Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

The Century Foundation's Prospects for Peace Initiative is sponsoring meetings and events in New York City next week with Shlomo Ben-Ami, former Israeli Minister of Foreign Affairs and Minister of Public Security, to discuss the future of the Arab-Israeli conflict, the prospects of an Israeli-Palestinian settlement, and the broader regional challenges. We write to inquire whether, if you think it could be useful, a meeting with you might be possible.

Prof. Ben-Ami, now vice president of the Toledo International Center for Peace, is currently working with former senior officials of Israel's security establishment and with informed Palestinians on developing a detailed plan for a ceasefire. This plan he will be sharing in private meetings.

Drawing on his extensive experience as a key participant in Arab-Israeli negotiations ranging from the 1991 Madrid Conference to the 2000 Camp David summit and the Taba negotiations that followed, Prof. Ben-Ami will discuss in all his engagements ideas for advancing the Annapolis peace process in the coming year. He can also share his insights regarding the uncertain regional context in the Middle East with respect to Iran, Syria, the Arab League Initiative, and the requirements for brokering peace in the region.

As Israeli Foreign Minister, Prof. Ben-Ami conducted secret negotiations with his Palestinian counterpart Abu Ala in Stockholm, participated with Prime Minister Ehud Barak in the Camp David Summit, and led the Israeli team in the negotiating rounds that followed Camp David, including Taba. He is the author of, among others, *Scars of War, Wounds of Peace: The Arab-Israeli Tragedy* (Oxford University Press, 2006), a highly-acclaimed comprehensive overview of Israel's role in the Arab-Israeli conflict.
