has decided to send an advance and quartering party to Rwanda. The advance and quartering party has planned to undertake its quartering mission to the deployment area of the Ethiopian contingent in order to take the appropriate orientation and make the required arrangement prior to the deployment of the main body of the contingent for the rotation of the troop as planned.

2. The team of the advance and quartering party will consist of fifty officers and men i.e. 3 officers from Defence HQ and 47 other from the new contingent. The groups of the advance and quartering party are:-

2.1 From the Defence HQ .....3 Officers  
2.2 From Mech inf coys 4 each 4x4.....16 Officers & men  
2.3 From Mech inf platoons 1 each 12x1.....12 " "  
2.4 From the logistic coy ..... 7 " "  
2.5 From the bn HQ ..... 3 Officers  
2.6 From Finance and data processing ..... 9

3. The itinerary for the advance and quartering party is as follows:-

3.1 Depart ADDIS ABABA on April 4, 1995 at 1115 hours

3.2. Depart KIGALI on 5 April 1995 to Gyangugu at the appropriate time by means of the appropriate transportation that will be arranged by the FMQ and CO ETHIOBAT.

3.3. Commence the quartering arrangement from 6 - 16 April 1995 in Gyangugu in the deployment area of the contingent as required in cooperation with unit commanders already in place.

3.4 16 Night to 19 April 1995 complete the rotation and on 20 April 1995 0900 hours full report will be submitted to the FMQ and the Ethiopian MOMB as the handing and taking over of the contingent is completed.

4. Request all the necessary arrangement of hotel accommodation and logistical support for the advance and quartering party from night 4/5 to 19/20 April 1995.

5. Request officials from UNAMIR and the CO of ETHIOBAT meet the advance and quartering party at KIGALI International Airport on arrival and transportation assistance from the airport to the rest house / Hotel and for the duration of the stay of the party in Rwanda.

6. Request early provision of Air Tickets and the required allowances for the advance and quartering party.



1. You requested to know if the Rwanda Government was informed of the arrival of the Senegalese contingent on 21 & 23 Feb 95.
2. As you are aware the dates for a rotation are proposed by G3 PLANS, after consultation with MOVCON, to UN HQ New York. There is some consultation between UNAMIR and UN HQ New York before the approved flight schedule is issued by New York. This schedule may or may not reflect all of the initial requirements put forward by G3 PLANS. It is at this time that the responsibility passes to MOVCON to conduct the rotation. Prior to the rotation being conducted MOVCON advises the Ministry of Interior (Immigration) at the airport and the RPA Chief of Security Kigali International Airport of the flight details of the rotating contingents.
3. I can confirm that this was done in the case of the Senegalese contingent. I have included a copy of the relevant documents that were sent to the Airport Commandant, Chief of Airport Security and the Controller of Airport Customs.

SUBJECT: MOVEMENT OF SENEGALESE TROOPS

1. With reference to the letter dated 23 Feb 95 from the office of the Chief of Protocol on the issue of the arrival of the Senegal troops the following points are presented:

a. Contrary to the claim made by the Protocol Office, the Rwanda Government was informed of the arrival of the troops. For this the UNAMIR advised the Ministry of Interior (Immigration) at the airport and the RPA Chief of Security Kigali International Airport. This is the normal distribution procedure for all other missions.

b. The other two incidents that the Protocol Office refers to are not related to this issue. One case was the arrival of a group of Milobs with whom the RPA demanded a security check of their baggage and the other case was with the arrival of a group of Malawi soldiers who brought in electrical equipment that the Customs required paperwork raised on.

2. To the problem in the first case is an internal distribution flow of information within the Government but to resolve this MOVCON will now expand its distribution list to all the relevant departments in the Government that need to know.

3. In the second case these problems were brought about by changes in Government policy and in each case the departments did not advise UNAMIR nor MOVCON of the changes. Each time MOVCON sought legal advice from Political Affairs thinking that it was the correct procedure.

4. MOVCON has not advised Political Affairs of troop movement before but will do so in the future. It should be noted that this information was not asked for previously but has been always available.



**NOTE FOR THE FILE**

**Incident at Kigali Airport Involving Senegalese Troops**  
**on 22 February 1995**

At about 10:30 hours on 22 February 1995 (on returning to the Office after accompanying the SRSG to a meeting with the Minister of Justice), I was called to attend to a problem at the airport involving 121 newly-arrived troops from Senegal. Ambassador Conde, our Chief of Protocol (in the absence of Ambassador Dessande), had already spoken to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and requested their intervention.

At the airport, Immigration were refusing to let the troops in because they had no travel documents. I drew their attention to relevant provisions of UNAMIR's Status of Mission Agreement with Rwanda, which state in brief, that there should be no passport or visa requirements for UNAMIR personnel, and, instead, that an individual or collective movement order (issued by UNAMIR or a participating State) and a UNAMIR or National ID Card should suffice (ref: para 34 of SOMA). The UN Laissez-Passer should also suffice. The immigration officers were prepared to accept this if confirmed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Interior.

While seeking such confirmation, Ambassador Conde informed me by radio that the Minister of Foreign Affairs had talked to Cpt Murari of the RPA (airport security) by phone and agreed with him that the troops should be photographed individually and processed through, after which UNAMIR would address any concerns raised by the Government. It took a while to locate the Captain to confirm this, and when he finally showed up, with Maj. Kamanzi, they raised security questions. For example, Maj. Kamanzi asked if we could vouch that the troops were not French Legionnaires. They also mentioned that the order should come only from the Minister of Defence.

There was thus a standoff, and some heated arguments. Fortunately, the President of Rwanda and the Minister of Interior were arriving at the airport from Akagera Park, by UNAMIR Helicopter. I joined Ambassador Conde and the Rwandese Chief of Protocol to meet them, and we raised the problem with the Minister of Interior. The Minister personally instructed the immigration officers to comply with the arrangement made by the Minister of Foreign Affairs. UNAMIR's Chief of Security, Mr. Ischlika, then arranged for the photographs to be taken. I left the airport when the processing began, at about 1430 hours.


At about 17:00 hours, we were informed that the Minister of Defence had stopped that process, presumably on the same security grounds raised earlier. There was talk of the repatriation of the troops back to Senegal. It took more than an hour of subsequent negotiation between Ambassador Conde, State Protocol, and the various Ministries to get that resolved. The troops were finally processed through at about 20:30 hours on the intervention of the FC who contacted the Minister of Defence. Steps were also taken to stop a second batch of troops that was due in this morning.

#### Comments

UNAMIR is required to inform the Government, in advance, of incoming troops. That was not done ahead of time in this case. The SRSG's Office only learned of their arrival when there was a crisis. When our protocol office was informed of the presence of the troops at the Airport, they informed immediately the Foreign Ministry. There were two other incidents this month, on 2 February and 20 February, of crises relating to troops whose arrival has apparently not been previously notified.

As we continue to press the Government to honour its obligations under the Status of Mission Agreement, we must certainly honour our own obligations.
