
My recent visit to Japan was a short one but I am glad I had an opportunity to address this important subject on a programme reaching out to the younger generation in Japan.


As I said in my interview with Ms. Takashima, I look forward to meeting the Japanese children she will be bringing to Copenhagen to "Seal the Deal."
