WHY SHOULD YOU AS MAYOR OF A CITY THAT IS THE MEAT PACKING CENTER OF THE COUNTRY COINCIDE WITH FORMER MAYOR LA GUARDIA OF NEW YORK CITY IN REGARD TO REMOVING MEAT PRODUCTS FROM OPA PRICE CEILINGS, WHEN HE AS MAYOR OF NEW YORK CITY, AND HAD POWER TO PASS ANY KIND OF LEGISLATION HE SAW FIT AND DID ENACT WHAT WAS SUPPOSED TO BE AIRTIGHT ANTI BLACK MARKET LAWS, BESIDES USING A BROADCASTING STATION SEVERAL TIMES A WEEK, STILL HAD THE BIGGEST BLACK MARKET IN THE UNITED STATES, AND IT STILL REMAINS AS SUCH. IT HAS BEEN CLEARLY DEMONSTRATED THAT THE BLACK MARKET IN MEATS CANNOT BE CONTROLLED. IT WOULD SEEM THAT THE SENATE BANKING & FINANCE COMMITTEE WHO VOTED TO TAKE THE MEAT INDUSTRY FROM PRICE CONTROL AFTER HOLDING MANY DAYS OF PUBLIC HEARINGS WOULD BE BETTER QUALIFIED TO KNOW THE FACTS THAN EITHER YOU OR MAYOR LA GUARDIA. YOU OF ALL MAYORS SHOULD BE THE LAST TO TAKE OPPOSITE VIEWS WITH SUCH A COMMITTEE WHEN THE MEAT INDUSTRY OF YOUR CITY BOTH WHOLESALE AND RETAIL WHO KNOW THE FACTS ARE FOR LIFTING OPA PRICE CONTROLS. WE HAVE ADVISED LA GUARDIA IN THE PAST TO CONFINE HIS ACTIVITIES TO ASSEMBLING FOOD FOR THE STARVING PEOPLE OF EUROPE AND KEEP HIS NOSE OUT OF OPA IF HE WANTS ANY FOOD PRODUCED FOR DISTRIBUTION. ACCORDING TO LAST NIGHTS RADIO PROGRAM WHERE YOU WERE INTERVIEWED HE HAS ALREADY GOT A SOLUTION TO THE LABOR TROUBLES WHICH WILL BE ANNOUNCED IN THE NEAR FUTURE. WE STILL THINK HE IS TAKING IN TOO MUCH TERRITORY AND HE HAD BETTER STICK TO ONE JOB UNTIL HE MAKES A SUCCESS OF IT.

According to resolution and policy, we do not provide assistance directly to the individuals in need. We negotiate with the governments of the countries who take over responsibility for the actual distribution of our supplies and clothing.
