THOUGH TENSION IS NOTICABLE IN KIBUYE PREFECTURE.

KIBUYE. BN CDR OF GITARAMA HAS ALSO BEEN MADE AWARE OF THE
THEFT AND HAD PROMISED TO HAVE HIS SOLDIERS KEEP AN EYE OUT
FOR IT. THE BDE LO EXPLAINED THAT THE VEHICLE HAD BEEN TAKEN
TO CARRY A SICK SOLDIER TO KABGAYI MILITARY HOSPITAL. HE WENT
ON TO CLAIM THAT THE VEHICLE HAD NEVER ARRIVED AND THAT THE

A. GITARAMA TEAM

i) MILOB PATROL TO MASANGO(AND MURAMA CONFIRMED FIGURES OF 600 AND 3000 REGISTERED RETURNED IDPS RESPECTIVELY. WHILE ONE OFFICIAL SOURCE CLAIMED THAT THERE WERE NO PROBLEMS, LOCALS ALLEGE THAT MANY ARRESTS HAVE TAKEN PLACE. NO DETAILS OF THESE ARRESTS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE MOMENT BUT, AS SOON AS RESOURCES ARE AVAILABLE, INFORMATION GATHERING WILL RESUME.

ii) TWO TEAMS STILL ON STATION WITH SECTOR 4B.

iii) GITARAMA PRISON AUTHORITIES ARE STILL ANXIOUS TO CARRY ON PREVIOUS PLAN TO MOVE PRISONERS. THEY NOW CLAIM TO HAVE RECEIVED DIRECTION FROM THE MINISTRY OF JUSTICE TO BEGIN THE MOVE AS SOON AS TRANSPORT RESOURCES ARE AVAILABLE. IS THERE ANY INFORMATION AVAILABLE ON THIS OPERATION?

B. KIBUYE TEAM

i) CHANNEL 13 CONTINUES TO GIVE PROBLEMS IN THE KIBUYE AREA. AN INSPECTION BY A KNOWLEDGEABLE OFFICER IN THIS FIELD LED TO THE CONCLUSION THAT THERE MAY BE INTERFERENCE FROM TWO OR MORE REPEATERS IN THE SAME LOCATION.

ii) MILOB PATROL TO MABANZA (3473) FOUND THE POPULATION TENSE BECAUSE OF THE RECENT ARRESTS (17 APR) OF A SECONDARY SCHOOL INSPECTOR, AN AGRONOMIST, THE PRESIDENT OF THE FARMERS ASSOCIATION OF RWANDA AND A NURSE WORKING FOR MSF. THERE IS A CLEAR AND DISTURBING PATTERN TO THE ARRESTS IN THIS PREFECTURE.

iii) MILOB HQ SPONSORED A MEETING WITH ALL NGOS TO DISCUSS SECURITY AND TO WORK OUT EMERGENCY MEASURES TO DEAL WITH THEFT AND THREAT.

C. MALI COY

i) A COURTESY CALL ON THE BOURGEMESTRE OF MURAMA YIELDED THE INFORMATION THAT SOMEWHERE BETWEEN 3 AND 4 THOUSAND IDPS HAVE RETURNED TO THE COMMUNE IN THE PAST FIVE DAYS. 3000 HAVE BEEN REGISTERED BUT MANY OTHERS WENT RIGHT TO THEIR HOMES. HE ALSO CLAIMED THAT IN THREE SECTORS, NKOMERO, RUNYEUGAUDO AND GACU, THERE HAVE BEEN ARBITRARY ARRESTS OF IDPS ON THE BELIEF THAT THEY MUST HAVE BEEN GUILTY OF GENOCIDE. THE BOURGEMESTRE HAS CIRCULATED A PLEA FOR RESTRAINT AND HAS ASKED FOR CIVIC COOPERATION IN RESPECTING THE PROCEDURE FOR ARRESTS. THE BOURGEMESTRE MADE AN URGENT APPEAL FOR FOOD, CLOTHING, MEDICINE AND FARMING EQUIPMENT. MANY OF THE IDPS ARE WOUNDED. WITHOUT IMMEDIATE HELP, IDPS MAY HAVE NO OPTION BUT BANDITRY.

i) PRISON POPULATION OF GITARAMA PRISON HAS NOT REACHED 7,500. CIVIL AUTHORITY HAS SIGNED THE RELEASE FORMS FOR 21 PRISONERS WHO HAD BEEN CHARGED WITH MINOR CRIMES. IT IS NOT KNOWN WHETHER THEY HAVE BEEN LET GO YET.

ii) BYIMANA ORPHANAGE IS READY TO MOVE TO KABGAYI COMPLEX AND NEED OUR ASSISTANCE TO TRANSPORT 365 CHILDREN AND MATERIAL. IT IS ESTIMATED THAT FOUR VEHICLES COULD DO THE JOB IN 2 DAYS. THEY WOULD LIKE TO BEGIN THE MOVE ON THURSDAY 4 MAY.

iii) MALICOY TREATED 42 LOCAL PATIENTS TODAY AND CONDUCTED A MEDICAL ASSISTANCE VISIT TO NYANZA ORPHANAGE.

iv) KIBUYE HUMANITARIAN OFFICER REPORTS THAT NO NGO HAS VISITED NYARUBUYE COMMUNE FOR 3 MONTHS. SECURITY MEETING WAS USED TO REQUEST MORE FREQUENT VISITS.

1. ABOUT (40) FOURTY PEOPLE WERE REPORTED KILLED AT MUSENYI SECTOR (GR 2263) IN GISHYITA COMMUNE ON THE NIGHT OF 28 APRIL 95. PEOPLE KILLED WERE FLEEING TO ZAIRE TO JOIN THEIR FAMILIES AND SOME ARE SAID TO BE THOSE WHO PLAYED PART IN THE GENOCIDE.
2. THERE WERE HEAVY SHOOTING AND CONFIRMED REPORT SAID THAT THESE PEOPLE WERE KILLED BY THE RPA SOLDIERS SINCE THEY HAVE A CAMP AT RWARAMBA (GR 2063) ALONG THE SHORES OF LAKE KIVU WHICH IS NEAR THE SCENE OF INCIDENT.
3. THE BOURGEMESTRE OF GISHYITA COMMUNE IS REPORTED TO HAD ORDERED PEOPLE NOT TO REACH THE SCENE OF INCIDENT AND BY NOW THE DEAD BODIES ARE BELIEVED TO HAVE BEEN BURIED.

DATE: 24 APR 95

1. AT APPROX 1600HRS 23 APR 95, A GROUP OF IDPS ON FOOT WAS OBSERVED BEING HARASSED BY CIVILIANS ALONG THE ROAD JUST SOUTH OF BUTARE. SEVERAL WERE BLEEDING FROM HEAD WOUNDS CAUSED BY PROJECTILES HURLED AT THEM FROM THE ROADSIDE. AS MOST OF THE IDPS WERE WOMEN WITH SMALL CHILDREN AND OLD MEN, THE MILOB AT THE SCENE TURNED AND STATIONED HIS CAR TO TRY TO PROTECT THE IDPS. HELP WAS REQUESTED FROM SECTOR HQ. SEVERAL MOTHERS WITH BABIES WERE TAKEN INSIDE THE VEHICLE. AS THERE WERE NO FORMED TROOPS AVAILABLE AND NO SHELTER WHERE THE IDPS WERE, THE MILOB DIRECTED THE IDPS TO BEGIN WALKING BESIDE THE VEHICLE. BECAUSE OF THE CONFUSION OF THE DAY AND OTHER DUTIES, HE WAS THE SOLE MILOB IN THE VEHICLE.

2. WHEN THE GROUP OF IDPS AND THE VEHICLE TURNED OFF THE MAIN ROAD TO DRIVE THROUGH A SMALL VILLAGE ON THE WAY TO THE HOME COMMUNE, A CIVPOL VEHICLE CAME BY AND WAS REQUESTED TO COVER THE REAR OF THE COLUMN. THEY AGREED. AS THE CONVOY STARTED UP THE HILL, A MOB OF OVER EXCITED CHILDREN BEGAN TO THROW BRICKS AND TO HIT THE IDPS WITH STICKS. THERE WAS NO CHOICE BUT TO KEEP MOVING. THE IDPS BY THIS TIME WERE TERRIFIED AND CLIMBED ALL OVER THE OUTSIDE OF THE MILOB VEHICLE. ADULTS JOINED THE MOB AND IDPS BEGAN TO FALL. AS THE CONVOY MOVED, STRAGGLERS WERE SWARMED AND BEATEN TO DEATH BY THE MOB. AT THIS POINT THE CIVPOL VEHICLE (CALL SIGN POA) DISAPPEARED WITHOUT A WORD. APPROXIMATELY HALF WAY THROUGH THE VILLAGE, THREE CIVILIANS WITH STICKS BEAT THE MOB AWAY FROM THE VEHICLE AND THE CONVOY HALTED UNDER THEIR PROTECTION. SHORTLY AFTER, ANOTHER MILOB VEHICLE RESPONDED TO THE CALL FOR HELP AND A PASSING SENBATT VEHICLE WAS FLAGGED DOWN. TWO ARMED SENBATT SOLDIERS WERE LEFT TO PROVIDE SECURITY WHILE THE SENBATT VEHICLE WENT FOR REINFORCEMENTS.

3. AFTER TREATING THE WORST OF THE CASUALTIES AND ASSESSING THE SITUATION, IT WAS DECIDED TO LOAD THE IDPS IN AS MANY VEHICLES AS COULD BE ASSEMBLED AND TO TAKE THEM BACK TO BUTARE STADIUM FOR MEDICAL ATTENTION. BY THIS TIME, THREE MILOB VEHICLES, ONE NGO VEHICLE AND TWO SENBATT VEHICLES HAD ARRIVED. THE MOB BEGAN TO CLOSE IN AS THE IDPS WERE LOADING. STONE THROWING BEGAN IN EARNEST DESPITE THE BEST EFFORTS OF THE AFOREMENTIONED CIVILIANS WITH STICKS. THIS TIME, THE CROWD ATTACKED THE MILOB VEHICLES AND

THE NGO VEHICLE. THOUGH THERE WAS NO SERIOUS DAMAGE, THE COMPLETE LACK OF DETERRENT VALUE OF UN INSIGNIA WAS APPARENT.

4. IT IS ESTIMATED THAT BETWEEN 10 AND 15 IDPS LOST THEIR LIVES IN THIS INCIDENT. THERE WERE NO BODIES EVIDENT WHEN THE CONVOY RETRACED ITS STEPS; PROBABLY BECAUSE THOSE WHO HAD BEEN OBSERVED BEING CLUBBED TO DEATH WERE DRAGGED OFF THE ROAD. THERE WERE 15 WOUNDED. MOST OF THE CASUALTIES WERE WOMEN ENCUMBERED WITH SMALL CHILDREN THOUGH MANY OF THE BABIES THAT COULD NOT BE PASSED INTO THE CAR ALSO SUFFERED HEAD WOUNDS. THE ATTACK WAS STARTED BY HYSTERICAL ADOLESCENTS AND PRESSED HOME BY ADULTS. MOST OF THE VILLAGE SEEMED TO PARTICIPATE AND IT APPEARED TO GIVE THEM CONSIDERABLE JOY TO BE ABLE TO HELP CLUB WOMEN AND CHILDREN TO DEATH. THIS ATTACK WAS INDISTINGUISHABLE FROM INTERAHAMWE ACTIONS OBSERVED LAST YEAR.

5. SEVERAL SMALL GROUPS OF RPA PASSED BY DURING THE TROUBLE AND DID NOTHING TO ASSIST. THE MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT FOR THE AREA MADE A SHORT SPEECH TO THE MILOB DURING A PAUSE IN THE ACTION BUT REFUSED TO HELP. HE CLAIMED THAT HE COULD DO NOTHING. THE ONLY REASON THAT THIS DID NOT TURN INTO A SMALL SCALE MASSACRE IS THAT 3 BRAVE RWANDESE CIVILIANS STOPPED IT. THE UTTER LACK OF RESPECT COMMANDED BY UN INSIGNIA MAY HAVE BEEN DUE TO THE FACT THAT IT WAS SUNDAY AFTERNOON AND MANY ADULTS HAD BEEN DRINKING BEER AND GUA-GUA. WHILE IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT THIS INCIDENT SEEMS INSIGNIFICANT IN THE CONTEXT OF THE MASSACRE AT KIBEHO, IT MAY BE TYPICAL OF MANY OTHER SMALL INCIDENTS THAT WILL NOT BE REPORTED BECAUSE OF THE HECTIC PACE OF THE ACTION AND THE LACK OF TIME FOR FOLLOW UP.

1. FURTHER TO SUBJECT INCREP, IT HAS NOW BEEN CONFIRMED THAT ALL RESIDENCES IN THE TOWN OF KIBUYE WERE SEARCHED AND THAT EVERY NGO AND UN AGENCY WAS ALSO SEARCHED. TROOPS CONDUCTING THE SEARCH WERE PROFESSIONAL AND NON-CONFRONTATIONAL.
2. PREFET AND LOCAL BATTALION CDR ARE BOTH OUT OF REACH AT THE MOMENT BUT REASON FOR SEARCH MAY BE PART OF SECURITY PREPARATIONS FOR IMPENDING VISIT OF PRESIDENT. TROOPS MAY SIMPLY HAVE FAILED TO MAKE ANY DISTINCTION BETWEEN HOUSES IN THEIR ZEAL TO ASSURE PRESIDENTIAL SECURITY.
3. INVESTIGATION CONTINUES BUT, AS THERE IS NO FURTHER SIGN OF TENSION IN THE WAKE OF THIS ACTION, THE INCIDENT WILL NOT BE REPORTED FURTHER EXCEPT IN SITREPS.

1) AT AROUND 2130H ON 14 APR 95 WE RECEIVED INFO FROM SECTOR 4C THAT A LADY WORKING FOR MEDICOS EN CATASTROFE IN MBUYE HOSPITAL 8263 WAS SERIOUSLY ILL AND NEEDED EVACUATION. ONE MILOB TEAM ALONG WITH THE MALICOY DOCTOR AND ESCORT WAS DESPATCHED TO EVACUATE HER. THE RPA WAS EXTREMELY COOPERATIVE AND THE RPA LO PERSONALLY ACCOMPANIED THE TEAM TO ENSURE SAFE PASSAGE. THE PATIENT WAS BROUGHT TO GITARAMA AROUND 0130H ON 15 APR 95. SINCE AUSHMED COULD NOT SEND AN AMBULANCE AND THE AMBULANCE WITH MALICOY HAD DEVELOPED SOME MECHANICAL PROBLEMS THE SAME TEAM PROCEEDED TO AUSHMED AT KIGALI TO ADMIT THE PATIENT. THE RPA LO AGAIN SHOWED GREAT RESOURCEFULNESS AND PROVIDED THE TEAM WITH A LETTER OF AUTHORISATION TO ENSURE PASSAGE AT THE CHECK POINTS. THE TEAM RETURNED AROUND 0430H. THE PATIENT'S CONDITION IS NOT KNOWN.

(ii) NUMBER OF INMATES AT KIBUYE PRISON HAS RISEN TO 704. AN INCREASE OF 100 ADDITIONAL PRISONERS PER WEEK IS EXPECTED FROM THE COMMUNES OF KIVUMU AND BWAKIRA. EARLIER THE PRISONERS WERE SENT TO GITARAMA PRISON BUT NOW THEY ARE BEING DIVERTED TO KIBUYE AFTER THE RIOTS IN GITARAMA PRISON.

 - ii) A MILOB PATROL TO MURAMA (6749) AND MASANGO (6254) COMMUNES WAS TOLD THAT SOME PEOPLE FLED DURING THE PERIOD LEADING UP TO THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE GENOCIDE. THE BOURGEMESTRES IN BOTH PLACES INDICATED THAT THE BEST COURSE OF ACTION IS TO WAIT FOR EVENTS TO CONVINCE THESE PEOPLE THAT IT IS SAFE TO COME HOME.
 - iii) A MILOB PATROL TO NYAKABANDA COMMUNE (6507-6708) REPORTED THAT THE SITUATION WAS CALM. ON 13 APR 95 A GROUP OF RPA SOLDIERS ARRESTED AT GASOVU SECTOR TWO LOCALS AND MAINTAINED THEM IN THE COMMUNE CELL.

PEOPLE IN KIBIMBA SECTOR WERE VERY AFRAID AND MOST OF THE MEN RUN AWAY AND HID IN THE FOREST. IN THE NYAKABANDA COMMUNE OFFICE ALL LOCALS NOTIFIED THAT THE TWO MAJOR PROBLEMS WHICH ARE LIKELY TO FACE IN THIS AREA ARE THE FOLLOWING :

(1) THE UNAMIR DEPARTURE IN THIS COUNTRY MIGHT CAUSE THE OTHER GENOCIDE

(2) PEOPLE ARE VERY WORRIED SINCE THEY ARE SUSPECTING OR THINKING THAT RPA MIGHT ATTACK THE HUTUS IN THIS COMMUNE SINCE THERE ARE 50 SOLDIERS AT THE COMMUNE CENTER.

ON 13 APR 95 Mr KAREGE (TEACHER) WAS ARRESTED BY RPA BECAUSE HE IS BEING SUSPECTING TO HAVE BEEN PARTICIPATED IN THE LAST GENOCIDE.

SITREP SENT DIRECTLY DUE TO COMMUNICATION.

i) PATROLS ATTEMPTED TO MASANGO (6254) LOCALS APPRECIATED UNAMIR INTENSIVE PATROLS DURING THE LAST PERIOD .

i) A PATROL TEAM WAS SENT TO GISHYITA (2161) AND REPORTED THE GENERAL SECURITY SITUATION AS CALM. ON 13 APR 0300 HRS SOME BANDITS IN UNIFORM CAME AND FIRED SOME SHOTS IN THE AREA FOOD STUFFS AND OTHER PROPERTY WAS STOLLEN. NO CASUALTIES OR DEATH HAS BEEN REPORTED.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THERE CONTINUES TO BE RELATIVE PEACE IN THE SECTOR WITH NO SIGN OF THE DIFFICULTIES ENCOUNTERED ELSEWHERE OVER THE PAST FEW DAYS. TESNION APPEARS TO BE RISING IN THE COMMUNE OF MWENDO (4558) AFTER TWO WEEKS OF RPA HARRASSMENT. PATROLS WERE SEVERELY CURTAILED DUE TO THE HEAVY RAINS.
2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE PRIME MINISTER AND THE MINISTER OF THE INTERIOR VISITED MASANGO COMMUNE (6254) TO CONDUCT PUBLIC MEETINGS ON THE SUBJECT OF SECURITY. THE FIRST EVENT WAS A MEETING WITH SECTOR COUNSELLORS, THE COMMUNE STAFF, A CROSS SECTION OF RESPONSABLES DE CELLULES AND BOURGEMESTRES OF BOTH MASANGO AND MURAMA. IT WAS A VERY POSITIVE MEETING WITH THE DELEGATES RESPONDING TO A NUMBER OF SECURITY CONCERNS RAISED BY THE ASSEMBLED OFFICIALS. THE PRIME MINISTER EMPHASIZED THE NECESSITY OF HAVING EVIDENCE BEFORE MAKING AN ACCUSATION, THE NEED FOR TRUTH, THE NEED TO AVOID HOLDING RELATIVES RESPONSIBLE FOR ACTIONS OF AN INDIVIDUAL FAMILY MEMBER, THE IMPORTANCE OF FAIR COMPENSATION FOR CATTLE EATEN DURING THE WAR AND THE IMPORTANCE OF NOT INSISTING ON MORE THAN A COW IS WORTH. HIS COMMENTS WERE WELL RECEIVED BY THE POPULACE BUT IT IS NOT KNOWN HOW THE ARMY TOOK THEM. IT IS INTERESTING TO NOTE THAT THE BDE CDR WAS REPRESENTED BY ONE OF HIS BATTALION CDRS. COMMENT ALL THE AUTHORITIES WHO SPOKE AT THIS MEETING ACKNOWLEDGED THE PROBLEMS OF FALSE ARREST, FALSE ACCUSATION AND ASSIGNMENT OF COLLECTIVE BLAME THAT HAVE BEEN RUMOURED FOR WEEKS. THE DISCUSSION CENTERED ON REASONS WHY PEOPLE FLED FROM THEIR HOMES OR WHY THEY SLEPT IN THE FIELDS.
3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES
 - A. RPA.
 - i) AN RPA SOLDIER, WHOSE CAR HAD BEEN DAMAGED AS A RESULT OF AN ACCIDENT WITH A CARE INTERNATIONAL OFFICIAL, TRIED TO TAKE HER CAR BY FORCE. WHEN MILOBS AND CIVPOL ARRIVED AT THE CARE OFFICE WHERE HE WAS TRYING TO ASSERT HIS RIGHT TO THE CAR KEYS, HE ARGUED THAT HE SHOULD HAVE ACCESS TO HER VEHICLE WHILE HIS CAR WAS BEING REPAIRED SINCE THE ACCIDENT WAS HER FAULT. AFTER DISCUSSION, IT

WAS AGREED AMICABLY THAT CARE WOULD RENT HIM A VEHICLE FOR THE TWO DAYS REQUIRED FOR REPAIRS TO BE COMPLETED ON HIS CAR.

i) HEAVY RAIN CANCELLED PLANNED PATROLS TODAY. MILOBS ATTENDED POLITICAL MEETING AND DEALT WITH LOCAL PROBLEM AT CARE INTERNATIONAL.

) ii) PRISON TRANSFER. CANCELLED. RESOURCES RETURNED TO UNITS EXCEPT FOR GHANBAT VEHS WHICH WERE HELD UP FOR MECHANICAL REASONS. ASSISTANCE OF INDBAT, GHANBAT AND SECTOR 5 MILOBS GREATLY APPRECIATED.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

i) A MILOB TEAM INVESTIGATED THE ALLEGED LANDINGS OVER THE PAST FIVE DAYS AT RWABISINDU (1759), KILIMBI (1049) AND MYABINAGA (1351). REPULSED BY RPA IN EACH CASE. NO PRISONERS. AN RPA MED SGT WHO WAS GIVEN A LIFT STATED THAT THERE HAVE BEEN FOUR RPA KILLED BY INTRUDERS DURING THE LAST MONTH AND ANOTHER 15 WOUNDED. HE ALSO CLAIMED THAT GROUPS ARE NOW COMING ASHORE WITH MORTARS AND MGS. NOTE: THERE APPEAR TO BE TWO TYPES OF INCURSIONS; THOSE IN RWAMATAMU COMMUNE ARE AGGRESSIVE WHILE THOSE IN GISHYITA AND GITESI COMMUNES AVOID CONTACT IN FAVOUR OF FOOD.

ii) A MILOB PATROL TO TOWN OF MUTUNTU (3554) IN MWENDO COMMUNE FOUND SITUATION WORSENING. RPA APPEAR TO HAVE A FREE HAND. THEY ALLEGEDLY COERCED A LOCAL TEACHER INTO SELLING THEM HIS MOTORCYCLE FOR A VERY LOW PRICE AND THEN DEMANDED THAT THE MONEY BE RETURNED; THEY KEPT THE MONEY. THERE WERE TWO PERSONS BROUGHT INTO THE HOSPITAL IN MWENDO WHO CLAIMED TO HAVE BEEN BEATEN BY THE RPA. IT IS ALLEGED THAT THERE IS A SELF PROCLAIMED KING OF MWENDO WHO WIELDS POWER BY BLACKMAILING PEOPLE WITH PICTURES TAKEN DURING THE GENOCIDE. THE OBJECTS OF HIS ACTION PROTEST THEIR INNOCENCE BUT PAY TO BECAUSE THEY FEAR ARREST. THE DOUBLE MURDER REPORTED EARLIER APPEARS NOW TO HAVE BEEN A TRIPLE MURDER BUT DETAILS ARE VERY SCKETCHY.

iii) A MILOB PATROL TO MARA SECTOR (2068) OF GISHYITA COMMUNE LEARNED THAT BANDITS HAD STOLEN CATTLE YESTERDAY.

THEY ARE BELEIVED TO HAVE BEEN FROM IJWE ISLAND AND ARE SAID TO HAVE TAKEN THEIR FAMILIES BACK WITH THEM. REPORTS OF TUTSIS APPROPRIATING CATTLE FROM HUTUS PERSIST. ARRESTS CONTINUE; TWO LAST WEEK. YESTERDAY A MAN WAS ALLEGEDLY KILLED WHILE FLEEING RPA CUSTODY. TO BE INVESTIGATED.

iv) FURTHER TO THE REPORT OF KILLING IN KAYENZI ON 9 APR, BOURGEMESTRE OF GITESI STATED TODAY THAT DECEASED WAS SHOT WHEN HE ATTACKED THE RPA GUARDS WHO WERE QUESTIONING HIM.

i) PATROLS ATTEMPTED TO MBUE (8365) AND MURAMBI (5260) BUT NO INFO GATHERED DUE TO HEAVY RAIN AND LACK OF VISIBLE INHABITANTS. ROADS VERY DANGEROUS.

i) PATROL TO MURABA (2055) HEARD COMPLAINTS OF HARRASSMENT BY RPA AT NIGHT AND THEFT OF CATTLE.

5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

i) MALICOY AND GHANBAT PROVIDED 3 TRUCKS TO LWF TO COMPLETE DISTR OF KITCHEN SETS TO NTONGWE COMMUNE.

ii) MALICOY HAS BEEN PROVIDING MEALS FOR TWO DAYS TO 3 NEWLY ARRIVED MAGISTRATES. MILOBS HAVE BEEN PROVIDING TRANSPORT.

iii) MALICOY EVACUATED SEVERAL LOCAL ACCIDENT VICTIMS FROM THE MASANGO ROAD TO GITARAMA HOSPITAL.

iv) BYIMANA ORPHANAGE ADVISED OF IMPENDING MOVE TO KABGUYI. THEY WILL REQUIRE TRANSPORT FOR 365 CHILDREN AND AND LIFT FOR AN INDETERMINATE AMOUNT OF SUPPLIES ON 15 APR. DETAILED REQUEST WILL BE SUBMITTED THROUGH HAC TOMORROW AFTER RECCE AND PLAN.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THIS SECTOR HAS EXPERIENCED NONE OF THE ANTAGONISM TOWARDS UNAMIR THAT OCCURRED IN KIGALI AND GISENYI. SO FAR THERE HAS BEEN NO INDICATION OF IMPENDING TROUBLE OF THIS KIND. ON THE CONTRARY, THE LOCAL BATTALION COMMANDER VISITED THIS MORNING AS SOON AS HE HEARD OF THE TROUBLE IN GISENYI TO REASSURE US THAT ALL WOULD BE QUIET HERE. THE LOCAL RPA CONTINUE TO ACT IN A RESTRAINED MANNER IN THEIR DEALINGS WITH THE PUBLIC; BUT THE ARRESTS CONTINUE. DESPITE THE AGITATION IN OTHER SECTORS, THE MAIN ACTIVITY IN THIS SECTOR TODAY SEEMED TO BE ASKING UNAMIR FOR HELP. ONE WONDERS IF A SENSE OF SHAME IS PART OF THE LOCAL PSYCHE.
2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. NTR .
3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES
 - A. RPA. LOCAL BN CDR ADVISED TODAY THAT PRISONERS IN THIS SECTOR ARE BEING HELD IN THE COMMUNAL CACHOT UNTIL SPACE IS AVAILABLE IN THE OFFICIAL JAILS. HE WENT ON TO SAY THAT WE MIGHT VISIT THEM AT ANY TIME IF WE SO WISHED AND EXPLAINED THAT FEEDING THESE PRISONERS IS PROBLEMATIC SINCE THE RELATIVES WHO BRING FOOD OFTEN LIVE TOO FAR AWAY TO BRING FOOD OFTEN. ICRC TO BE CONTACTED TO DISCUSS POSSIBILITY OF FORMALIZING SOME SORT OF FEEDING ARRANGEMENTS.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.
 - A. GITARAMA TEAM
 - i) COMBINED HUMAN RIGHTS/MILOB PATROL WENT TO MUSAMBIRA COMMUNE TO FOLLOW UP THE CASE OF THE TEACHER WHO HAD PREVIOUSLY SOUGHT REFUGE WITH SECTOR 3 AND HAD BEEN CONVINCED TO RETURN HOME. THOUGH IT WAS EARLIER REPORTED THAT THERE WERE NO WITNESSES AGAINST HIM AT THE PUBLIC MEETING HELD ON SUNDAY, TODAY THERE WERE MANY. IN VIEW OF THE LONG LIST OF CRIMES HE IS NOW ACCUSED OF AND THE SUDDEN EASE WITH WHICH WITNESSES WERE FOUND, IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THE CASE AGAINST HIM

IS LARGELY INVENTION. HE IS ALLEGED TO HAVE BEEN PERSONALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DEATHS OF OVER 130 PEOPLE, THE THEFT OF AN UNSPECIFIED NUMBER OF COWS, DESTRUCTION OF HOUSES, RUMOUR MONGERING AND GENERALLY DISTURBING THE PEACE. IT IS HARD TO BELIEVE THAT THESE CRIMES WERE NOT KNOWN OF AT THE TIME OF THE PUBLIC REVIEW OF HIS CASE OR THAT THEY WERE NOT SUFFICIENT TO HAVE HAD HIM ARRESTED EARLIER.

ii) COMBINED HUMAN RIGHTS/MILOB PATROL SPOKE WITH EXPATRIOT WITH 25 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN RWANDA WHO SUGGESTED THAT THERE IS A CAMPAIGN AGAINST HUTU INTELLECTUALS AND THAT THE GOVERNMENT INTENDS TO LET AS MANY PEOPLE DIE IN PRISONS AND CACHOTS AS POSSIBLE. HE ALSO CLAIMED THAT THE PEOPLE ARE VERY UPSET BY WHAT THEY BELIEVE TO BE A COMMON PRACTICE OF GIVING FALSE WITNESS. FINALLY, HE STATED THAT HE EXPECTED THERE TO BE AGITATION AGAINST UNAMIR, NGOS AND OTHER AGENCIES OVER THE NEXT FEW WEEKS.

iii) A CIVPOL PATROL TO NYAMABYI COMMUNE FOLLOWED UP THE CITIZENS WHO HAD SOUGHT SHELTER WITH SECTOR HQ IN THE DAYS LEADING UP TO THE ANNIVERSARY AND FOUND THAT THERE WERE NO PROBLEMS. ALL WILL BE CONTACTED REGULARLY OVER THE NEXT FEW WEEKS.

iv) A COMBINED HUMAN RIGHTS/MILOB PATROL TO MUSHUBATI COMMUNE (6970) INSPECTED THE COMMUNAL CACHOT ACCOMPANIED BY THE BOURGEMESTRE. THERE WERE 38 PERSONS BEING DETAINED FOR GENOCIDE. THE BOURGEMESTRE EXPLAINED THE REVIEW PROCESS BUT APPEARED TO BE OUT OF HIS DEPTH; HE HAD LITTLE UNDERSTANDING OF STANDARDS OF PROOF OR RULES OF EVIDENCE. THE PATROL WENT ON TO GIKOMERO SECTOR (6472) TO CHECK ON THE CONDITION OF 3 PERSONS WHO HAD PREVIOUSLY SOUGHT REFUGE WITH THIS HQ. TWO OF THEM WERE FOUND, THE WIFE OF THE THIRD SAID THAT HE HAD GONE TO KIGALI TO WORK. TWO NAMES WERE PROVIDED: NEMDAHIMANA (AGED 70) AND GAHIGI (AGED 60).

v) A MILOB PATROL TO KAYENZI (3470) AND NYABIKENKE (7292) COMMUNES FOUND THE TENSION PRESENT LAST WEEK TO HAVE EASED CONSIDERABLY WITH THE EXCEPTION OF RUMOURS CIRCULATING ABOUT THE IMMINENT RETURN OF FRGF ALLEGEDLY SPREAD BY FORMER INTERHAMWE IN HIDING. THE BOURGEMESTRE OF KAYENZI REQUESTED TRANSPORT TO CARRY MATERIALS FOR REBURIAL CEREMONY AND FUEL FOR THE GENERATORS RECENTLY REPAIRED BY UNAMIR TECHS FROM KIGALI. WE WILL ARRANGE.

vi) PRISON TRANSFER. NO PRISONERS TRANSFERRED TODAY. ORDERS RECEIVED TO POSTPONE TOMORROW'S OP.

B.KIBUYE TEAM

i) A MILOB TEAM CARRIED THE ASSISTANT BOURGEMESTRE FROM

RUTSIRO (3183) TO KAGANO (3683) WHERE HE SPOKE AT LENGTH ABOUT GENOCIDE AND OTHER TOPICS COVERED ELSEWHERE DURING THE ANNIVERSARY SPEECHES.

ii) A SECOND PATROL WENT TO MWENDO (4558) COMMUNE TO INVESTIGATE PREVIOUSLY REPORTED DOUBLE HOMICIDE ON 30 MAR. THE BOURGEMESTRE CLAIMED THAT HE HAD INVESTIGATED THE FOLLOWING DAY AND HAD CONCLUDED THAT THE ATTACKERS, THOUGH DRESSED IN MILITARY CLOTHING, WERE REFUGEES FROM ONE OF THE CAMPS. A MILOB WHO HAD PARTICIPATED IN BOTH INTERVIEWS THOUGHT THAT JUDGING FROM THE FEAR IN THE FACES AROUND HIM, THE RPA MAY WELL HAVE BEEN INVOLVED.

iii) A MILOB PATROL TO KAYENZI (3470) SENT TO FOLLOW UP THE INVESTIGATION OF THE INCIDENT REPORTED BY MALAWICOY OF A MURDER ON 9 APR HEARD THE FOLLOWING VERSION OF EVENTS FROM A WITNESS WHO REFUSED TO IDENTIFY HIMSELF:

AT ABOUT 1500, THE RPA WENT TO KIRAMBO VILLAGE (3765) TO ARREST NDAGIJE (DECEASED) ON SUSPICION OF GENOCIDE. HE WAS TAKEN TO KAYENZI WHERE HE WAS INTERROGATED AND BEATEN. HE TRIED TO DEFEND HIMSELF BY STRIKING A SOLDIER AND WAS ORDERED SHOT BY THE LOCAL RPA CDR.

THE RPA LO DISMISSED THE KILLING AS A LOCALLY MOTIVATED MURDER HAVING NOTHING TO DO WITH THE RPA.

THE PEOPLE HAVE NO HARVEST AND CONSEQUENTLY, NO FOOD. EMERGENCY DELIVERY MAY BE NECESSARY. WILL LIAISE LOCALLY WITH NGOS TO DETERMINE BEST COURSE OF ACTION.

THE ATTITUDE OF THE LOCAL BDE CDR AND MOST RPA OFFICERS IN THIS AREA CONTINUES HARDLINE. MANY HAVE EXPRESSED THE BELIEF THAT THE ONLY EXCUSE FOR FEAR IS GUILT AND THUS THEY ARE PRONE TO ASSUME GUILT WHEN ANYONE CRINGES OR FLEES. MILOBS WILL TRY TO GET MORE INFO TOMORROW.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.
 - A. GITARAMA TEAM
 - i) COMBINED HUMAN RIGHTS/MILOB PATROL TO MUSAMBIRA COMMUNE FOUND THE TEACHER WHO HAD PREVIOUSLY SOUGHT REFUGE WITH SECTOR 3 AND HAD BEEN CONVINCED TO RETURN HOME IS STILL IN THE COMMUNAL CACHOT. TODAY IT APPEARED THAT THE MAIN REASON FOR HIS DETENTION IS THAT HE HAD THE TEMERITY TO SEEK HELP FROM THE PREFET (HUTU) RATHER THAN THE BOURGEMESTRE (TUTSI). ON REVIEWING THE EVIDENCE PRESENTED AT THE PUBLIC MEETING LAST SUNDAY, THE HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM HAVE DIFFICULTY UNDERSTANDING THE BASIS FOR HIS DETENTION. THERE IS SOME SUSPICION THAT HE

IS BEING HELD SIMPLY BECAUSE OF HIS STATUS AS AN INTELLECTUAL. THIS CASE WILL CONTINUE TO BE MONITORED CLOSELY. OTHER PERSONS WHO HAD TAKEN REFUGE WITH THIS SECTOR WERE REPORTED TO BE IN PEACE BUT DIRECT CONTACT COULD NOT BE MADE BECAUSE OF HEAVY RAINS AND ROAD CONDITIONS.

ii) A COMBINED MILOB/HUMAN RIGHTS PATROL TO TAMBWE COMMUNE FAILED TO FIND ANY EVIDENCE TO SUBSTANTIATE THE ALLEGATION OF MURDER MADE AGAINST THE RPA BY ONE OF THE WOMEN WHO SOUGHT REFUGE HERE LAST WEEK. THE WOMAN WHO MADE THE ALLEGATION WAS REPORTED BY HER NEIGHBOURS TO HAVE BEEN KILLED IN AUGUST. A PATROL WILL ATTEMPT TO FIND HER AGAIN IN THE NEXT FEW DAYS.

iii) MILOB PATROL TO MUGINA COMMUNE FOUND CONTINUED COMPLAINTS OF ARBITRARY ARRESTS AND HEARD FROM FAMILIES OF PERSONS BEING HELD IN THE COMMUNAL CACHOT THAT THEY HAVE NO ACCESS TO THEIR LOVED ONES. THEY DELIVER FOOD BUT HAVE NO IDEA IF IT REACHES THEIR MEN OR NOT.

iv) PRISON TRANSFER. NO PRISONERS TRANSFERRED TODAY. NO CONFIRMATION FOR TOMORROW. MILOB TEAM ARRIVED TO ASSIST WITH OP FROM GISENIE. TOTAL OF SIX TCV AVAIL FOR OP: 2 FROM GHANBAT, 4 FROM INDBAT (5TH VEH OFF ROAD). ALL PARTICIPANTS ARE STANDING BY AND SHOULD BE ABLE TO BEGIN OP QUICKLY ONCE ORDER IS GIVEN.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

i) ONLY ONE PATROL WAS SUCCESSFUL IN ITS ATTEMPT TO GATHER INFO TODAY BECAUSE OF ROAD CONDITIONS. THE PATROL INSPECTED THE DISPENSARY AT NIANGA (5622) AND FOUND THAT IT IS RUN BY MSF, TREATS 100 PATIENTS PER DAY AND IS CRITICALLY SHORT OF MATTRESSES.

ii) OPS O CONDUCTED LIAISON VISIT TO SECTOR 4C TO INVESTIGATE SIMILARITY OF SECURITY SITUATION. THERE WAS NO DISCERNABLE PATTERN LINKING THE TWO. 4C REPORTS APPROX 15% OF INCIDENTS ATTRIBUTABLE TO RPA WHEREAS 3A REPORTS APPROX 90%.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE SITUATION CONTINUES TO BE CHALLENGING. WHILE THE LOCAL BDE CDR COOPERATED WITH SECT CDR TO DEAL WITH THE PROBLEM OF PERSONS SEEKING REFUGE THIS MORNING, HIS TROOPS HALTED A MOVE OF ORPHANS FROM SHOGWE WHICH HAD BEEN DIRECTED BY THE MINISTRY OF THE INTERIOR AND SOCIAL AFFAIRS. KIBUYE SUB SECTOR REPORTS THAT THE LOCALS ARE STILL NERVOUS BUT UNSURE WHY.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

(A) GITARAMA TEAM:-

i) SECTOR HQ STAFF, HUMAN RIGHTS MONITORS AND MILOBS COORDINATED A MEETING INVOLVING THE LOCAL BDE CDR, PREFET OF GITARAMA, PROCUREUR AND BOURGEMESTRE OF NYAMABUYE COMMUNE TO TRY TO CONVINCE THE 150 PERSONS SEEKING REFUGE AQT SECTOR HQ TO RETURN TO THEIR HOMES. THE INITIATIVE REQUIRED MOST OF THE MORNING WITH PEOPLE VISIBLY RELUCTANT TO TAKE THE AUTHORITIES WORD FOR THEIR SECURITY. ONE CITIZEN POINTED OUT TO THE BOURGEMESTRE THAT HE MIGHT BE A GOOD PERSONSBUT WITHOUT A GUN HE COULD DO NOTHING AGAINST THOSE WHO WERE HARRASSING HIM. THE PEOPLE WERE EVENTUALLY CONVINCED AFTER THE BDE CDR PROMISED TO DEAL WITH TWO PARTICULARLY BAD CASES PERSONALLY AND AFTER IT WAS AGREED THAT PEOPLE WOULD BE ESCORTED HOME BY MILOBS AND REGIBSTERED BY HUMAN RIGHTS. THEY WERE PROMISED FREQUENT FOLLOW UP B Y MILOBS. BY 1600 MOST OF THE PEOPLE HAD BEEN RETURNED TO THEIR HOMES BY MALICOY TRUCKS AND MILOBS, NO INCIDENTS REPORTED.

ii) MILOB/CIVPOL PATROL TO MURAMA COMMUNE FOUND THE SITUATION

CALM WITH NO EVIDENCE OF TROUBLE. PEOPLE WERE OBSERVED WORKING IN THEIR FIELDS BUT THERE WAS NO MARKET ACTIVITY. SIMILAR SITUATION WAS OBSERVED IN RUNDA COMMUNE BUT CONVERSATION WITH THE BOURGEMESTRE AND A PRIEST REVEALED THAT THERE IS A HIGH LEVEL OF ANXIETY OVER THE CONTINUED VENGEFUL ATTITUDE OF THE RPA. DURING A PUBLIC MEETING YESTERDAY, THE RPA REP SPOKE AGGRESSIVELY. THREE PERSONS WERE ARRESTED TODAY. FURTHER, EARLIER THIS WEEK, A WOMAN WAS BEATEN SO BADLY BY AN RPA SOLDIER THAT SHW HAD TO BE EVACUATED BY ICRC. LAST, THE BOURGEMESTRE OF RUNDA PROVIDED THE TEAM WITH A SCHEDULE OF REMEMBRANCE ACTIVITIES FOR THE COMING WEEK.

(B) KIBUYE TEAM:-

(i) A MILOB PATROL CARRIED THE BOURGEMESTRE OF RUTSIRO TO MURUNDA (3088) TO ADDRESS A PUBLIC MEETING. THE ACTIVITY WAS SUCCESSFUL.

(ii) A MILOB PATROL TO GITWA (4071) AND KIGEYO (3978) LEARNED THAT THE TENSION HAS RELAXED A LITTLE BUT NOT SO MUCH THAT LOCALS STOP SLEEPING IN THE FIELDS. FIVE ARRESTS THIS WEEK IN KIGEYO BUT NO NAMES AVAILABLE.

(iii) A MILOB PATROL TO RWAMATAMU (1557) COMMUNE FOUND THE TOWN NEARLY DESERTED. THE PATROL WAS FOLLOWED BY AN RPA

PATROL WHO TRIED TO TELL THEM THAT THEY NEEDED SPECIAL CLEARANCE TO BE THERE. AFTER PERSUADING THE RPA OTHERWISE, THE PATROL HEARD FROM THE RPA THEMSELVES THAT THEY HAD ARRESTED A LARGE NUMBER OF PEOPLE, ALL OF WHOM WERE FUILTY OF GENOCIDE.

(iv) A FOURTH MILOB PATROL TO THE TWON OF MURAMBI (4755) FOLLOWED UP AN INCIDENT REPORT FROM SEVERAL DAYS AGO ERRONEOUSLY REPORTED TO HAQVE OCURRED IN MUKONGO. ON 30 MAR 95, FIVE RPA SOLDIERS ENTERED THE HOUSE OF NDAHMANA ENEAS AND WERE ADVISED BY HIS WIFE THAT HE WOULD PROBABLY BE FOUND AT THE HOUSE OF HIS SECOND WIFE. ON ARRIVAL AT THE SECOND HOUSE, THE SOLDIERS WERE TOLD THAT ENEAS WAS IN TOWN. THE SOLDIERS BOUND THE WIFE AND WATCHMAN AND TOOK THEM BOTH TO TWON WHERE THEY FOUND ENEAS, TIED HIM UP, AND TOOK HIM BACK TO THE FIRST HOUSE. THERE, THE SOLDIERS ASKED IF HE HAD A SON. WHEN HE AFFIRMED THAT HE DID, THE SON WAS CALLED INTO THE HOUSE AND SHOT IN THE HEAD IN FRONT OF ENEAS AND HIS WIVES. (DECEASED IS BIZIYAREMYE, BALTAZAR, AGED 21) THE SOLDIERS THEN STOLE ALL OF ENEAS, MONEY (200,000RF) , RANSACKED BOTH OF HIS HOUSES AND THEN MURDERED HIM. BOTH WIVES AND ONE LOCAL WITNESS VERIFIED THE INCIDENT BUT REFUSED TO INENTIFY THE SOLDIERS. THE MILOB TEAM COULD NOT FIND THE SOUS-PREFET OR BOURGEMESTRE TO FOLLOW UP

(C) MALI COY:-

(i) MALICOY PATROLS IN THE NTONGWE AND MUNANIRA (5557) SECTORS FOUND THE SITUATION CALM. A THIRD PATROL TO NYMUGALI (8057) HAD A VEHICOLE ACCIDENT CAUSING FIVE MINOR INJURIES.

(ii) MALICOY PROVIDED TWO VEHICLES AND ESCORTS TO FERRY APPROX 100 LOCALS WHO HAD SOUGHT PROTECTION AT SECT HQ BACK TO THEIR HOMES.

D. MALAWICOY :-

(i) PATROLS SENT TO MARA (2067) AND MUSHUBATI (3278) COMMUNES. SIT CALM BUT THE PATROLS SENSED A GENERAL UNEASINESS IN THE AREAS VISITED.

HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES:-

(i) HUMANITARIAN OFFR ATTEMPTED TO COORD THE MOVE OF ORPHANS FROM SHOGWE ORPHANAGE TO A NEW SITE. THE INIATIVE PROCEEDED WITH THE USUAL CONFUSTION UNTIL THE RPA DECIDED THAT IT SHOULD STOP. DESPITE THE FACT THAT THE MOVE WAS ORDERED BY THE MINISTER OF THE INTERIOR AND THAT THE KITCHEN AND SLEEPING MATERIAL HAD ALRERADY BEEN MOVED, THE LOCAL RPA STOPPED A SECOND TRIP FROM HAPPENING. THIS HAD THE EFFECT OF SEPARATING THE CHILDREN FROM FOOD AND BEDDING. PERMISSION TO PROCEED WAS RECEIVED JUST BEFORE LAST LIGHT AND THE MOVE IS STILL GOING ON.

(ii) MALAWICOY EVACUATED A PATIENT TO KIBUYE HOSPITAL.

DETENTION CENTRE, JUST BEHIND THE COMMUNE OFFICE. THE RPA GRABBED THEIR WEAPONS AND SEALED ALL ENTRANCES. NOBODY WOULD TALK TO THE TEAM. DEDUCTION IS THAT THERE MAY HAVE BEEN AN ESCAPE. NO SHOTS FIRED.

iv) A CIVPOL/MILOB PATROL TO TABA COMMUNE FOUND THE AREA HAS RESISTED THAT INSECURITY THAT HAS SWEEPED UP MOST OF THE GITARAMA PREFECTURE. THERE HAVE BEEN VERY FEW ARRESTS AND THE BOURGEMESTRE HAS BEEN SUCCESSFUL IN GETTING BOTH ETHNIC GROUPS TO COOPERATE THROUGH A SERIES OF PUBLIC MEETINGS. THIS INFO WAS VERIFIED BY A CROSS SECTION OF LOCALS FROM DIFFERENT SECTORS.

v) A MOTORCYCLE PATROL TO RUTOBWE AND KAYENZI COMMUNES FOUND THE AREA VERY CALM.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. TENSION REMAINS HIGH BUT THERE HAVE BEEN A FEW SMALL SUCCESSES TODAY IN THE FIGHT TO KEEP CONTROL. A LARGE EXODUS IN ONE OF OUR NORTHERN COMMUNES WAS HALTED BY A JOINT RPA/CIVIL PUBLIC MEETING AND TENSION AMONG THOSE SEEKING REFUGE AT GITARAMA WAS REDUCED NOTICEABLY AFTER A CONCERTED EFFORT BY THE GITARAMA HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM AND THE PREFET OF GITARAMA. FURTHER, THE BOURGEMESTRE OF MUSAMBIRA, ONE OF OUR MOST DIFFICULT COMMUNES IN THE PAST, WAS ESCORTED BY MILOBS AND HUMAN RIGHTS ON A TOUR OF PUBLIC MEETINGS TO CALM PEOPLE IN HIS COMMUNE. ON THE OTHER HAND, THERE HAS BEEN A SLIGHT INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF PERSONS SEEKING REFUGE AND IN PERSONS FLEEING THEIR HOMES FOR PARTS UNKNOWN. IN ADDITION, THE TENSION IN THE PREFECTURE OF KIBUYE NOW SEEMS TO HAVE SPREAD NORTH TO RUTSIRO AND EAST TO MWENDO.
2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE PREFET OF GITARAMA AND MANY BOURGEMESTRES WERE OBSERVED CONDUCTING PUBLIC MEETINGS IN AN EFFORT TO CALM PEOPLE'S FEARS. PLANS FOR BEREAVEMENT WEEK ACTIVITIES VARY BY COMMUNE THOUGH THERE IS A GENERAL THEME TYING THEM ALL TOGETHER: DISCUSSION OF CAUSES OF GENOCIDE, DISCUSSION OF MEANS OF AVOIDING REPETITION AND PLANNING FOR RECONCILIATION.
3. FACIIONAL ACTIVITIES
 - A. RPA.
 - i) THERE SEEMED TO BE A NUMBER OF SOLDIERS OFF DUTY TODAY IN THE GITARAMA AREA. BOTH HERE AND ON SEVERAL CHECKPOINTS IN THE PREFECTURE, THEIR MOOD SEEMED GENERALLY FRIENDLIER THAN USUAL.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

i) A COMBINED MILOB/CIVPOL/HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM ESCORTED THE BOURGEMESTRE OF MUSAMBIRA COMMUNE (8273) ON A TOUR OF SECTORS TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETINGS TO TRY TO DEAL WITH THE TENSION IN HIS COMMUNE. THIS IS THE FIRST POSITIVE SIGN OBSERVED FROM THIS BOURGEMESTRE IN MONTHS. IN SOME OF THE CELLULES IN HIS AREA, PEOPLE HAVE PREPARED HIDDEN BUNKERS IN WHICH THEY INTEND TO HIDE IF THINGS HEAT UP.

ii) A MILOB PATROL TO NYAKABANDA (6507) AND NYABIKENKE (7292) COMMUNES AND FOUND THE SITUATION MODERATELY TENSE. THE RATE OF ARRESTS HAS GONE DOWN IN THE LAST FEW DAYS AND, IN TWO SECTORS OF NYAKABANDA COMMUNE, A COMBINED MILITARY/CIVIL EFFORT TO STEM AN IMMINANT EXODUS ON 4 APR WAS SUCCESSFUL. THE TEAM MET PEOPLE WHO WERE RETURNING TO THEIR HOMES WHO CLAIMED TO HAVE BEEN CONVINCED BY THIS MEETING THAT THINGS WOULD BE ALRIGHT. IN THIS COMMUNE, INSTRUCTIONS HAVE BEEN ISSUED THAT BEREAVEMENT WEEK WILL BE AUSTERE; NO PARTIES, PUBLIC DRINKING OR MARKETS FOR THE ENTIRE WEEK. IN NYABIKENKE COMMUNE THERE WERE REPORTS THAT SOME PEOPLE HAD FLED NORTH TO KUHENGARI IN ANTICIPATION OF TROUBLE ON THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE GENOCIDE.

iii) A MILOB TEAM PATROLLED TO MUKINGI COMMUNE (7161) WHERE THEY FOUND TWO SECTORS THAT APPEAR TO HAVE BEEN DESERTED, KIMIGALI (6860) AND DUSEGU (6461). IN RUTAGARA SECTOR (6559) THE TEAM HEARD REPORTS OF ABUSIVE ARRESTS AND BEATINGS.

iv) AN ATTEMPT TO RETURN TO TAMBWE COULD NOT BE MADE BECAUSE OF OTHER PRIORITIES.

v) THE SECTOR HQ WAS INVOLVED IN AN ATTEMPT TO COORDINATE A LAST MINUTE EFFORT TO TRANSFER SEVERAL TRUCKLOADS OF PRISONERS FROM GITARAMA PRISON TO GISENYE. UNFORTUNATELY, THE LACK OF PRIOR NOTICE AND CLEAR INSTRUCTIONS FORCED THE CANCELLATION OF TWO PLANNED PATROLS AND THE ULTIMATE FAILURE OF THE ATTEMPT. A PLANNING SESSION WAS CHAIRED BY THE SECTOR CDR SO THAT THIS CRUCIAL ACTIVITY CAN BEGIN WITH SOME ASSURANCE THAT IT WILL SUCCEED. THE PROPOSED DATE OF COMMENCEMENT IS 10 APR.

vi) TOMORROW'S PATROL PLAN COVERS MOST OF THE COMMUNES IN THE PREFECTURE. FORMED TROOPS, MILOBS, CIVPOL AND HUMAN RIGHTS WILL JOIN FORCES TO TRY TO EXPRESS OUR SYMPATHY TO THE PEOPLE IN AS MANY VILLAGES AS POSSIBLE.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

i) A TEAM PATROLLED TO RUSHISHI (3885) WHERE THEY FOUND THE AREA CALM BUT WITH THE LOCAL POPULATION PREOCCUPIED WITH AN OUTBREAK OF DISEASE AMONG THEIR CATTLE. THE LOCALS BELIEVED IT TO BE ANTHRAX.

ii) A MILOB TEAM PATROLLED TO THE COMMUNE OF RWAMATAMU () WHERE THEY FOUND MANY HOUSES PADLOCKED. THE AREA SEEMED

VIRTUALLY DESERTED. THOSE PRESENT WOULD NOT SPEAK TO THE TEAM.

111) A MILOB TEAM EXECUTED A CONFIDENCE PATROL THROUGH THE COMMUNES OF GISHYITA, GITESI AND MABANZA WHERE THEY FOUND PEOPLE REASSURED BY THEIR PRESENCE. THEY WERE ASKED TO VISIT AGAIN TOMORROW. ARRESTS HAVE CONTINUED TO ADD TO TENSION. LOCALS ADVISED OF TOWN MEETINGS TOMORROW. THE BOURGEMESTRE OF MABANZA STATED THAT ATTENDANCE IS COMPULSORY.

iv) MILOBS ACCOMPANIED A HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM TO RUTSIRO (3183) TO INVESTIGATE THE TALE OF PEOPLE WHO HAD BEEN PUNISHED FOR LEAVING THE COMMUNE. THEY LEFT RUTSIRO ON 22 MAR ON FOOT HEADED IN THE DIRECTION OF GIKONGORO. WHEN STOPPED BY THE RPA IN MUKO THEY CLAIMED THAT THEY WANTED TO ATTEND RELIGIOUS SERVICES. THOUGH NOT ALLOWED TO REACH KIBEHO, THEY MADE IT TO GIKONGORO WHERE THEY REMAINED UNTIL 27 MAR. THEY WERE CARRIED BACK TO KIGALI BY UNHCR AND THEN TO KIBUYE AND RUTSIRO. THE PREFET ORDERED THEM PUNISHED FOR HAVING LEFT THE COMMUNE WITHOUT INFORMING THE COMMUNE AUTHORITIES WHERE UPON THEY WERE INCARCERATED FOR FOUR DAYS AND FINED 1,000RF EACH.

C. MALICOV

i) MALICOV HQ GITARAMA TOOK IN MORE PERSONS SEEKING UNAMIR PROTECTION TODAY. THEY ARE NOW PROTECTING 148 PERSONS IN GITARAMA AND 5 IN NTONGWE.

ii) A PATROL FROM MASANGO TO NKOMERO (6749) NOTICED THE BOURGEMESTRE IN THE PROCESS OF A PUBLIC MEETING. IT DID NOT GO WELL AS THE PEOPLE CLAIMED NOT TO TRUST HIM FOR ETHNIC REASONS. SOME FIVE FAMILIES HAD RECENTLY LEFT THE SECTOR FOR PARTS UNKNOWN.

D. MALAWICOV

i) NOT AVAILABLE AT TIME OF TRANSMISSION. WILL BE FORWARDED SEPARATELY WHEN AVAILABLE.

i) MALICOV ESCORT TO PREFECTURE AGRONOMIST TO COLLECT SEED POTATOES FROM GISENYI

1. **GENERAL SITUATION.** TENSION REMAINS HIGH IN MOST PARTS OF THE SECTOR. THE FUROR OVER THE PRISON SHOOTING SEEMS TO HAVE DIED DOWN SOMEWHAT IN SPITE OF FALSE REPORTS ON BBC AND OTHER PROMINENT STATIONS; HOWEVER, NEW RUMOURS KEEP SPRINGING UP. THE LATEST RUMOUR REPORTED IN NYAMABUYE COMMUNE (GITARAMA TOWN) IS THAT THE REVENGE HAS BEEN DELAYED TO 16 APR BECAUSE TOO MANY PEOPLE WILL BE HIDING ON 7 APR. WE NOW HAVE 123 PERSONS FROM A CROSS SECTION OF COMMUNES SEEKING PROTECTION AT SECTOR HQ. IN SEVERAL AREAS, IT HAS BEEN CONFIRMED THAT PEOPLE SLEEP IN THE FIELDS OUT OF FEAR OF ARREST OR ATTACK. IN MANY AREAS, COMMUNE OFFICIALS ARE WORKING VERY HARD TO CALM THE PEOPLE BUT IT IS AN UPHILL BATTLE AGAINST THE GENERAL MISTRUST THEY FACE.
2. **POLITICAL ACTIVITIES.** THE PREFET OF GITARAMA, THE PROCUREUR AND THE LOCAL BDE COMMANDER PARTICIPATED IN A JOINT ADDRESS TO THE PRISONERS OF GITARAMA PRISON. THE AIM WAS TO CONVINCE THEM TO TRUST THE JUSTICE SYSTEM BUT THEY WERE ALSO ADVISED THAT THEY ARE LIABLE TO BE SHOT IF THEY ATTEMPT TO ESCAPE. THE EXERCISE WAS MARRED SLIGHTLY BY THE REFUSAL OF THE BDE CDR TO SHOW HIMSELF CLEARLY AND TO SPEAK BUT, NEVER THE LESS, TENSION WAS VISIBLY LOWER AT THE END OF THE SESSION. THIS ACTIVITY WAS ORGANISED BY THE GITARAMA HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM.
3. **FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES**
 - A. **RPA.**
 - i) THE RPA BDE CDR WAS VERY ANGRY OVER THE BBC REPORT THAT CLAIMED THAT HUMAN RIGHTS MONITORS HAD BEEN DENIED ACCESS TO THE GITARAMA PRISON. HE ANGER WAS JUSTIFIED SINCE HE AND HIS OFFICIALS HAD BEEN MOST COOPERATIVE THROUGHOUT THE INVESTIGATION AND HAD IN FACT TAKEN THE INITIATIVE TO ESCORT UNAMIR PERSONNEL TO THE PRISON TO SEE FOR THEMSELVES. IT WAS UNFORTUNATE THAT HIS ANGER WAS DIRECTED AT AN INNOCENT HUMAN RIGHTS WORKER RATHER THAN AT THE BBC.
 - ii) RPA HELD A PUBLIC MEETING IN RUTONDE (5880) AT WHICH THEY WARNED LOCALS NOT TO SPEAK TO UNAMIR PERSONNEL.

B. RGF. NTR

C. MILITIA. IT WAS REPORTED TODAY THAT THE TROUBLE AT GITINDA (5959) NOTED YESTERDAY HAD BEGUN LAST WEEK WHEN ALLEGEDLY FORMER MILITIA ELEMENTS VISTED THE AREA AT NIGHT AND ROBBED SEVERAL HOUSEHOLDS. APPARENTLY THE BANDITS ARE ARMED WITH SMALL ARMS AND GRENADES AND HAVE SURVIVED BY MOVING BACK AND FORTH ACROSS BATTALION BOUNDARIES AHEAD OF RPA TROOPS. THEIR ACTIVITIES PROMPTED A FRUSTRATED RESPONSE FROM TUTSI RESIDENTS WHO HAD JUST BEGUN TO RECOVER FROM THE WAR WHEN THEY FOUND THEMSELVES AGAIN AT RISK FROM THE SAME ELEMENTS WHO HAD DESTROYED THEIR HOMES IN THE FIRST PLACE.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A.GITARAMA TEAM

i) A MILOB TEAM PATROLLED TO MUSHUBATI (6970), TABA (8883) AND RUNDA COMMUNES (5882). THE BOURGEMESTRES OF EACH COMMUNE HAVE BEEN HOLDING PUBLIC MEETINGS TO CALM PEOPLE. IN MUSHUBATI, THE SITUATION IS FAIRLY CALM DESPITE THE ANXIETY CAUSED BY THE ANNOUNCED MILITARY EXERCISE REPORTED YESTERDAY. NO ONE APPEARS TO BE FLEEING. IN TABA COMMUNE, THE TEAM LEARNED THAT THE BEREAVEMENT WEEK PLANNING COMMITTEE HAD SELECTED 5 MAY AS THE OFFICIAL REBURIAL DATE FOR SOME 1500 VICTIMS OF THE MASSACRE. NO SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS HAD BEEN ISSUED TO INHABITANTS FOR THE COMING WEEK. IN RUNDA COMMUNE, THE BOURGEMESTRE HAS ARRESTED ONE MAN FOR RUMOUR MONGERING AND HAS BEEN VERY ACTIVE IN QUELLING FEARS. HIS PROGRAMME FOR THE UPCOMING WEEK INCLUDES PUBLIC DISCUSSIONS OF THE CAUSES OF THE LAST GENOCIDE AND WAYS IN WHICH IT CAN BE AVOIDED IN FUTURE.

ii) A MILOB TEAM PATROLLED THROUGH NYAMABUYE (7570) AND TAMBWE (7653) COMMUNES. IN NYAMABUYE, THE BOURGEMESTRE BELIEVED THAT HIS EFFORTS TO CALM THE PEOPLE HAD HELPED BUT ADMITTED THAT THERE WAS STILL A LOT OF FEAR. HE IS PLANNING TO SPEND 7 APR VISITING ORPHANAGES. THERE WERE NO RPA VISIBLE IN THE SECTORS VISITED THOUGH NOTICES OF UPCOMING EXERCISES WERE EVIDENT. IN TAMBWE, THE TEAM WAS ADVISED THAT THE MAIN CAUSE OF CONCERN WAS AN ANTICIPATED CORDON AND SEARCH OPERATION OF A SECTOR MISSED DURING THE LAST OPERATION. THE LOCALS FEAR THAT THE ARRESTS MADE IN THESE OPERATIONS ARE OFTEN ARBITRARY AND UNJUST. LOCALS HAVE RECEIVED INSTRUCTIONS TO REMAIN INDOORS DURING THE BEREAVEMENT PERIOD AND TO OBEY ANY INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN BY THE RPA.

iii) A MILOB TEAM PATROLLED TO GITINDA (5959) TO FOLLOW UP YESTERDAYS INCIDENT AS REPORTED ABOVE. THE TEAM VISTED MASANGO AND MURAMA COMMUNES AND WERE ADVISED AT THE LATTER THAT PEOPLE HAD STARTED TO GO INTO HIDING AND TO FLEE TO GIKONGORO IN FEAR OF THE RPA.

iv) MILOBS ACCOMPANIED THE JOINT TEAM TO THE PRISON AS

DESCRIBED ABOVE.

v) MILOBS ACCOMPANIED A HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM TO TAMBWE LATE TODAY TO INVESTIGATE A CLAIM FROM ONE OF THE PERSONS SEEKING REFUGE THAT HER FATHER HAD BEEN MURDERED. THEY RAN INTO AN AGGRESSIVE RECEPTION AND WERE UNABLE TO BEGIN. A NEW ATTEMPT WILL BE MADE TOMORROW.

vi) THE EMPTY PORTION OF THE MUGINA ROAD THAT LIES WITHIN MUSAMBIRA COMMUNE REPORTED YESTERDAY WAS CHECKED BY UNHCR TODAY BUT REPORT IS NOT YET AVAILABLE.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

i) A TEAM PATROLLED TO RUTONDE COMMUNE TO FOLLOW UP ALLEGATIONS OF HARRASSMENT MADE TWO DAYS AGO. THE SITUATION SEEMS WORSE. IN ADDITION TO PROSCRIPTION AGAINST SPEAKING TO UNAMIR, THE TEAM LEARNED THAT MANY HEADS OF HOUSEHOLD SLEEP IN THE FIELDS OUT OF FEAR OF ARREST. THE TEAM MET A LARGE GROUP OF WOMEN WHOSE HUSBANDS HAD BEEN ARRESTED.

ii) A MILOB TEAM PATROLLED TO BWAKIRA (5061) COMMUNE WHERE THEY LEARNED OF LARGE NUMBERS OF ARRESTS AND ALLEGATIONS OF MURDER BY THE RPA. THEY ALSO HEARD COMPLAINTS THAT TUTSIS WERE STEALING LIVESTOCK BELONGING TO HUTUS ON THE PRETEXT THAT THEIRS HAD BEEN STOLEN BY HUTUS DURING THE WAR. THEY ALLEGEDLY TAKE WHATEVER THEY WANT.

iii) THE FC VISITED AND WAS BRIEFED BY THE SECT CDR AND ESCORTED TO KIBUYI PRISON WHERE IT WAS LEARNED THAT THE PRISON IS NOT PREPARED TO RECEIVE PRISONERS FROM GITARAMA. NO DATE WAS GIVEN WHEN THEY WOULD BE READY.

C. MALI COY

i) A PATROL WAS SENT TO THE VILLAGE OF GISALI (8860) TO INVESTIGATE A REPORT THAT THE VILLAGE WAS DESERTED. THEY LEARNED THAT IT IS DESERTED EVERY NIGHT BUT THAT THE INHABITANTS RETURN IN THE DAY TIME.

ii) ESCORTS WERE PROVIDED TO HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM AND TO THE MILOB LOG OFFR (PAY PDE).

D. MALAWICOY

i) PATROL SENT TO FUMBA (8854), SIT CALM.

ii) PROVIDED ESCORT TO FC VISIT TO PRISON AND COY POSNS.

5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

i) MALICOY TREATED 23 LOCAL PATIENTS AND TRANSPORTED THREE CHILDREN BITTEN BY A DOG PRESUMED TO BE RABID TO KABGUYI HOSPITAL.

ii) MALICOY PROVIDE A TRUCK TO LWF TO DISTRIBUTE KITCHEN

SETS, A TRUCK TO THE PREFET FOR ROAD REPAIRS AND AN ESCORT TO THE PREFECTURE AGRONOMIST TO PICK UP SEED POTATOES.

iii) MALICOY AND MILOBS ARRANGED FOOD AND SHELTER FOR APPROX 120 PERSONS SEEKING PROTECTION AT SECTOR HQ.

iv) MALICOY IS PROVIDING SECURITY FOR A BROKEN DOWN WORLD VISION VEHICLE ON THE GITARAMA KIGALI ROAD.

6. CIVIL AFFAIRS

1. GENERAL SITUATION. TENSION CONTINUES TO MOUNT AND RUMOURS SEEM TO BE GAINING A STRONG HOLD ON PEOPLE'S IMAGINATION. THE CURRENT RUMOUR IN GITARAMA IS THAT 300 PERSONS WERE SLAUGHTERED IN THE PRISON - THE REALITY IS THAT 1 WAS KILLED AND SEVEN INJURED. ELSEWHERE, AN ETHNIC DISPUTE BROKE OUT IN THE VILLAGE OF GITINDA (5959) AS A RESULT OF A LOCAL DEMOGOGUE STIRRING UP A DESIRE FOR REVENGE. THE RUMOUR OF IMPENDING REVENGE HAS REACHED THE PREVIOUSLY QUIET COMMUNE OF KAYENZI. THE CASE LOAD OF PERSONS SEEKING PROTECTION FROM UNAMIR ELEMENTS IN THIS SECTOR STOOD AT 14 AT LAST LIGHT WITH UNCONFIRMED REPORTS OF MORE MOVING FROM MURAMA TO THE MASSANGO UNAMIR POST. THE SITUATION IN KIBUYE IS ALSO WORSENING WITH MORE EVIDENCE OF FEAR AND MORE RUMOURS THAN PREVIOUSLY NOTED. THE COMMUNE OF MWENDO HAS NOW CAUGHT THE SAME FEVER.
2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. NTR
3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES
 - A. RPA.
 - i) THE RPA HAVE NOW BEGUN TO DEPLOY TROOPS IN THE WOODS SURROUNDING THE PRISON AFTER LAST LIGHT. THEY WERE OBSERVED BY MILOBS COMING OFF SHIFT AT FIRST LIGHT THIS MORNING.
 - ii) THERE WERE SIGNINIFICANT MOVEMENTS OF RPA TROOPS IN THE GITARAMA AREA WITH TWO COY OBSERVED MOVING SOUTH ON FOOT WITH BAGGAGE AND SMALLER ELEMENTS LOADING VEHICLES IN PREPARATION FOR A MOVE. NO INFO AVAL YET ON WHERE THE TROOPS ARE HEADED.
 - iii) THE RPA BDE CDR ESCORTED THE SECT CDR ON A TOUR OF THE PRISON TODAY AND EXPLAINED THE SECURITY PROBLEMS HE MUST FACE. HE ALLEGED THAT NO PRISONER HAD BEEN INJURED BY GUN FIRE BUT THE SECT CDR OBSERVED THREE PATIENTS WITH RECENT GUNSHOT WOUNDS AT THE PRISON HOSPITAL.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. GITARAMA TEAM

i) A MILOB TEAM ATTEMPTED, ONCE MORE, TO GET TO THE BOTTOM OF THE ALLEGED SHOOTING INCIDENT IN MUSAMBIRA COMMUNE ON THE NIGHT OF 28 MAR. THE TEAM HAD DIFFICULTY FINDING INFORMANTS IN THE AREA IN WHICH THE INCIDENT OCCURRED BECAUSE OF BEING FOLLOWED BY AN RPA PATROL. THE TEAM LEARNED THAT THE COMMUNE OFFICIALS ARE OPENLY CAMPAIGNING AGAINST UNAMIR USING THE ARGUMENT THAT WE ARE NOT HELPING THEM TO PUNISH THE PERPETRATORS OF GENOCIDE. IN GATAGARA CELLULE () THE TEAM CONFIRMED AN EARLIER REPORT THAT ONE MAN, M. MUNYNDINDA, GARTON, WAS PROVIDING THE RPA WITH NAMES OF PEOPLE TO BE ARRESTED. LOCALS ARE VERY FRIGHTENED OF HIM AND HE HAS DEVELOPED THE CHARMING HABIT OF THREATENING ARREST TO THOSE WHO DISAGREE WITH HIM OR FAIL TO ACCOMMODATE HIS WISHES. REPORTS THAT PEOPLE ARE FLEEING TO KABGUYI FOR UNAMIR PROTECTION ABOUND. HAVING SHAKEN THEIR RPA ESCORT BY THIS TIME, THE TEAM WENT TO THE SITE OF THE SHOOTING INCIDENT AND LEARNED FROM TWO WIDOWS THAT NO ONE HAD PROVOKED THE RPA, THAT NO ONE HAD THROWN STONES AS ALLEGED BY THE COMMUNE SECURITY OFFICER DURING THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION AND THAT THE RPA FIRED SPONTANEOUSLY. DURING THE INTERVIEW IN WHICH THIS INFORMATION WAS ACQUIRED, A MAN CAME OUT OF HIDING TO CLAIM THAT HE WAS THE ONLY MALE REMAINING IN THE CELLULE. THE TEAM SAW NO OTHERS.

THE TEAM ALSO INTERVIEWED A PRIEST WHO ADVISED THAT THE PREVIOUS PRIEST OF MUSAMBIRA, PERELAURENT NDAGIZIMANA, WAS ARRESTED ON CHARGES OF GENOCIDE ON 26 MAR 95. HE IS BELIEVED TO BE IN GITARAMA PRISON.

ii) A MILOB TEAM WAS SENT TO KAYENZI COMMUNE (3470) TO TRY TO DETERMINE THE EXTENT OF INSECURITY IN WHAT HAD BEEN BELIEVED TO BE A QUIET COMMUNE. THE TEAM FOUND THE SITUATION HAD DETERIORATED SERIOUSLY SINCE THE LAST VISIT WITH PEOPLE VERY EVASIVE AND DIFFICULT TO APPROACH. THE BOURGMESTRE, WHO HAD PREVIOUSLY BEEN VERY OPEN WITH THE MILOBS, WAS INHIBITED BY THE PRESENCE OF AN RPA OFFICER. SEVERAL INFORMANTS TOLD OF ARRESTS AND RUMOURS OF IMPENDING MASS ACTS OF REVENGE. THE TEAM ALSO HEARD GRAPHIC DESCRIPTIONS OF MISTREATMENT OF PRISONERS. NO REPORTS OF AN EDICT ADVISING OF MILITARY EXERCISES REACHED THE TEAMS EARS.

iii) A JOINT MILOB/CIVPOL/HR INVESTIGATION OF THE GITARAMA PRISON INCIDENT WAS CONDUCTED WITH THE FOLLOWING RESULTS:

- (a) IT IS CONFIRMED BY ALL POSSIBLE SOURCES THAT AT MOST ONE PRISONER WAS KILLED BY RIFLE FIRE AND THAT THIS PERSON WAS KILLED AT MIDNIGHT WHILE TRYING TO SCALE DOWN A ROPE BLANKET FROM THE PRISON ROOF,
- (b) IT WAS CONFIRMED BY VISUAL OBSERVATION AND INTERVIEW OF PRISON MEDICAL AUTHORITIES THAT AT LEAST FOUR PERSONS SUFFERED GUNSHOT WOUNDS WHILE TRYING TO SCALE THE WALLS

ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE PRISON. THIS TOOK PLACE BETWEEN 0525 AND 0545 3 APR; AND

(c) IT WAS CONFIRMED THAT THE MANY SHOTS FIRED WERE PRIMARILY WARNING SHOTS FIRED TO DISCOURAGE ANY MORE ESCAPEES.

WHAT CANNOT BE CONFIRMED IS THE SPECIFIC REASON FOR THE INCIDENT. THE PRISONERS CLAIM THAT THEY BELIEVE THAT THEY WILL BE KILLED EN MASSE SOON AND FURTHER CLAIM THAT THEY TRIED TO ESCAPE ONLY AFTER HEARING SHOTS, WHICH THEY CLAIM THE RPA FIRED DELIBERATELY TO PANIC THEM. THE RPA CLAIM THAT NO SHOTS WERE FIRED UNTIL THE ESCAPE ATTEMPT BEGAN. THE RPA FEAR A MASS ESCAPE ATTEMPT THROUGH WALLS WHICH HAVE HAD MOST OF THE MORTAR SCRAPED AWAY OVER THE PAST FEW WEEKS. A DYNAMIC OF FEAR HAS BEGUN TO REINFORCE THE ALREADY EXISTING FEARS OF BOTH PARTIES. THE CONDITIONS INSIDE THE WALLS ARE SO BAD THAT ANYTHING MAY HAPPEN.

iv) A GROUP OF VISITORS TO MUGINA MASS GRAVE SITES NOTICED THAT THERE WERE VERY FEW PEOPLE LEFT IN PREVIOUSLY HEAVILY POPULATED AREAS ALONG THE MUSAMBIRA PORTION OF THE ROAD LEADING TO MUGINA. THIS WILL BE CONFIRMED TOMORROW.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

i) A TEAM PATROLLED TO MUSHUBATI (3279) SECTOR OF MABANZA COMMUNE TO INVESTIGATE THE POSSIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A MALAWICOY POST IN A PREVIOUS SENBATT POSITION THERE. THE COMMANDER OF THE CLOSEST RPA UNIT, RUSORORO (2878) PROMISED COOPERATION IN THE EVENT OF UNAMIR DEPLOYMENT. RUSORORO IS THE LOCATION MENTIONED IN OUR SITREP OF 30 MAR AS THE POSSIBLE SITE AT WHICH PRISONERS ARE HELD. THE INHABITANTS OF MUSHUBATI CONTINUE TO BE FEARFUL OF THE COMING ANNIVERSARY. MORE TO FOLLOW.

ii) A MILOB TEAM VISTED THE TOWN OF MAHEMBE (1854) IN RWAMATAMU COMMUNE WHERE THEY FOUND THE PEOPLE DIFFICULT TO CONTACT. THE ONLY PERSON WILLING TO SPEAK TO THEM APPEARED TO BE A SOLDIER OUT OF UNIFORM TO WHOM OTHERS LOOKED FOR APPROVAL BEFORE ANSWERING QUESTIONS.

iii) A MILOB TEAM SENT TO THE COMMUNES BWAKIRA AND MWENDO VISTED A HOSPITAL AT MUTUNDO WHERE THEY WERE TOLD OF A MAN AND HIS SON WHO HAD BEEN MURDER ON 1 APR. NO OTHER DETAILS AVAIL; TO BE FOLLOWED UP.

C. MALI COY

i) A PATROL WAS SENT TO THE VILLAGE OF KITINDA (5959) IN REPOSE TO AN RPA REQUEST FOR ASSISTANCE IN CALMING ETHNIC STRIVE. THE OFFICER IN CHARGE FOUND A GROUP OF APPROX 200 GATHERED TO LISTEN TO A SUGGESTION THAT THEY SHOULD RECOUP THE LOSSES THEY INCURRED DURING THE WAR THROUGH FORCE ON THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE WAR. THE RPA ELEMENT ADDRESSED THE CROWD

AND THEN INTRODUCED THE UNAMIR OFFICER. HE WAS APPLAUDED. THE DIFFERENCES WERE RESOLVED AFTER A LENGTHY DIALOGUE AT THE END OF WHICH, THE COUNSELLOR AND THE PEOPLE OFFERED THE PATROL A DRINK AS A TOKEN OF THEIR AGREEMENT TO LET THE AUTHORITIES SETTLE THEIR COMPLAINT RATHER THAN TAKE DIRECT ACTION ON THEIR OWN.

ii) A PATROL FROM NTONGWE TO KIMIRAMA (9150) FOUND PEOPLE FARMING PEACEFULLY THOUGH THE RPA SEEMED TO HAVE STOPPED THE RETURN OF REFUGEES COMPLETELY AS A RESULT OF ARRESTS. FOOD IS SUFFICIENT WITH THE AID OF CRS.

D. MALAWICOY

i) PATROLS SENT TO RUKOKO (4770), NGOMA (2061) AND MUSHUBATI (3279) FOUND SIT CALM IN THE SECTORS VISITED.

5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

i) MALAWICOY TREATED 33 LOCAL PATIENTS AND TRANSPORTED ONE OTHER TO THE HOSPITAL.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. TENSION CONTINUES HIGH IN THE WAKE OF GOVT ANNOUNCEMENTS ON THE RADIO AND CONTINUING ARRESTS. WE HAVE BEGUN TO RECEIVE PEOPLE SEEKING PROTECTION IN THE GITARAMA PREFECTURE. LOCALLY EMPLOYED EXPATRIOTS CLAIM THAT THE LEVEL OF TENSION IS PALPABLE TO THOSE WHO HAVE BEEN HERE LONG ENOUGH TO RECOGNIZE THE SIGNS.
2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. NTR
3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES
 - A. RPA. THE RPA CONTINUE TO BE VERY VISIBLE THROUGHOUT THE SECTOR. THE LATEST DEVELOPMENT HAS BEEN WRITTEN NOTIFICATION AFFIXED TO TREES AND HOUSES AROUND GITARAMA AREA ADVISING OF AN EXERCISE TO BE HELD IN "CERTAIN SECTORS" NEXT WEEK. THIS HAS HAD THE EFFECT OF MAKING EVERYONE IN THE OUTLYING REGIONS EVEN MORE NERVOUS AS THEY THINK THAT THEY ARE BEING DUPED INTO COOPERATING IN THEIR OWN DEMISE. THIS MATTER WILL BE TAKEN UP WITH THE RPA TOMORROW.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.
 - A. GITARAMA TEAM
 - i) A MILOB TEAM PATROLLED TO MUSAMBIRA COMMUNE (8273) TO INVESTIGATE RUMOURS OF IMPENDING MASS ARRESTS OF ALL HUTU MALES OVER THE AGE OF 14 BEGINNING ON THE NIGHT OF 4 APR. IT WAS CONFIRMED THAT THE RUMOUR IS INDEED WIDESPREAD BUT, AS WITH MOST OF THESE RUMOURS, NO SOLID EVIDENCE CAN BE FOUND. SEVERAL YOUNG MEN HAVE FLED TO SECTOR HQ AS A RESULT OF THESE RUMOURS. THEY WILL BE HANDLED AS PER SOP. IT WOULD APPEAR FROM INITIAL INVESTIGATION THAT TWO BROTHERS IN GATAGARA SECTOR (815708) MAY BE RESPONSIBLE FOR MOST OF THE UNCERTAINTY. A PREVIOUSLY RELIABLE LOCAL HAS ADVISED THAT TENSION HAS REACHED A VERY HIGH LEVEL IN THIS AREA AND THAT MANY PEOPLE ARE MAKING PLANS TO FLEE.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

i) CONFIDENCE PATROLS WENT TO GITESI (2871) AND MABANZA (3473) COMMUNES. NTR.

C. MALI COY

i) MALICOY ELEMENTS NOTICED LARGER NUMBERS OF PERSONS ATTENDING CHURCHES THAN IS USUAL IN THE PREFECTURE TODAY.

ii) TWO PERSONS SOUGHT REFUGE FROM THE MASSANGO PLATOON AND NINE MORE CAME TO GITARAMA HQ. SIX HAVE ARRIVED FROM MUSAMBIRA AND THREE FROM TAMBWE. IN EACH CASE, THEY FLED BECAUSE OF RUMOURS OF IMPENDING MASSACRE OR MASSIVE ARRESTS. IN EACH CASE, THE MPS EITHER HAVE BEEN OR WILL BE ADVISED AND STEPS WILL BE TAKEN TO CONTACT THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES TO ARRANGE FOR HANDING OVER AS PER SOP. GIVEN THE PERSISTENCE OF REPORTS OF BOGUS REASONS FOR ARREST AND SUMMARY EXECUTION, NOT TO MENTION THE STATE OF THE PRISONS, THE SOPs MAY NEED REVISION.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. TENSION CONTINUES TO BE RELATIVELY HIGH IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE WAR. LOCAL OFFICIALS IN MANY AREAS CONTINUE TO TRY TO CALM PEOPLE THROUGH PUBLIC MEETINGS BUT THE HARDLINE ELEMENTS IN OTHER AREAS PERSIST IN ARRESTING MANY PEOPLE WITHOUT ATTENTION TO DUE PROCESS. HARDLINE ELEMENTS SEEM OBLIVIOUS TO THE POTENTIAL CONSEQUENCES OF REMOVING ALL HOPE OF REAL JUSTICE.
2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. NTR
3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES
 - A. RPA. THE INTERNAL ROTATION OF TROOPS IN THE INBIRAMBO() AND RUGABANO () AREAS OF KIBUYE PREFECTURE CONTINUES. THE RPA CONTINUE TO BE ACTIVE IN THE SOUTH WESTERN CAMP AREA OF MARA (2068)
 - B. RGF. NTR
 - C. MILITIA. NTR
4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.
 - A. GITARAMA TEAM
 - i) A MILOB TEAM PATROLLED TO RUNDA COMMUNE (5882) WHERE THEY WERE ADVISED BY THE BOURGEMESTRE THAT HIS EFFORTS TO RECOVER WEAPONS ISSUED TO THE PUBLIC BY THE FORMER GOVERNMENT HAD NETTED SOME 150 FIREARMS. HE BELIEVES THERE TO BE APPROX 75 MORE ARMED PERSONS IN HIS COMMUNE AND HAS A LIST OF SUSPECTS THAT HE IS PERSUING. THE ATMOSPHERE IN THE COMMUNE WAS NEUTRAL THOUGH THERE ARE MANY RUMOURS CIRCULATING. THE BOURGEMESTRE HAS BEEN CONDUCTING VILLAGE MEETINGS TO DEAL WITH THE PROBLEM AND SUGGESTED THAT MANY FAMILIES FEEL MORE INSECURE THAN USUAL BECAUSE THE HEAD OF THE HOUSEHOLD IS MISSING. THE PATROL CARRIED ON TO MUGINA COMMUNE (9267) WHERE THEY HEARD ALLEGATIONS THAT ARRESTEES ARE BEATEN TO NEAR DEATH AT THE COMMUNE DETENTION FACILITY BEFORE BEING SENT TO GITARAMA PRISON. THE PATROL GATHERED A LIST OF SEVEN NAMES OF PERSONS ALLEGED TO HAVE BEEN TREATED THIS WAY AND WILL PASS THE LIST TO HUMAN RIGHTS FOR FOLLOW UP.

ii) A MILOB TEAM SEARCHED THE MASSANGO (6254) AND MURAMA (6749) COMMUNES FOR CORROBORATING EVIDENCE OF A FRESH MASS GRAVE BUT FOUND NOTHING DESPITE A CAREFUL AND SUBTLE SEARCH. THEY WERE TOLD BY SOME YOUNG RWANDESE THAT THERE HAVE BEEN MANY ARRESTS OF HUTU MEN OF LATE AND THAT THEY DISAPPEAR AFTER BEING ARRESTED; HOWEVER, THE BOYS RAN AWAY IN FRIGHT AFTER HAVING SAID THAT MUCH.

iii) SECT CDR AND OPSO RECEIVED A SURPRISE VISIT FROM THE PREFET OF GITARAMA WHO WISHED TO DISCUSS SOME HUMANITARIAN ISSUES. A SEPARATE REPORT HAS BEEN SUBMITTED.

B. KIBUYE TEAM

i) A MILOB TEAM ACCOMPANIED TECHNICIANS TO REPAIR THE CH 13 REPEATER AT KARONGI HILLS. FAULT REPAIRED BUT COMMS ARE STILL FUZZY.

ii) A MILOB TEAM PATROLLED TO RUCURA (3653) WHERE THEY LEARNED OF DISPUTES OVER LAND AND CATTLE INVOLVING RETURNEES. THEY ALSO WERE TOLD OF RUMOURS THAT THERE WILL BE MASS KILLINGS ON 6/7 APR. PUBLIC MEETINGS HAVE BEEN HELD TO DEAL WITH THESE RUMOURS. LOCALS COMPLAINED OF THE BAN ON THE SALE OF CATTLE ISSUED BY THE RWANDAN GOVT.

C. MALI COY

i) MALICOY ELEMENTS AND MILOBS IN GITARAMA CONDUCTED A JOINT RECCE OF NGO OFFICES, RESIDENCES AND MILOBS RESIDENCES AND PREPARED A MAP OF THEIR LOCATIONS AND PHONE NUMBERS. AN EXERCISE WILL BE HELD TO TEST THE RAPID REACTION TEAM'S ABILITY TO DEPLOY TO ONE OF THESE AREAS EARLY NEXT WEEK.

ii) A PATROL FROM RUHANGO WENT TO KAHERE SECTOR () WHERE THEY FOUND PEOPLE PREOCCUPIED WITH FARMING ACTIVITIES AND TRYING TO COPE WITH MALARIA AND DIARRHEA WITHOUT MEDICAL FACILITIES.

D. MALAWICOY
