I APPRECIATE YOUR DIFFICULTIES AND I WANT YOU TO CONTACT GEN LUNDULA AND REQUEST HIM IF IT IS POSSIBLE FOR HIM TO LOCATE AT LEAST ONE BATTALION OF ANC TROOPS IN KASONGO AREA TO MAINTAIN LAW AND ORDER. IF GENERAL LUNDULA IS IN A POSITION TO ACCEPT THIS COMMITMENT IT WOULD ENABLE ME TO WITHDRAW FROM YOUR COMPANY BACK TO STAN. WHEN DISCUSSING THIS PROBLEM WITH GENERAL LUNDULA HE MAY REQUEST ASSISTANCE. BEFORE COMMITTING YOURSELF INFORM ME OF THE DETAILS OF HIS REQUEST. HOWEVER, NO WITHDRAWAL FROM KASONGO BY UN TROOPS WILL TAKE PLACE UNLESS ORDERED BY ME. AS EVEN IF GEN LUNDULA IS IN A POSITION TO LOCATE ANC TROOPS IN KASONGO I SHALL HAVE TO OBTAIN THE AGREEMENT OF THE PRIME MINISTER FOR THE CHANGEOVER BEFORE IT CAN BE EFFECTED.
