3.A. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED THE AREAS OF GISENYI, KANAMA (2712), NYAMYUMBA (2006) AND KAYOVE. THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO INVESTIGATE THE KILLING OF 4 PERSONS ON THE NIGHT OF 18/19 MAR 95 AT KANAMA. THE TEAM HAS ALSO BEEN TASKED TO LIAISE WITH THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES AT THE COMMUNE OF KAYOVE AND COLLECT THE LIST OF THE ORPHANS AND THE WIDOWS. THE TEAM WAS ACCOMPANIED BY A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNHCR. THE TEAM WAS ALSO TASKED TO ASSESS THE SECURITY SITUATION ALONG THE PATROL ROUTE BY TALKING TO AS MANY LOCALS AS POSSIBLE. THE TEAM REPORTED THE SECURITY SITUATION AS CALM. THE TEAM CONDUCTED THE INVESTIGATION BUT COULD NOT COMPLETE THE INVESTIGATION DUE TO THE WITNESS NOT BEING AVAILABLE. THE INVESTIGATION WILL BE COMPLETED ON A LATER DATE. THE PATROL REPORTED THAT THE DETENTION CENTER AT KAYOVE DID NOT HOLD ANY PRISONERS AT THE MOMENT.

3.B. ONE MILOB TEAM PROVIDED ESCORT TO THE SIU TEAM FROM KIGALI WHO WERE INVESTIGATING THE KILLING OF 2 YOUTHS ON THE 15 FEB 95 AT THE BIGOGWE MILITARY CAMP (3520) BY THE RPA. THE SIU TEAM INTENDS TO EXHUME THE BODIES AT THE SECTOR OF KAJEBESHI IN THE MUTURA COMMUNE TO CONDUCT FURTHER INVESTIGATIONS. THE INVESTIGATIONS COMMENCED AT ABOUT 1015 H. HOWEVER THE RPA PATROL ARRIVED ON THE SPOT AT ABOUT 1130 H AND PREVENTED FURTHER PROGRESS OF THE WORK UNTIL THEY CHECKED FROM THE BOURGEMESTRE OF THE MUTURA COMMUNE (3223) IF THE PERMISSION HAD BEEN GRANTED. THIS WAS INSPITE OF THE FACT THAT THE TEAM HAD THE WRITTEN AUTHORISATION FOR THE TASK FROM THE PREFECT AS ALSO FROM KIGALI. THE HR 8 AND CY 9 RUSHED TO THE LOCATION TO TALK TO THE SENIOR RPA OFFICIALS WHO WERE EXPECTED IN THE LOCATION. THE RPA FINALLY GAVE THE PERMISSION TO THE TEAM TO CONTINUE THE INVESTIGATION HOWEVER KEPT SOLDIERS IN THE LOCATION DURING THE EXHUMATION PROCESS BUT

LATER THE SOLDIERS DISPERSED. THE TEAM SUBSEQUENTLY COMPLETED THE TASK IN A RELATIVELY CALM ATMOSPHERE AND AT THE TIME OF WRITING THIS REPORT THE TEAM WAS ON ITS WAY BACK TO GISENYI.

- 3.C. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED THE AREAS OF RUHENGIERI, NYAMUTERA (5819), NYAKINAMA (6019), GATONDE (6217), NYABIKENKE (7392) AND RUTOBWE (7880). THE PATROL WAS TASKED TO ASSESS THE SECURITY SITUATION IN THE AREA AS ALSO LIAISE WITH THE OFFICIALS AT NYAKINAMA AND GATONDE TO UPDATE THE INFORMATION PROFILE.
4. THERE WAS A ORGANISED MOVE OF THE 1959-60 CASE LOAD RETURNEE FROM THE RECEPTION CENTERS AT GISENYI TO GASHORA IN SECTOR 2 AOR. - 7.B. DARIO, A VOLCANOLOGIST BRIEFED THIS SECTOR ON THE CURRENT STATUS OF THE VOLCANO NYRIGONGO. THE CURRENT STATUS OF THE VOLCANO INDICATES THAT THE ACTIVITY IN THE CRATER IS INTERMITTENT AND THERE IS NO SUBSTANTIAL RISE IN THE LEVEL OF THE LAVA IN THE CRATER. BECAUSE THE ACTIVITY IS INTERMITTENT THE LAVA LAKE IN THE CRATER IS HARDENING AND IS NOT PRESENTLY IN THE LIQUID STATE. THIS IS A GOOD INDICATOR AND THIS WOULD NOT RESULT IN A ERUPTION IN THE NEAR FUTURE.
