NOTES SUR LA RENCONTRE DU SECRETAIRE GENERAL
AVEC LE PRESIDENT DE L'ALGERIE

Le Secrétaire général se propose de faire avec le Président le tour d'horizon d'un certain nombre de problèmes internationaux qui préoccupent les Nations Unies à l'heure actuelle. Cefaisant, il évoque le conflit Iran/Irak et résume les récents développements, en particulier au niveau du Conseil de sécurité des Nations Unies. Sur ce plan, il évoque la possibilité pour lui, si les conditions en particulier du côté iranien le lui permettent, de se rendre dans la région auprès des autorités de Baghdad et de Téhéran.

Le Président remercie le Secrétaire général pour son exposé et souligne la nécessité pour lui de poursuivre l'effort commencé. Il considère que c'est bon signe de la part de l'Irak d'avoir proclamé une trêve unilatérale de 30 jours. Il rappelle les efforts que son pays, depuis longtemps, n'a cessé de déployer sur le plan bilatéral pour aider à la solution de ce conflit. Ces efforts de l'Algérie se poursuivent encore et il assure le Secrétaire général que s'il y avait quoi que ce soit que son pays pouvait faire pour compléter l'action des Nations Unies, il le ferait volontiers.

Evoquant la situation au Moyen-Orient, le Secrétaire général rappelle la réunion qu'il a eue à Genève avec M. Peres et le Président Mubarak. Il souligne la complexité de la situation au Moyen-Orient, due en particulier à l'enchevêtrement des problèmes bilatéraux et multilatéraux.

Le Président considère pour sa part que dans cette affaire deux faits important : d'abord la participation de l'OLP à la Conférence internationale dont il est question, et ensuite l'idée d'un état palestinien lui paraît essentielle.

Le Secrétaire général considère que l'idée de la conférence fait son chemin. Il lui semble soupçonner un certain assouplissement dans la position des Etats-unis et il pense qu'une certaine souplesse du côté de l'Union soviétique serait également importante.

A propos de l'Afrique australe, le Secrétaire général se dit inquiet de l'ensemble de la situation, et en particulier de celle qui prévaut en Angola qui, après le Mozambique, se trouve aujourd'hui dans une situation économique particulièrement difficile.

Le Secrétaire général évoque aujourd'hui la question du Sahara occidental, en particulier ses efforts pour promouvoir l'envoi d'une mission technique d'évaluation sur le terrain.

Le Président estime que la mission en question doit s'inscrire strictement dans le cadre des résolutions pertinentes de l'OUA et des Nations Unies. Les craintes évoquées par le Front Polisario concernant la mission lui paraissent justifiées. Il importe donc de rassurer ces derniers sur la nature exacte et le mandat de celle-ci. Le Président estime que si ces assurances étaient fournies au Polisario, il lui semble que les difficultés soulevées concernant la mission n'auraient pas d'objet.

Le Président déclare avoir reçu une lettre du Roi qui portait uniquement sur des questions bilatérales. Il voudrait saisir cette occasion pour rassurer le Maroc sur les intentions de l'Algérie à propos du Maghreb. En effet, un effort important est déployé en ce moment pour regrouper les pays du Maghreb et il importe que le Maroc comprenne que ces efforts ne sont pas dirigés contre lui. Le Président pense que les relations diplomatiques entre les deux pays pourraient être prochainement rétablies. Il insiste encore sur la bonne volonté de l'Algérie d'agir dans un esprit de coopération. C'est dans ce sens que son pays travaille à créer plus de confiance parmi les pays de la région. Une telle action ne doit pas être vue comme une tentative d'isolement du Maroc. Son gouvernement ne réclame pas aujourd'hui une solution définitive au différend sur le Sahara occidental; mais, l'Algérie aimerait beaucoup recevoir de la part du Roi des signes positifs de bonne volonté en vue d'un règlement.

Il tient à rappeler que la libération des prisonniers, qui a eu lieu récemment, est une initiative de l'Algérie qui a reçu une réponse positive du Maroc. Il tient à rappeler au Secrétaire général que, s'il y a quoi que ce soit que l'Algérie puisse accepter de faire concernant le Sahara occidental, ce sera dans le cadre des Nations Unies; et, qu'aucune initiative ne sera prise par l'Algérie sans que, au préalable, le Secrétaire général soit consulté.



TWENTY-THIRD ORDINARY SESSION OF THE SUMMIT CONFERENCE
OF HEADS OF STATE AND GOVERNMENT OF THE ORGANIZATION OF
AFRICAN UNITY

General

1. The Twenty-third Ordinary Session of the OAU Summit will be held in Addis Ababa from 27 to 29 July 1987. President Kaunda of Zambia is expected to be elected the next current Chairman of the OAU at the opening meeting scheduled to start at 4.00 p.m. on 27 July 1987. The OAU Secretariat has confirmed that the Secretary-General is included in the list of speakers to address the opening meeting. It is estimated that about twenty-five Heads of State will attend the Summit.
2. The Summit is preceded by the Forty-sixth Ordinary Session of the OAU Council of Ministers from 20 to 26 July 1987. Foreign Minister Ben Mkapa of Tanzania is the new Chairman of the OAU Council of Ministers. The deliberations of the Council of Ministers focused primarily on the situation in Southern Africa and the United Nations Programme of Action for African Economic Recovery and Development.
3. The United Nations Council for Namibia, the United Nations Anti-apartheid Committee and the United Nations Committee on Decolonisation participated in the deliberations on the situation in Southern Africa.
4. Mr. Adebayo Adedeji, Executive Secretary of the ECA, participated in the discussions of the Ministerial Council on the Programme of Action for African Economic Recovery and Development. He made a statement to the Council (copy on file with Omayad) in which he clarified the position of the United Nations and the Secretary-General. The ECA actively participated in the deliberations on related economic issues.
5. The Council of Ministers will conclude its work later today.

Agenda of the Summit

6. There is no doubt whatsoever that the deliberations of the Summit will be dominated by the situation in Southern Africa.
7. Last year the OAU Summit established an Ad Hoc Standing Committee of Heads of State and Government on the question of Southern Africa, chaired by the OAU current Chairman and comprising all the Heads of State and Government of the Frontline States and Nigeria, the outgoing Chairman, Chairmen of the Liberation Movements as well as Algeria, Ethiopia, Cape Verde and Congo. The Ad Hoc Committee met in Lusaka Zambia, yesterday (25 July 1987) at the Summit level to review developments and is expected to make recommendations to the OAU Summit on the situation. The current Chairman of the OAU will submit a report to the Summit on the question of Southern Africa.

8. In addition to the situation in Southern Africa, the main items on the agenda of the OAU will include the Programme of Action for African Economic Recovery and Development, the question of Western Sahara, Chad, the refugee situation and the Middle East. The Summit will also elect Assistant Secretaries-General for five geographical regions of the OAU. Among other things, the Summit is expected to focus on arrangements for the twenty-fifth anniversary of the OAU. Nigeria has offered to host the twenty-fifth anniversary meetings of the OAU at Abuja, its new federal capital. The Nigerian invitation is expected to be accepted.

Meetings of the Secretary-General

9. Mr. Omayad has met with the Foreign Ministers of the Frontline States concerned to prepare for the Secretary-General's meeting with their respective Heads of State. Similarly, the Executive Secretary of the ECA, as well as Mr. Issa Diallo, has also met with Foreign Ministers concerned in regard to other vital issues to prepare for the Secretary-General's meetings with the Heads of State concerned.

10. Mr. Adedeji has prepared short briefs for the Secretary-General on relations with the host country (Ethiopia) and the local situation for the Secretary-General's meeting with Chairman Mengistu. He has also prepared a background note for the Secretary-General on the Programme of Action for African Economic Recovery and Development (copies with Mr. Diallo).

11. The Executive Secretary of the ECA, Mr. Adedeji, has provided an Office at Africa Hall (with appropriate furniture) for the Secretary-General's meetings with Heads of State. The Office adjoins the main Conference Hall where the Summit will be held, in order to provide for the convenience of both the Secretary-General and his guests.

Related Developments

12. In the Secretary-General's discussions with the Francophone and Anglophone Heads of State, he might wish to find out separately how they view the prospects for:


- (a) the Francophone Summit scheduled to be held in Canada (Quebec) in early September 1987; and
- (b) the Commonwealth Summit in Canada (Vancouver) in October 1987.

13. The Secretary-General might wish to indicate in these discussions that he will be prepared to send messages to these two Summits (similar to the one he sent to the Venice Summit), in which he would advocate for greater support for the African Recovery Programme, Frontline States, and a concerted effort for the eradication of apartheid in Southern Africa. The Secretary-General might also wish to offer to send a small United Nations technical team to Canada to assist African countries at these two Conferences. If the idea is accepted, it would be left to the Francophone and Anglophone countries concerned to arrange clearance for the UN team for Canada, with their respective Organizations.

14. In regard to the Secretary-General's discussion with President Kaunda after his election as current Chairman, the Secretary-General might wish to find out when he intends to be in New York to address the General Assembly on behalf of the OAU.

Visit of the Prime Minister of Norway to Addis Ababa

15. Mrs Gro Brundtland, Prime Minister of Norway is expected to arrive in Addis Ababa today. She has been invited to address the opening Session of the OAU Summit in her capacity as President of the World Commission on Environment and Development and to launch the programme of the Commission.

ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE SECRETARY-GENERAL'S VISIT
TO ADDIS ABABA FOR THE OAU SUMMIT CONFERENCE

The Secretary-General will visit Addis Ababa to address the opening session of the OAU Summit Conference which is to take place on 27 July 1987. He will be accompanied by Mrs. Pérez de Cuéllar.

In consultation with the Secretary-General the following arrangements have been decided upon:

I. MINISTERIAL MEETING (20 to 25 July 1987)

(a) Composition of advance party

1. Mr. Issa Diallo, Director, Offices of the Secretary-General
2. Mr. Hisham Omayad, Director, Department for Special Political Questions, Regional Co-operation, Decolonization and Trusteeship

(b) Assignments

(i) Mr. Issa Diallo will be responsible, in close co-operation with ECA, for all contacts with the Ethiopian authorities and the OAU Secretariat, concerning arrangements for the Secretary-General's arrival and stay in the capital, including hotel reservations and transportation. In addition, Mr. Diallo will be responsible for contacts with the OAU Secretary-General regarding the Secretary-General's participation in the Summit, as well as for arranging appointments on behalf of the Secretary-General with the following Heads of Delegations:

Head of State of Ethiopia, OAU Chairman, OAU Secretary-General, President Kaunda of Zambia (Chairman of the Front-line States), President of Senegal, Head of State of Nigeria, President of Angola, President of Mozambique, President of Algeria, Mr. Abdul Aziz, Secretary-General, POLISARIO, President Hissene Habre of Chad, Head of Delegation of Sudan, Head of Delegation of Somalia.

(ii) Mr. Hisham Omayad will be responsible for monitoring and keeping abreast of the proceedings in the various committees of the OAU Ministerial Meeting, and will prepare a brief memorandum of not more than two pages summarizing the highlights of the discussions. This memorandum is to be ready for presentation to the Secretary-General upon his arrival at 5:00 p.m., on Sunday, 26 July 1987.


