Thank you again for your strong support of the United Nations.

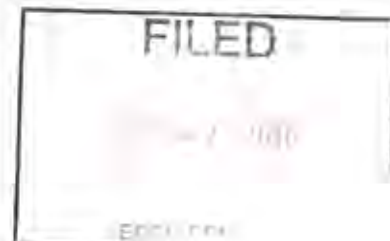
