



I write in connection with our March 24, 2008 meeting at the U.S. Mission, and to advise you that the United Nations' proposal has been brought to the Mayor's attention. The Mayor's first step in assessing the proposal is a review of all underlying data related to the various United Nations requests.

Specifically, the City requests the following: (1) all threat and risk assessment reports for the UN Complex; (2) all security guidelines for the Capital Master Plan; (3) the blast analysis review conducted by Weidlinger Associates; and (4) any additional data or reports apart from this list which relate to the perimeter security proposal.
