Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

You will recall that in July 2010, the General Assembly adopted by consensus the United Nations Global Plan of Action against Trafficking in Persons. The Plan, *inter alia*, calls for the General Assembly to appraise in 2013 the progress achieved in its implementation. In December 2012 the General Assembly passed resolution 67/190 on improving the coordination of efforts against trafficking in persons, and decided to convene "a high level meeting of the General Assembly no later than July 2013 in order to assess achievement, gaps and challenges including in the implementation of relevant legal instruments".

✓ I have therefore decided to schedule this high level meeting for Monday, 13 May 2013.

By adopting the Global Plan of Action against Trafficking in Persons, Governments resolved to take concrete action to prevent trafficking in persons, protect and assist victims, prosecute related crimes and strengthen partnership among Government, civil society organizations and the private sector, including the media. One of the most important elements of the Global Plan of Action is the "*United Nations Voluntary Trust Fund for Victims of Trafficking in Persons, especially women and children*", which is managed by the UN Office on Drugs and Crime with the advice of a board of trustees appointed by you Mr. Secretary-General.

It is my hope that the high level meeting will provide an opportunity for an in-depth and forward looking discussion on the implementation of the Global Plan of Action. Also the meeting will hopefully help raise additional support for the important Trust Fund to which Member States and the public will be encouraged to contribute.

In light of your unwavering commitment to the fight against human trafficking, it is my honour Mr. Secretary-General, to invite you to address in the opening segment this important high level meeting. I would be most grateful if you would favorably consider this invitation.
