

The United Nations Observer Mission Uganda/Rwanda presents its compliments to the Secretary of Defence, requests his assistance in the following matters and has the honour to state that, in view of the prevailing difficulties of routing UN cargo aircrafts from Nairobi to Kigali, it has become necessary to route the aircrafts with stores and personnel through Entebbe International Airport through the kind courtesy of the Ugandan Government. Besides, due to the same reason, some of the essential supplies require to be met from Kampala/Kabale.

2. In view of the foregoing, may I kindly request you to facilitate the following:

- a. Landing of UN aircrafts carrying stores and personnel at Entebbe International Airport.
  - b. Clearance of the stores at the Entebbe Airport.
  - c. Entry of UNAMIR vehicles with essential personnel to Uganda at Kagitumba or Katuna border crossing point for collection of stores and essential items from Kampala/Mbarara/Kabale etc.
  - d. Passage of UNAMIR personnel to Rwanda through Kagitumba or Katuna border.
3. The United Nations Observer Mission Uganda/Rwanda avails itself of this opportunity to renew its highest esteems and considerations at all times.

1. UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 504 (1981) OF 22 JUNE 1981, THE UNITED NATIONS OBSERVER MISSION UGANDA/RWANDA (UNOMUR) HAS ESTABLISHED AND MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT THE YEAR 1993, THE AREA OF INTERNATIONAL BOUNDARY (BORDER) BETWEEN RWANDA AND UGANDA, THE AREA OF WHICH ARE:

1. TO MONITOR THE UGANDA/RWANDA BORDER
2. TO VERIFY THAT NO MILITARY ASSISTANCE REACHES RWANDA, NOR IS BEING PUT FORWARD IN THIS REGARD, ON TRANSIT OR TRANSPORT, BY ROAD OR TRAILS WHICH COULD ACCOMMODATE VEHICLES OF LETHAL WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION ALONGS THE BORDER, AS WELL AS ANY OTHER MATERIAL WHICH COULD BE OF MILITARY USE.
