ABOUT 200 PRISONERS ARE TO BE TRANSFERRED FROM GIKORO COMMUNE TO MSINDA PRISON IN RUTONDE SECTOR, KIBUNGO PREFECTURE. AND THE BOURGEMESTRE OF GIKORO COMMUNE HAS REQUESTED UNAMIR FOR TRANSPORTATION.



WEEKLY HUMANITARIAN REPORT PERIOD COVERING 18 DEC. TO 24 DEC. 95

GENERAL SITUATION

The AOR in general is quiet and calm. The routine works are going on with most signs of improving, and many NGOs or UN Agencies are present in the Communes for assistance to the local population in various areas. The lack of housing, water, medicines and health care still remains a problem in the area despite the humanitarian action of NGOs and UNAMIR.

1. SECTOR HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

This week the main activity of Humanitarian Team has been to monitor the arrival and situation of returnees, also some orphanages were visited.

Further details of activities carried out as follows:

_ GASHORA Commune: Monitoring RUTETE border and DIHIRO Transit Camp.

_ KANZEZE Commune: Visit to NYAMATA Orphanage

_ Orphans : 200.

_ Sponsor : CUAMM in the past but now this NGO has pulled out. Actually UNICEF is handling the problem by trying to find an NGO to assist this Centre.

_ NGENDA Commune: Visit to NGENDA Orphanage

_ Orphans : 158.

_ Sponsor : World Vision

2. GENERAL LIVING CONDITIONS

_ Food: Due to lack of rain there is a food problem in some Communes like BUTAMWA and GIKOMERO.

_ Water: No change.

_ Health Care: No change.

_ Agriculture: Lack of rain in some areas, and the crops are drying up.

_ Education: No change.

_ Returnees: This week through RUTETE border many returnees arrived from BURUNDI under the auspices of UNHCR :

19 DEC. 95 : 881 returnees. Home Communes distribution : NGENDA 24, GASHORA 25, KIGALI 26, KIBUNGO 792. And 14 children

distributed by "SAVE THE CHILDREN" to orphanages in KIGALI and KIBUNGO respectively 8 and 6.
21 DEC. 95 : 550 returnees. They have been immediately transported to KIBUNGO Transit Centre.
22 DEC. 95 : 444 returnees. Home Commune distribution : KIGALI 34, KIBUNGO 371, NGENDA 33, GASHORA 1, RUHENGIERI 5.

— Transit Camps: Most of returnees above was carried in DIHIRO Transit Camp before going in there home Communes.

— Prisons: No really change.
There is 520 inmates in GIKORO Commune.

3. ACTIVITIES OF UN AGENCIES AND NGOS

OXFAM QUEBEC provided iron sheet for shelter programme which will start in february in BUTAMWA Commune.
In the same Commune "GTZ" provided medicines for the crops.
IRC is assisting KANZENZE Commune especially in water projects, rehabilitation and loan giving.

4. INFORMATION ON THE CAPACITY OF ABSORPTION OF RETURNEES IN THE AOR


No change.

5. REQUESTS FOR ASSISTANCE

BUTAMWA Commune : requires engineers to grade road from NYAMIRAMBO turn off GR 0782 to BUTAMWA GR 0176.
GASHORA Commune : UNHCR officials requires engineers to grade road between RUTETE border crossing and immigration post (about 4 KMS) in order to facilitate easy transportation of the returnees.

6. CONCLUSION

Humanitarian Team and MILOBS in Sector 1A are working in close cooperation with INDBATT, FEC and UN AGENCIES/NGOs in order to provide maximum assistance to the local population and earn a good name for MILOBS and UNAMIR.





UNHCR REQUESTED THE INDIAN ENGINEER COY TO GRADE THE ROAD BETWEEN THE BORDER CROSSING AND THE IMMIGRATION POST AT RUTETE GR 2243 (ABOUT 4 KMS) IN ORDER TO FACILITATE EASY TRANSPORTATION OF THE RETURNEES.
