

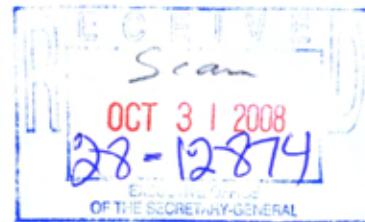

Mrs Deputy Secretary General,

On Nov 20 and Nov 21, a delegation of Swiss members of parliament will be at the UN, attending the annual session of the GA with the Interparliamentary Union (IPU).

The delegation has expressed a wish to meet with a high-ranking member of the Secretariat. I would like to ask you to receive the delegation. Topics of discussion could include the management reform agenda and the development agenda of the United Nations. Both are of keen interest to the Swiss Parliament where a new four-year budget authority for development cooperation currently is under consideration.

The three visiting politicians are:

- **Dr. Felix Gutzwiller**, member of the Council of States (Senate) from Zurich and a member of the foreign relations committee. Dr. Gutzwiller is a professor for preventive medicine and a leading authority in this field.
- **Dr. Geri Müller**, member of the National Council (House) from Aargau and president of the foreign relations committee. Mr. Müller is the deputy mayor of the city of Baden.
- **Dr. Doris Stump**, member of the National Council (House) from Zurich and a member of the Swiss Delegation to the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe. Ms. Stump is a publisher.
