2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL.

(1) MINISTER OF LABOR AND CIVIL AFFAIRS OF RWANDA VISITED GITARAMA ON 09 NOV 94. HE ADDRESSED THE NGOS AT PREFECTURE WHERE HE EXPLAINED HOW TO INCREASE THE COOPERATION BETWEEN THEM AND HIS MINISTRY. HE ALSO ADDRESSED APP 15,000 PEOPLE IN THE STADIUM AND TALKED ABOUT DEVELOPMENT AND REBUILDING UP THE COUNTRY.

b. MILITARY

(1) IT WAS REPORTED THAT RPA WERE ARRESTING MANY PEOPLE AT CYERU (9561). INVESTIGATION WAS ON.

(2) MILOB TEAM WHILE ESCORTING BROWN & ROOT TANKER FROM GIKONGORO TO BUTARE WAS STOPPED BY RPA AT KIZI CHECK POINT. THE RPA DEMANDED TO REMOVED THE UN FLAG FROM THE VEHICLE BY SHOWING REASON THAT FLAGS WERE AUTHORIZED IN UN VEHICLE ONLY DURING WAR PERIOD. THEY ALSO SAID THAT AS THERE WAS NO WAR SITUATION PREVAILING SO NO UN FLAG WOULD BE ALLOWED IN UN VEHICLES. AS THE TEAM WAS NOT PERMITTED TO MOVE FURTHER SO, THEY REMOVED THE FLAG WITH THE INSTRUCTION OF THE SECT COMD 4A AND PROCEEDED TO BUTARE. HOWEVER, SECT COMD SUBMITTED A STRONG PROTEST LETTER TO RPA INDICATING THAT FLAG WAS THE PART OF INSIGNIA OF UN PERSONNEL AND VEHICLES.

(3) 03 RPA OFFICERS ATTENDED THE MEETING OF FORCE COMD WITH NGOS AT KIBUYE.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ.

(1) DCMO ALONG WITH OPS OFFICER WENT TO RUHENGARI FOR STAFF VISIT AND ALSO TO OBSERVE THE SETTING UP OF THE SUB-SECTOR 5. DCMO WAS BRIEFED BY THE OPS OFFICER ABOUT THE ACTIVITIES OF THE SECTOR. IT WAS NOTICED THAT THE COMM NET WORK WAS STILL NOT ESTABLISHED, COULD BE DUE TO THE LOCATION OF THE BASE STATION. HOWEVER, COMM PERSONNEL WOULD GO TO THE LOCATION ON 10 NOV 94 FOR RECTIFICATION OF THE NET WORK

- (1) BOTH GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDERS WERE OPENED FOR ALL TRAFFIC.
- (2) MILOB TEAM ESCORTED 32 DPs FROM KIGALI TO RUKOMO.
- (3) MIND FIELDS WERE DISCOVERED AT MUGABAZI AREA IN NTYABA (0201) COMMUNE AND KANYON (0203) COMMUNE.
- (4) ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT IN AND AROUND THE SECTOR, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

- (1) ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT TO RELIMA, KAUGA, RUTETE, RUSUMO AND NGENDA, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.
- (2) MILOB TEAM ESCORTED DPs FROM KIGALI TO KIBUNGO.
- (3) 1X MILOB TEAM WENT FOR AIR RECCE ALONG THE TANZANIAN BORDER, GENERAL SITUATION FOUND NORMAL.
- (4) WFP DISTRIBUTED FOOD AMONG THE TEACHER AT RUKIRA AREA ON 09 NOV 94.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

- (1) APP 40 BANDITS FROM BURUNDI ARMED WITH MACHETES AND RIFLES ATTACKED THE VILLAGE OF REMERA (7294) ON 08/09 NOV 94. BEFORE THE BANDITS COULD REACH, THE LOCALS FLED AWAY SO THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES. INVESTIGATION CONTINUES.
- (2) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT AT KIGEMBE AND OTHER AREAS, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.
- (3) 05 NUNS WERE ESCORTED FROM BUTARE TO CYANGUGU.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

- (1) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT IN DIFFERENT PARTS OF THE SECTOR, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.
- (2) HUM OFFICER ATTENDED A WEEKLY NGO MEETING AT

GIKONGORO. NGOS COMPLAINED ABOUT THE REFUSAL OF GHANBATT TO PROVIDE ESCORTS AND INVESTIGATION TEAM AT NIGHT.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) MILOB TEAM ESCORTED HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM TO MASS GRAVES SITES AT KIBUYE.

(2) FORCE COMD VISITED THE SECTOR ON 09 NOV 94. HE WAS BRIEFED BY THE SECT COMD ABOUT MILOB ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTOR.

(3) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT IN AND AROUND THE SECTOR, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT AT KAGIKONGORO (8319) AND KAMEMBE COMMUNE, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.

(2) IT WAS REPORTED THAT ONE CIVILIAN WAS WOUNDED BY ~~2~~ MEN WITH UNIFORM AT MBILIZI (8216). MONEY AND OTHER BELONGINGS WERE TAKEN BY THE ATTACKER.

(3) ICRC CONTINUING WITH FOOD DISTRIBUTION~~ed~~ AT NYARUSHISHI (8522)

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT AT RUHENGARI, CYANIKA, TARE, NYAROTOVU (7718) AND OTHER BORDER POSTS, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.

(2) MILOB TEAM ESCORTED HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM FROM GISENYI TO KIBUYE VIA RUBAVU (3213) AND KAYOVE (2892).

(3) MILOB PATROL TEAM WAS STOPPED BY RPA AT KINIGI WHILE PROCEEDING FROM GIFUMBA (528440) TO ZAIRIAN BORDER (540463). THE MATTER WOULD BE INFORMED TO LOCAL RPA COMD ON 10 NOV 94.

a. POLITICAL.

(1) MIN OF TRADE AND TOURISM ACCOMPANIED BY NEW AND

FORMER PREFECT OF RUHENGARI ADDRESSED THE LOCAL ADMINISTRATION, NGOS AND OTHER AGENCIES. THE AIM OF THE MEETING WAS TO INTRODUCED THE NEW PREFECT OF RUHENGARI TO THE PEOPLE.

b. MILITARY.

(1) ON FURTHER INVESTIGATION, IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE KILLINGS WHICH TOOK PLACE AT MAREBA (7548), KAVUMU (7943) AND BURENGE (8233) WERE CARRIED OUT BY RPA. THE INFORMATION WAS RECEIVED FROM LOCAL SOURCE. HOWEVER, PEOPLE IN THOSE AREAS WERE RELUCTANT TO GIVE ANY INFORMATION TO MILOBS AS THEY WERE AFRAID OF RPA.

(2) THE RPA STILL MAINTAINING THEIR POSITION AT RUGABANO (4266).

(3) THE RPA HELD A MEETING WITH THE PEOPLE OF CARENGERA (9421) COMMUNE AND BRIEFED ABOUT THE PRESENT SITUATION OF THE COUNTRY.

(4) THE RPA RELEASED THREE CARITAS DRIVERS WITH THE TRUCKS AT GITARAMA.

(5) FROM 07 NOV 94, GENDARMERIE STARTED THEIR ACTIVITIES AT GISENYI TOWN. APP 50 GENDARMERIE WERE FOUND IN AND AROUND THE TOWN.

a. MILOB GP HQ. NTR.

b. SECTOR 1 BYUMBA.

(1) BOTH GATUNA AND KAGIYUMBA BORDERS REMAINED OPEN FOR ALL TRAFFIC.

(2) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT AT KAGITUMBA AND RUGARAMA AREAS, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO.

(1) MILOB TEAMS CONDUCTED PATROLS AT RILIMA, GASHORA, NGENDA, NYAMATA, SAKE, BARE AND BORDERING AREAS, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.

(2) THE PREFECT OF KIBUNGO REQUESTED TO UNAMIR FOR

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA.

(1) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT TO TAMBWE (7653), RUHANGO (7653) AND RUNYINYA (6111), SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.

(2) MILOB TEAM MONITORED THE EMBARKATION OF RETURNEES AT KABEHO (5307) AND ESCORTED THEM TO BUTARE WAY STATION.

(3) ONE 10 YRS OLD SERIOUSLY SICK BOY WAS EVACUATED BY MILOBS FROM RUNYINYA TO BUTARE HOSPITAL.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO.

(1) MILOB TEAM ESCORTED DPs FROM MUKO CAMP TO GITARAMA.

(2) MAJORITY OF THE PRIMARY SCHOOLS WERE FUNCTIONING WITHOUT ANY FEAR OF THE CHILDREN AND THEIR PARENTS.

(3) INVESTIGATION IN MBOGO CAMP STATED THAT THERE WAS NO HARASSMENT OF THE DPs BY RPA.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE.

(1) MR ERIC OF UNREO WAS ESCORTED TO DIFFERENT PLACES OF THE SECTOR BY THE MILOBS.

(2) PATROLLING WERE CARRIED OUT IN AND AROUND THE SECTOR, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU.

(1) TWO PERSONS WITH MILITARY UNIFORMS ATTACKED THE VILLAGE OF KIBINGO (9532) ON 06/07 NOV 94. NO CASUALTY REPORTED SO FAR. REASON WAS UNKNOWN. INVESTIGATION WAS ON.

(2) MILOB TEAMS CARRIED OUR PATROLS AT KARENGERA (9421), KITABI (3520), KAMEMBE AND DIFFERENT BORDER POSTS, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI.

(1) UNHCR REPORTED THAT ONE FAMILY WAS ATTACKED BY SOME UNIFORM PERSONNEL AT NYANGE (5839) WHERE ONE PERSON WAS KILLED AND OTHER 09 PERSONS WERE WOUNDED OUT OF WHICH TWO WERE CHILDREN. INVESTIGATION WAS ON AND MORE DETAILS TO FOLLOW.

(2) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT TO RUHENGIERI, CYANIKA, MARERU (3318), MUKAMIRA (4521), KABAYA (5006), NGORORERO (6095) AND DIFFERENT BORDERING AREAS, SECURITY SITUATION NORMAL.

(3) MILOB TEAM ATTENDED THE MEETING WITH LOCAL NGOS, DIFFERENT COMMUNE LEADERS AND PREFECTURE. THE MEETING WAS CHAIRED BY MIN OF LABOUR AND SOCIAL AFFAIRS. THE AIM OF THE MEETING WAS TO GROW BETTER COORDINATION AMONG THE HUM ORGANIZATIONS.

i. SECTOR 6 - KIGALI.

(1) 1 X MILOB TEAM ESCORTED 10M TRUCK WITH 47 DPS FROM KIGALI TO KIBUNGO AND RETURNED WITH OTHER 55 DPS.

(2) ANOTHER MILOB TEAM ESCORTED 14 DPS TO NYAMATA AND GASHORA AND CAME BACK TO KIGALI WITH 27 DPS.

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

b. BORDERS

(1) GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPENED TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPENED TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) RUSIZI BORDER POST IN SECT 4C WAS OPENED TO TRAFFIC.

(4) GISENYI AND CYANIKA BORDER POSTS WERE OPENED TO NORMAL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL. NTR.

b. MILITARY

(1) RPA

(a) CONDUCTED ROUTINE DAY AND NIGHT FOOT AND MOBILE PATROLS IN MAJOR TOWNS AND VILLAGES THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY.

(b) IN SECT 3, STRONG RPA TROOPS MOVEMENT FROM BUTARE TOWARDS GITARAMA WAS OBSERVED DURING THE PERIOD. AT 050955B NOV 94, RPA FIRED SA WITHIN GITARAMA. REASON FOR FIRING, DAMAGE AND CAS UNKNOWN.

(c) RPA PATROLS NEAR CONCERN ORPHANAGE AT BUTARE, FIRED SHOTS TO ARREST RPA SOLDIER WHO ESCAPE FROM DETENTION.

(d) RPA ROTATED TROOPS AT IN THE GIKONGORO PREFECTURE.

(e) RPA MAINTAIN POSNS AT NYAMBUYE (2880), RUBYIRO (2169) AND KILIMBI (1049).

(2) MILITIA.

(a) KABURANERA (6111) IN SECT 3, TWO MEN WERE WOUNDED IN AN ATTACK SUSPECTED TO BE CARRIED OUT BY THE INTERAHAMWE.

(b) MILITIA KILLED A MAN AND INJURED TWO PERSONS ON 26 OCT 94.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. PLANNING, COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN SECTORS CARRIED OUT DURING THE PERIOD. ASSISTANCE WAS ALSO GIVEN TO UNREO AND NGOS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOB TEAMS PATROLLED BYUMBA, RUKOMO AND GATUNA AREAS AND REPORTED SIT CALM.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED AND MONITORED ACTIVITIES ALONG THE RWANDA-TANZANIA AND RWANDA - BURUNDI BORDERS AND REPORTED SIT CALM. PATROLS ALSO COVERED SANKE, GASHORA, RUTETE, NGENDA AND NYAMATA.



d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM WITH INCREASED INFLUX OF RETURNEES.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED KIBEHO (9007), BIMAWA (7063), KABGAYI (7468) NTONGWE (9157) AND NUGINA (9267). THE SIT IN THESE AREAS WAS REPORTED CALM.

(3) MILOBS INVESTIGATED ALLEGED ROBBERY BY RPA SOLDIERS AT NTONGWE. IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE SHOP OWNER AND SOME CUSTOMERS WERE BEATEN UP BY THE RPA. THEY ARRESTED SOME INDIVIDUALS. THE SHOP OWNER AND HIS 2 CHILDREN WERE BEATEN AND DETAIN. RPA CONDUCTED JOINT INVESTIGATION WITH MILOBS AND ARRESTED ONE RPA SECTION COMMANDER.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT BORDER PATROLS, MONITORING AND INVESTIGATION DURING THE PERIOD. PATROLS COVERED KADUHA AND RUKONDO AREAS.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD. ROADS IN SECTOR UNMOTORABLE.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT HEL PATROLS IN THE KIBUYE, NYAMBUYE, RUBYIRO, GISORO (1867), GASHORA (1761), RUBEREZO (1158), GITSIMBWE (1052) AND KILOIMBI (1049) MANY CANOES WERE OBSERVED ALONG SHORES OF LAKE AT KILIMBI. SIT IN THESE AREAS WAS CALM.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) ROUTINE PATROLS CONDUCTED WITHIN SECTOR.

(3) UNHCR PERS VISITED THE SECT HQ. THEY DEPOSITED SOME FOOD ITEMS WITH MILOBS TO BE DITRIBUTED TO TRANSIT REFUGEES.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THERE IS TENSION DUE TO MASSACRE AND RECENT ROBBERY CASES IN SOME AREAS WITHIN THE SECTOR.

(2) MILOBS PATROLLED GISENYI AND BORDER POSTS, NYUNDO (248117), RUHENGARI, CYANIKA (7153), KINIGI (5540), BISOKE (449393) AND MAROKE AND REPORTED AREA CALM AFTER ESCALATION OF ROBBERY AND MURDERS.

(3) OTHER PATROLS COVERED NAYRUTOVU (7518), MATABA (7110), NTUGAMO (7300) GASIZA (7296), KAVUMO (7697), AND OTHER AREAS WITHIN THE SECTORS.

i. SECTOR 6 - KIGALI

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI AND ITS SUBURBS REMAINED CALM. RPA INTENSIFIED THEIR ROUTINE FOOT AND MOBILE PATROLS AND MOUNTED SNAP ROAD BLOCKS IN THE CAPITAL ESPECIALLY AT NIGHT.

(2) SECTOR MILOBS ESCORTED UNCHR TRUCKS WITH A TOTAL OF 49 DPs FROM KIGALI TO KIBUNGO AND ESCORTED 41 DPs TO KIGALI. ANOTHER TEAM OF MILOBS ESCORTED 5 UNHCR WITH 207 DPs TO NYAMATA AND NGENDA.

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

a. THERE HAS BEEN A SHARP INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF RETURNEES/DPs IN THE KADUHA CAMP.

b. WATER SUPPLY HAS RESUMED AT GIKONGORO.

c. SCHOOL AT GISORO HAD ITS ROOF RIPPED OFF BY A STORM. SCHOOLS AND BUILDINGS ALONG THE LAKE SHORE WERE ALSO RIPPED OFF DURING A STORM.

d. 250 AND 300 DPs AT RUGANO AND BIRAMBO RESPECTIVELY  
AWAITING EVACUATION.







(7) 133 DPs WERE EVAC BY UNHCR FROM NYAMASHEKE (9841) TO VARIOUS DESTINATIONS ON 01 NOV 94. ABOUT 1,000 DPs IN SAME LOC ARE AWAITING EVAC.

(8) 1,160 OUT OF 3702 DPs AT KIRAMBO (0444) ARE AWAITING EVAC. 39 DPs AT BUGARAMA ARE ALSO AWAITING EVAC TO CYANGUGU.

(11) MSF AND ICRC DISTRIBUTED FARM IMPLEMENTS AND OTHER RELIEF MATERIALS TO 6690 FAMILIES IN THE KIGEMBE COMMUNE IN SECT 3 DURING THE PERIOD. THE COMMUNE LACKED MED SUPPLIES AND AS A RESULT, THE MED CENTRE IN THE COMMUNE YET TO OPEN. LOCALS ALSO REQUESTED FOR FOOD, MED AND WATER SUPPLIES FROM NGOS.

THE NUNS WERE ACCUSED OF NOT HAVING THE CORRECT VEH DOCUS. WHEN MILOBS INTERVENED, THE RPA TROOPS INSISTED ON CLEARANCE FROM THE INTERIOR MINISTRY IN ORDER TO RELEASE THE CAR.

b. THE TWO JOURNALIST ARRESTED AND DETAINED BY RPA AT URMULI HOTEL, RUHengeri WERE REPORTED TO BE IN GOOD CONDITION. RPA INFO INDICATED THAT THE TWO MAY BE TRANSFERRED TO KIGALI BY 03 NOV 94.

(c) REPORTS RECEIVED BY SECTOR MILOBS CONCERNING MUKO ~~IS~~ CAMP BURNING INCIDENT IN SECT 4A INDICATES THAT THE BOURGEMESTRE OF MUKO (381414) WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN THE BURNING. THIS WAS SAID TO BE A RETALIATORY MEASURE AGAINST CAMP DWELLERS WHO DISOBEYED HIS ORDERS.



ON INQUIRY IT WAS LEARNT THAT ON 31 OCT 94 AT AROUND 1800 HRS ONE UN VEHICLE WITH BRITCON PERSONNEL ARRIVED AT GATUNA BORDER POST FROM KABALE. ACCORDING TO THE UGANDAN BORDER GUARDS, THE BRITCON SOLDIERS WERE DRUNK AND BEHAVED WITH THEM IN AN IMPROPER MANNER. THE SOLDIERS THREW SOME BOTTLES ON THE ROAD.
