Le Secrétaire général par interim de l'Organisation des Nations Unies présente ses compliments à Monsieur le Représentant Permanent de la Belgique auprès des Nations Unies et à l'honneur de se référer à la note verbale O.412 A/S.249 que celui-ci lui a adressée le 5 février 1962, et au sujet de laquelle des renseignements détaillés ont été obtenus du fonctionnaire chargé de l'Opération des Nations Unies au Congo, sur la base de rapports qui lui ont été fournis sur place. Le Secrétaire général par interim tient en conséquence - en rappelant sa note verbale du 29 janvier 1962 - à faire savoir à Monsieur le Représentant Permanent que, selon un rapport du Major Lawson, du Contingent Nigérien de l'ONUC, tous les prêtres non-congolais et toutes les religieuses non-congolaises ont été évacués du Nord Katanga et sont maintenant en surêté. Les lieux évacués comprennent notamment Kongolo, Sola et Lupunda. Les religieuses et les prêtres congolais de Kongolo ne sont pas considérés comme courant un danger immédiat, mais ceux qui souhaitent partir ont été évacués par le Commandant Lawson au cours de l'une de ses missions dans la région, les autorités de l'ONUC sont en rapport avec l'Evêque de Kongolo et elles lui ont prêté leur concours en lui permettant d'envoyer par avion ONUC à Albertville un ecclésiastique et une religieuse, en attendant qu'une décision soit prise quant à l'éventuelle évacuation des vingt religieuses et trente séminaristes restant à Kongolo. On signale que les prêtres congolais de Kasongo ne se considèrent nullement en danger. L'ONUC a envoyé des patrouilles à Kasongo à

partir de Kindu et a Senterry à partir de Lulubourg. A Kindu même, l'ONUC et l'ANC ont organisé des patrouilles mixtes et, comme le Secrétaire général par interim en a informé le Représentant Permanent par sa note verbale précédente en date de ce jour, il ressort des renseignements reçus que la situation est satisfaisante du point de vue de la sécurité. Le Représentant Permanent a également été informé d'autres cas où les forces des Nations Unies effectuaient des patrouilles régulières dans l'exercice des responsabilités qui lui incombent, à savoir aider au maintien de l'ordre public. Le Représentant Permanent n'ignore certainement pas que, chaque fois que des personnes qui craignent des dangers, ou que ce soit dans le pays, en font la demande, l'ONUC ne ménage aucun effort, dans les limites de ses ressources, pour mettre ces personnes en sécurité ou pour les aider de toute autre manière. 1. HAVE RECEIVED COMPREHENSIVE REPORT FROM GUSSEING ON EVILLE REFUGEE CAMP, COPY OF WHICH WILL BE FOLDED FORTHWITH. MAIN POINT IS THAT ONUC SHOULD DECIDE AND SHOULD BE KNOWN TO HAVE DECIDED UPON FIRM POLICY FOR DISSOLVING CAMP AS MORALE AT PRESENT LOW AND PROBLEM OF HOOLIGANISM AND ORGANIZED JEUNESSE BANDE INSIDE AND OUTSIDE CAMP REACHING SERIOUS PROPORTIONS: ALSO STRESSES DANGER OF EPIDEMICS. Dans mon je vous ai donné mon évaluation de la position de Tshombé telle qu'elle ressort de ses positions actuelles. J'ai attiré votre attention sur la vigilance que nous devons porter au problème katangais sachant d'avance que vous partagez déjà mes appréhensions et mes craintes.

Si les intentions de Tshombé sont telles que décrites dans mon cable précité il cherchera à gagner du temps, à accumuler les preuves et les arguments en sa faveur, jusqu'au jour où il se sentira assez fort pour lever le voile sur ses véritables intentions.

Il annoncera au monde entier qu'il a renvoyé tous les mercenaires et les Nations Unies en témoignent. Les enquêtes qu'on mène ou mènera un jour au Katanga démontreront la brutalité de l'action militaire de l'ONUC : mort du représentant Croix Rouge, des civils belges, etc. Il fera une estimation des dégâts subis et se fera passer pour un pauvre martyr. Aussi il me paraît utile d'attirer votre attention sur les effets psychologiques de votre action sur Tshombé dans vos conversations privées et sans objet. Tshombé doit être imprégné qu'Adoula est aujourd'hui plus fort que jamais - élimination de Gizenga, vote de confiance par l'Assemblée, accueil chaleureux aux Nations Unies, assistance plus grande promise par Amérique, soutien de plus en plus marqué du Gouvernement Central par le peuple congolais et le monde extérieur.

Face à cela Tshombé est passé de mode, ses diverses volte-face, son manque perpétuel à la parole donnée, l'ont beaucoup déconsidéré aux yeux du monde et du peuple. Le Katanga est en train de lui échapper petit à petit et il est réduit au rôle passif de la protestation platonique. Sur le plan international, il ne peut plus compter sur grand monde et si quelques conseillers persistent à le pousser dans ses atermoiements actuels c'est sûrement plus par intérêt personnel que pour le bien du Katanga.

Après ce premier exercice assez démoralisant et auquel vous pouvez ajouter tous les arguments nombreux et variés qu'il serait vain de vous citer, vous pouvez toujours dans le cadre de la conversation intime et privée et à laquelle vous ne demandez aucune suite en réponse, aborder la deuxième phase de votre action psychologique. En effet un grand homme politique tel que le Président Tshombé ne peut tenir ainsi. Si aujourd'hui et tant qu'il est encore temps Tshombé révisant sa position, maintenant sa parole, fait un appel au peuple katangais le conviant à l'unité dans le grand Congo pour le bien de tous les Congolais. Dans ce cadre la littérature politique vous fournit une gamme extrêmement vaste d'arguments forts irréfutables et auxquels les Africains sont très sensibles. Vous essaieriez de persuader Tshombé que le peuple katangais et le Congo tout entier oubliant le passé l'élèveront au rang des héros qui savent sacrifier leur susceptibilité personnelle à l'intérêt supérieur de la Nation. Nous sommes certains qu'Adoula fera tout pour faciliter la tâche du Président Tshombé qu'il a en haute estime. Nous sommes persuadés également qu'à partir de ce moment Tshombe redeviendra l'homme international qui a joué un grand rôle dans l'édification du Congo de demain.

Nous sommes persuadés que votre intervention dans ce sens vous permettra soit d'arriver à hâter la solution réelle du problème katangais ou lever l'hypothèque du doute qui plane actuellement sur les véritables intentions de Moïse.
