
Excellency,



NIGERIA'S CENTENARY CELEBRATION CONFERENCE

CONCEPT NOTE

INTRODUCTION:

A hundred years of any nation is a unique historical event. Nigeria has made major strides in achieving its national goals and aspirations as envisioned by its founding fathers; and this is best expressed by the fact that its people have remained together for all these years. This is a significant milestone. Within this period, particularly since independence in 1960, Nigeria has faced the complex challenges of nation building – periods of peace and achievement; times of conflicts, crisis and even war. This is, of course, not peculiar to Nigeria as many nations such as the United States, Peoples Republic of China, the Russian Federation, Great Britain, France, etc, have had such experiences in the course of their history.

The Centenary Celebration provides a unique opportunity for Nigeria and friends of Nigeria to rejoice and reflect on our nation's journey so far, appreciate the on-going national transformation; reinforce and reaffirm the commitment of Nigeria and Africa to peace at home, in the continent and around the world in the years ahead.

THE THEME:

The commitment and contributions of Nigeria to peace in Africa and around the world are widely acknowledged. It is in that spirit that the country wishes to seize the opportunity of the Centenary Celebration to hold a one-day summit-level international conference on the theme – *Human Security, Peace and Development: Agenda for 21st Century Africa*, to be hosted by the President, Dr. Goodluck Ebele Jonathan.

THE PURPOSE:

The theme of the Conference is premised on the fact that human security engenders solidarity among people. It also ensures peaceful co-existence, unity and social cohesion which are the bedrock of sustainable development of nations. The challenge

of integrating human security and state security for national stability has engaged the best efforts of past and present generations of leaders in the continent.

Nigeria desires to use the occasion of its Centenary Celebration; especially, the global focus of attention on its people, history, achievements and aspirations, to reinforce the imperative of human security as the bedrock for national stability, continental and world peace.

STRUCTURE OF THE CONFERENCE:

The one-day Conference is proposed for Thursday, 27th February, 2014 and is expected to hold from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the International Conference Centre, Abuja. It will feature:

- i. A keynote address by President Goodluck Ebele Jonathan.
- ii. Presentations by Guest Speakers on topics relating to peace, security and development.
- iii. Goodwill messages.
- iv. A declaration by the Conference.

EXPECTED OUTCOME:

- i. To use the occasion of Nigeria's Centenary Celebration to reaffirm Nigeria's and Africa's commitment to global human security, peace and development; and,
- ii. Highlight the importance of a continental and global agenda for peace and human security for the 21st Century.
- iii. Seek global support for that agenda.
