GS (1) TENSION AMONG THE RPA WAS PREVAILING AFTER THE SHOOTING INCIDENT ON LAST SUNDAY NIGHT IN KIBUYE. ON INQUIRY IT WAS LEARNT THAT FEW RPA SOLDIERS ATTACKED THE RESIDENCE OF 2ND IN COMMAND OF THE BATTALION IN ORDER TO KILL HIM. BUT THE ATTACK WAS UNSUCCESSFUL. DURING THE ATTACK ONE WAS KILLED WHILE OTHER FOUR WERE ARRESTED AND PUT IN THE CUSTODY ON THE ATTACKER SIDE. THE MORAL OF THE RPA IN KIBUYE SECTOR SEEMED TO BE LOW.

(1) BOTH GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDERS REMAINED OPENED FOR ALL TRAFFIC.

(2) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT AT NYAGAHANGA, NGARAMA, NYAGATARE, KAGITUMBA AND GABIRO, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL. IT WAS REPORTED THAT A TOTAL OF 5842 PERSONS HAD ENTERED RWANDA FROM UGANDA TO RWANDA THROUGH KAGITUMBA BORDER POST OVER THE LAST WEEK.

1. SITUATION

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

b. BORDERS

(1) GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPENED TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPENED TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) THE ZAIRE BORDER REMAINED CLOSED TO UNAMIR PERS.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL. HAND OVER OF 37 RWANDESE ARRESTED IN ZAIRE DUE TO THEIR INVOLVEMENT AT KATALE REFUGEE CAMP TOOK PLACE AT GISENYI/GOMA BORDER POST AT ABOUT 1730HRS ON 27 NOV 94. PRISONERS WERE TAKEN OVER BY RPA LO AND SENT TO GISENYI PRISON. MILOBS ATTEMPT TO SEE THE PRISONERS FAILED.

(a) RPA CARRIED OUT ROUTINE DAY AND NIGHT FOOT AND MOBILE PATROLS AND MOUNTED SNAP ROAD BLOCKS IN MAJOR TOWNS AND VILLAGES THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY.

(b) RPA DEVELOPING MORE HOSTILE ATTITUDE TOWARDS UNAMIR IN SECTOR 3.

(c) SERIES OF SMALL ARMS FIRE WAS HEARD AT ABOUT 2200HRS AND 2300HRS IN RPA CAMP. INVESTIGATION REVEALED THAT THERE WAS NEAR MUTINY AMONG RPA TROOPS. MORALE OF RPA TROOPS IN SECT 4B SEEMS TO BE LOW. INVESTIGATIONS IN PROGRESS.

(2) MILITIA. NTR.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. PLANNING, COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN SECTORS CARRIED OUT DURING THE PERIOD. ASSISTANCE WAS ALSO RENDERED TO UNREO AND NGOS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOB TEAMS CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PATROLS IN BYUMBA AND GATUNA AREAS DURING THE PERIOD.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS ESCORTED HUM RIGHTS TEAM TO INVESTIGATE MASSACRE AT SAKE AND KIGARAMA.

(3) MILOBS ESCORTED 574 DPs FROM NYAMATA TO NGENDA AND GASHORA.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) SECTOR MILOBS INVESTIGATED REPORTS THAT STUDENTS AT BYIMANA WERE REFUSED ADMISSION. ACCORDING TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE SCHOOL THERE WAS LACK OF SPACE IN THE SCHOOL TO ACCOMMODATE ALL THE STUDENTS. THE ISSUE IS BEING ADDRESSED BY THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION.

(4) MALICOY PATROLLED MUTINA (1054), GAKO (1052) AND BUSSARO (9247). THE PRESENCE OF UXB WERE REPORTED AT GAKO. MALICOY ALSO ESCORTED FOOD FOR CARE TO MUSAMBIRA.

(5) MALAWICOY PATROLLED RAMBA (5414) AND REPORTED THAT MANY LOCALS WERE YET TO REPORT TO THEIR HOMES.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) SECTOR MILOBS CARRIED OUT BORDER PATROLS AND MONITORING DURING THE PERIOD. PATROLS COVERED GIKONGORO AND RWANDA/BURUNDI BORDER (REMERA GR 4299), AKABOKA (4988), GIKONGORO, RUNYOMBI AND REPORTED SIT IN AREA CALM.

(3) OTHER MILOBS PATROLS COVERED KABILIZI (5936), RUKONDO (5538), MAKERA (578399), MBOGO (615294), KAMWAMBI (634309), NYAMAGABE (545274) AND CYANIKA (5530). SIT IN AREAS REPORTED CALM.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED RELATIVELY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOB CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PATROLS TO GIKUNDAMVURA (9410), BUTAMANO (8307), KAGAMO (9840), KIRAMBO (0444) AND GATARA (1345). ABOUT 100DPs WERE REPORTED TO BE LIVING AT BUTAMANO.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED GISENYI AND BORDER POSTS, NYUNDO (248117), RUHengeri AND CYANIKA (7153), MARERO (3202), TARE (9109), RHOMBO (7534), TABA (7827), KIVUMO (2405), KORA (3922), RUSIA (3027) AND OTHER AREAS WITHIN THE SECTOR.

(3) MILOBS ESCORTED UNHCR OFFICIALS TO RWERERE (2822) AND OTHER AREAS DURING THE PERIOD.

(5) MILOBS CARRIED OUT HEL SEARCH FOR MISSION UNHCR EXPATRIATE BETWEEN JAMBA AND GUMBA BUT COULD NOT LOCATE HIM.

(6) MILOBS LOCATED A CORPSE AT LAKE KIVU BEACH (6117). BODY WAS WASHED ASHORE 3 DAYS EARLIER. NO WOUNDS FOUND ON BODY BUT HEAD NOT PRESENT.

i. SECTOR 6 - KIGALI

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI AND ITS SUBURBS WAS RELATIVELY CALM.

(2) MILOBS ESCORTED A CONVOY OF 10 UNHCR VEHICLES WITH 574 DPs FROM KIGALI TO KAZENZE.

a. THE BYUMBA ORPHANAGE RUN BY WORLD VISION REQUESTED UNAMIR ASSISTANCE TO PROVIDE A TRUCK TO CARRY FUEL WOOD.

b. THE AMFREF DIRECTOR IN CHARGE OF BYUMBA HOSPITAL COMPLAINED OF LACK OF QUALIFIED NURSES AND LAB AND BLOOD TRANSFUSION EQPT.

c. DPs AT NYAMATA AND GASHORA COMPLAINED OF LACK OF RELIEF ITEMS.

d. MALAWI COY MED STAFF TREATED 50 PATIENTS AT KIGEMBE.

e. MILOBS INVESTIGATED ALLEGED ARREST OF ONE MISS ANCILLA MUNGANYINGA BY RPA AT NYABISINDU (6940). THE LADY WORKED AT THE KAMWAMBE CAMP AND WAS BEING DETAINED AT NYANZA (7140). THE CASE IS BEING HANDLED BY HUM RIGHTS COMMISSION.

f. ADRA IS REHABILITATING ROAD BETWEEN MUBUGA (2463) AND MARA (2067).

g. THE MURURU CAMP AT CYANGUGU HAD BEEN VACATED EXCEPTED FOR A FEW ORPHANS WHO ARE STILL STRANDED AT THE CAMP. THE CLINIC AT THE CAMP IS LEFT OPENED FOR USE BY KAMEMBE LOCALS.

h. APPRX 2,200 REFUGEES ARE AWAITING EVAC AT KARMABO (0444).

5. CIVILIAN AFFAIRS. LOCALS AT BUTARE ORGANIZED ROAD REHABILITATION WITHIN THE TOWN.



(1) THE RPA ESTABLISHED A CAMP AT NYARUBUYE IN SECTOR 2.

(2) THE RPA REPORTED THAT THE ZAIREAN SOLDIERS WHO WERE INVOLVED IN THE ATTACK OF 26 NOV 94 WERE ARRESTED IN CYANGUGU. BUT IT WAS NOT SURE THAT WHETHER THE REPORT OF THE RPA WAS CONFIRMED OR NOT. THE RPA OFFICER ALSO INDICATED THAT IN FUTURE SUCH ATTACK WOULD BE REPLIED ACCORDINGLY.

(3) AT BUSANSE (4690), THE CHIEF OF THE DPs CAMP INFORMED THE MILOB TEAM THAT 05 PERSONS OF THE CAMP WERE ARRESTED BY RPA FROM THE VILLAGE NEAR THE CAMP. THE WHEREABOUTS OF THOSE PEOPLE WERE UNKNOWN. INVESTIGATION WAS ON.

(1) ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT IN DIFFERENT ROUTES OF THE SECTOR, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) HANDING OVER OF 37 RWANDESE WHO WERE ARRESTED IN ZAIRE BECAUSE OF INVOLVEMENT IN CONFLICTS AT KATALE REFUGEE CAMP, WAS IN PROGRESS AT GISENYI/GOMA BORDER POST. OFFICIALS FROM UNHCR AND ICPC WERE PRESENT IN THE LOCATION.







(1) CMO AND DCMO WENT TO BUTARE AND WANTED TO MEET THE PREFECT AND RPA BDE COMD TO DISCUSS THE ON GOING REFUGEE PROBLEM IN THE SECTOR BUT COULD NOT MEET AS THEY WERE NOT AVAILABLE.

b. SECTOR 1 BYUMBA.

(1) BOTH GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDER REMAINED OPENED FOR ALL TRAFFIC.

(4) ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT IN AND AROUND THE SECTOR, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.




