Dominican  
Civilians, 24 of them dissapeared, and only 2 survived.

Many Haitians were hacked with machettes, on Tuesday, August 18, 2015, a young Haitian  
Willin

Yrak, was hacked with machette in Hatillo Palma, Dominican Republic.

It is very important to notice, that Haiti, as a Founding Member of the United Nations; but the  
United Nations High Commissioner of Refugees (UNHCR), United Nations High Commissioner

failed to treat Haitians under the 1951 Geneva Conventions, and the Protocol d'Accord of 1967.

United Haitian Association of USA, Inc. (UHA) and ACDESSA, called on the United Nations for an

INTERNATIONAL TREATY ON THE HAITIAN BOAT PEOPLE AND THE HAITIAN IMMIGRANTS IN THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC.

In 2014, the Bahamas Government, has deported 4.229 Haitians, while 5.000 died on International Waters.

For the past 43 years Haitians Nationals had perished on High Seas, the Deported Survivors have been

treated without DUE PROCESS.

More than ever, it is time for UNHCR, and UNHCHR to endorse their responsibilities toward Haiti and its people.

FOR SO LONG, HAITI HAS BEEN SHORT CHANGED BY THE UNITED NATIONS.

The Haitian people can no longer accept the Politic of "Deux Poids and Deux Mesures" of the United

Nations. After all, the Haitiano-Dominican crisis, is a Bilateral and Multilateral Crisis; therefore, in essence, such a Crisis must be handle by the United Nations, because, both Nations Haiti and the

Dominican Republic are State Members of the United Nations.
