1. REPEATED WARNINGS BY RWANDA AUTHORITIES THAT WHILE ON TRANSIT TO AND FROM KAMEMBE AIRPORT ONUC TROOPS SHOULD NOT REPEAT NOT SHOW THEIR ARMS HAVE OFTEN BEEN DISREGARDED BY MALAYAN TROOPS.

2. LAST SUNDAY DECEMBER 23 A GROUP ARRIVING FROM ELI LEFT THE PLANE SHOWING THEIR ARMS. AS EYE WAS THERE LIEUTENANT PERPETE OF RWANDA NATIONAL GUARD COMPLAINED TO ME AND EYE CALLED THE ATTENTION OF THE OFFICER IN CHARGE OF THE GROUP WHO REPLIED THEY HAD NOT BEEN BRIEFED ABOUT FACT THAT THEY HAD TO HIDE THEIR ARMS. EYE THEN APOLOGIZED TO LIEUTENANT PERPETE.

1. GENERAL ATMOSPHERE BUK CALM
2. LASSIRY STILL IN PRISON. ALTHOUGH KAMITATU DECIDED THAT LASSIRY BE TRIED BY COURT CHARGE ABUSE POWER, ~~XXX~~ YET CASE NOT TAKEN UP BY COURT. MOSOKO STILL AWAY. REPORTS INCLINE ACCUSE HIM MISAPPROPRIATION PUBLIC FUNDS AND PARLIAMENT REPORTED TO DISCUSS CASE LEO TODAY. STRONG RUMOURS HE WILL BE REMOVED FROM OFFICE.
