SUBJECT: Status of Observer at the Economic and Social Council -
Invitation to Arab League and Organization of American
States. Date March 7, 1951.

The term "observer" does not have a precise well-defined legal meaning. It has been used customarily in international conferences to describe participants who may take part in the discussions, but who do not have the right to vote. As far as the Council is concerned, it has made no specific provision in its rules or resolutions for observers. It has, of course, provided for participation without vote by members of the United Nations not on the Council and similarly for representatives of Specialized Agencies. These arrangements are based specifically on Articles 69 and 70 of the Charter.

However, in the present case, it seems quite clear that if the Council adopts the proposed motion, its intention would be to follow the practice of the General Assembly, which has extended a similar invitation to the two regional organizations concerned (Res. 253 (III) and 477 (V)). The Assembly, like the Council, has no particular rules defining the status of observer, but in practice the invitation of the General Assembly to the Organization of American States and the Arab League has been construed as an act of courtesy permitting the representatives of those organizations to be present at the sessions of the General Assembly, without in itself conferring upon such representatives the right to participate in the discussions. Naturally, it is open to the General Assembly, acting through its President, to invite the representatives to address the Assembly or one of its committees, but that does not imply that the representatives are entitled to do so merely by virtue of the invitation to be present.

Unless the Council indicates otherwise, it would therefore be presumed that the OAS and the Arab League representatives invited to the Council would have the same position in the Council as the representatives of these organizations have in the General Assembly. It does not seem necessary to adopt any additions or amendments to the rules of procedure for this purpose.
