(1) TODAY, ONE MILOB TEAM (B), ALONG WITH A RECOVERY DET FROM 95 CSMG AND RPA GUIDES, PERFORMED AN ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL AUTHORITIES MISSION. YESTERDAY EVENING, THE LOG O 92ND RPA BN REQUESTED THE RECOVERY OF ONE OF THEIR HEAVY TRUCKS (MERCEDES DUMP TRUCK) WHICH A MONTH AGO WAS OVERTURNED AND FELL FOUR (4) METRES IN A NEAR DRY STREAM BED AFTER MISSING A CROSSING OF THE BRIDGE AT GR (SC229542) NEAR THE VILLAGE OF FUMBA GR (SC2254) IN THE GISOVU COMMUNE. THE LOG O STATED THAT THIS ACCIDENT RESULTED IN THE INJURY TO THREE (3) RPA SOLDIERS AND ONE (1) CIVILIAN WORKING FOR THE RPA. THE RECOVERY DET EFFECTED OVER A TEN (10) HOUR PERIOD AND UNDER VERY DIFFICULT TERRAIN CONDITIONS NOT ONLY THE EXTRACTION OF

a. SECTOR HQ. TODAY, THE INDIAN SIGNALS DETACHEMENT MOVED FROM IT'S FORMER LOCATION TO THE EDEN ROC HOTEL, KIBUYE WHERE THEY ARE NOW BRIGADED WITH US. LAND LINE COMMUNICATION WAS INTERRUPTED DURING THE AFTERNOON AND WILL NOT RESUME UNTIL TOMOROW MORNING AT THE VERY SOONEST.

(1) ONE MILOB TEAM (A) PATROLLED BWIZA GR (3673) IN THE RUTSIRO COMMUNE. THE TEAM VISITED THE BWIZA REFUGEE CAMP. THERE, THEY SPOKE TO THE CONSEILLER, WHO STATED THAT YESTERDAY ONE MAN WAS PLACED UNDER ARREST BY RPA SOLDIERS WHO CAME FROM THE GISENYI PREFECTURE. THE REASON WAS NOT MADE KNOWN TO HIM, NEITHER DID THE RUTSIRO STATIONNED RPA SOLDIERS KNOW ANYTHING ABOUT IT. HE WAS TAKEN TO GISENYI WHERE HIS PRESENT STATUS IS UNKNOWN. THE TEAM QUESTIONNED THE UNHCR REP AT THE CAMP WHO CLAIMED THERE ARE SUPPOSE TO BE 600 REFUGEES IN THE AREA; HOWEVER, ONLY 100 PERSONS CAN BE ACCOUNTED FOR AT THE CAMP, AND MAYBE ANOTHER 70 PERSONS IN A CAMP WHOSE

LOCATION IS IS NOT EXACTLY KNOWN, BUT IS SUPPOSED TO BE SITUATED AT ONE HOURS WALK NORTH OF THE MAIN CAMP. THE REPRESENTATIVE SAID THAT HE WILL INVESTIGATE WHERE ARE THE OTHER APPROX 400 REFUGEES WHICH ARE SUPPOSED TO BE IN THE RUTSIRO COMMUNE. THERE WERE NO FURTHER THINGS TO REPORT.

A. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED BUHINGA GR (3579) IN THE MABANZA COMMUNE. THE VEH COULD NOT GO TO THE OBJECTIVE AS THE RD WAS UNPRACTICABLE. THEY SPOKE WITH LOCALS ON THE RD. THESE REPORTED THAT IN THE BUHINGA SECTOR, ONCE OR TWICE A WEEK, GANGS OF TUTSI SURVIVORS COME AT NIGHT TO EXTORT FROM THEM CATTLE AND MONEY. THE PEOPLE BELIEVE THAT THERE MAY BE RPA COMPLICITY IN THIS. NO ONE SO FAR HAS BEEN REPORTED BEATEN OR ARRESTED, HAS THEY SIMPLY HAND OVER THEIR PROPERTY WITHOUT RESISTANCE. THEY ALSO STATED THAT A MAN WAS ARRESTED IN THE AFTERNOON OF 27 JUL FOR REFUSING TO REPORT FOR A COMMUNAL RD WORK PARTY. THE PEOPLE SAID THAT HE WAS TAKEN BY COMMUNE POLICE TO THE MUBUGA CELLULE GR(3577) CACHOT.

B. THE OPS O VISITED THE PREFECT OF KIBUYE AND REQUESTED TO KNOW WHY THE MILOBS PATROLS WERE BEING STOPPED AND DENIED PASSAGE TO GISOVU COMMUNE CENTRE AT AN RPA CHECK-POINT GR(2859) ON 25 JUL 95. THE RPA HAD DEMANDED A WRITTEN FROM THE RPA BN COMD IN ORDER THAT THE PATROL PROCEED THROUGH. M. LE PRÉFET ANSWERED THAT HE BELIEVES THIS TO BE BECAUSE UNAMIR SENDS HELICOPTER PATROLS TO THAT AREA AND THAT THE BOURGHMEISTRE, NOT LIKING THAT UNAMIR DOES NOT SEEK HIS AUTHORITY TO DO SO, HAS DECIDED TO CONTROL RD MOVEMENT OF UNAMIR IN HIS COMMUNE. THE OPS O RESTATED THE MANDATE ACCESS OF UNAMIR TO PATROL AND THE PREFECT SAID THAT HE WOULD SPEAK TO THE BOURGHMEISTRE.



1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE SITUATION IS CALM ALTHOUGH FEAR AND APPREHENSION OF INSECURITY PREVAILS AMONG THE LOCALS IN THE PREFECTURE AS BEFORE.

 - A. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED MURUNDI GR (5573) AND NYAMINAMBE GR (4968) IN THE BWAKIRA COMMUNE. GENERAL INFORMATION WAS GATHERED FOR STATISTICAL PURPOSES, SOME OF WHICH WAS PASSED ON TO THE APPROPRIATE AGENCY. THE GENERAL SITUATION IS REPORTED CALM.
 - B. A SECOND MILOB TEAM PATROLLED KIBUYE TOWN GR (2772) IN THE GITESI COMMUNE. THE GENERAL SITUATION IS REPORTED CALM. THEY VISITED THE KIBUYE HOSPITAL WHO HAS RECENTLY OPENED A WARD RESERVED FOR INMATES OF THE KIBUYE PRISON. THERE, THEY SAW TWO MEN WERE INTERNED THERE FOR WOUND RESULTING FROM BEATING, ONE OF WHICH WAS BEING TREATED FOR A FLAYED CHEST, ALLEGEDLY CAUSED BY A RIFLE BUTT. WHEN VISITING THE COMMUNE OFFICE, THE BOURGHMEISTRE INFORMED THEM THAT THE INJURY CAUSED TO THAT INMATE WAS THE RESULT OF ROUGHING UP BY HIS POLICEMEN. HE DID NOT ADVANCE ANY REASON FOR THIS OCCURANCE; HOWEVER, HE STATED THAT HE TOLD HIS POLICEMEN NOT TO DO THIS AGAIN.
5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES AT THE REQUEST OF THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL OF THE TEACHING INSTITUTE OF KIBUYE GR (2772) AND THE KIBUYE HOSPITAL, OUR SECTOR HQ ARRANGED FOR THE AIRMEDEVAC TO AUSMED OF A 19 YEAR OLD WOMAN STUDENT SUFFERING FROM A BACK INJURY.



SUBJECT: SITREP COVERING PERIOD FROM 251800 TO 261800 JULY 95.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE SITUATION IS CALM ALTHOUGH FEAR AND APPREHENSION OF INSECURITY PREVAILS AMONG THE LOCALS IN THE PREFECTURE AS BEFORE.

4. OWN ACTIVITIES

A. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED KIVUMU SECTOR GR (5573), THE GENERAL SITUATION IS REPORTED CALM. THE TEAM MET THE ASSISTANT BOURGEMEISTRE OF KIVUMU COMMUNE WHO INFORMED THEM OF THE REFUGEE SITUATION IN THE COMMUNE. HE TOLD THE TEAM THAT THERE ARE 255 REFUGEES AT NYANGE GR (5572). THEY ARRIVED ON 22 JUNE 95 FROM ZAIRE AND ARE WAITING TO BE RESETTLED. HE FURTHER TOLD THE TEAM THAT THE REFUGEES ARE LACKING FOOD, BLANKETS, AND ACCOMMODATIONS. THE REFUGEES HAVE REQUESTED TO BE RESETTLED IN RUTSIRO COMMUNE WHICH HAS SIMILAR CLIMATIC CONDITIONS AS ZAIRE. HOWEVER, THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES HAVE OBJECTED TO THIS REQUEST BECAUSE THERE ARE ALREADY ABOUT 1500 REFUGEES IN THAT AREA. THE TEAM ALSO VISITED NYANGE HOSPITAL AND FOUND THE HOSPITAL FUNCTIONING WELL. THE TEAM LEARNED THAT A PRISONER FROM KIVUMU PRISON WAS ADMITTED ON 16 JULY 95. HE IS NURSING SEVERE WOUNDS HE SUSTAINED FROM BEATINGS BY KIVUMU COMMUNE POLICE. IT IS ALLEGED THAT HE WAS ARRESTED ON 10 JULY 95 AND TAKEN TO KIVUMU PRISON WHERE HE WAS BEATEN BY COMMUNE POLICE. BUT REASONS FOR HIS ARREST ARE NOT KNOWN. HOSPITAL AUTHORITIES HAVE RECOMMENDED THAT HE BE TRANSFERRED TO GITARAMA HOSPITAL BUT THE BOURGEMEISTRE HAS STOPPED THE TRANSFER. ANOTHER VICTIM OF BEATINGS BY THE SAME COMMUNE POLICE FROM THE NSANZA SECTOR IS ALLEGED TO HAVE FAILED TO MEET THE DEMAND OF PAYING 10,000 RWANDESE FRANCS TO COMMUNE POLICE FOR NO KNOWN CAUSE. HE IS NURSING HEAD WOUNDS.

B. A SECOND MILOB TEAM PATROLLED RUSHISHI GR (2558) IN THE GISOVU COMMUNE. THE GENERAL SITUATION IS REPORTED CALM, ALTHOUGH THERE IS ACUTE HARASSMENT IN THE NYARUBUYE CELLULE GR (2353). IT WAS DIFFICULT FOR THIS TEAM TO GAIN INFORMATION BECAUSE THEY WERE TOLD BY THE LOCALS THAT THOSE WHO TALKED TO UNAMIR ON 7 JULY 95 ARE NOW WANTED BY RPA. AMONG THE WANTED PEOPLE IS ONE TEACHER FROM NYARUBUYE GR(2353) PRIMARY SCHOOL. AT RUSHISHI, THE NUMBER OF REFUGEES HAS REDUCED FROM 132 TO 95. MOST OF THEM WENT TO RESETTLE ON THEIR OWN TO MABANZA COMMUNE. THE REFUGEES WHO ARE PRESENT IN THIS LOCATION REQUIRE FOOD, BLANKETS, AND COOKING UTENSILS. THE TEAM FURTHER VISITED GISOVU HEALTH CENTRE GR(2952) AND WERE INFORMED THAT THE HOSPITAL HAS RUN OUT OF KEROSENE FOR THE REFRIGERATOR. HENCE, THEY HAVE A PROBLEM IN THE STORING OF VACCINES. THE TEAM WAS DENIED PASSAGE TO GISOVU COMMUNE CENTRE AT AN RPA CHECK-POINT GR(2859). THE RPA DEMANDED A WRITTEN FROM THE RPA BN COMD IN ORDER THAT THE PATROL PROCEED THROUGH.

THE TEAM ALSO MEET A PADRE RESPONSIBLE FOR ADVERTIST CHURCH IN MWENDO WHO INFORMED THEM THAT THERE ARE CURRENTLY FOUR TYPES OF CHURCHES IN THE COMMUNE AND THERE IS NO TENSION BETWEEN THEM AT ALL .







C. THIRD MILOB TEAM PATROLLED RUTONDE GR (5780) IN KIVUMU COMMUNE , THE GENERAL SITUATION IS REPORTED CALM BUT LOCALS ARE STILL LIVING IN FEAR OF BEING ARRESTED . MEN IN RUTONDE CELLULE ARE REPORTED TO BE HIDING DURING THE DAY AND VISIT THEIR FAMILIES IN THE NIGHT . ON 7 JULY 95 , UNDISCLOSED NUMBER OF THIEVES ARMED WITH WPNS STOLE 2 COWS AND DRESSES FROM LOCALS . THEY ARE ALLEGED TO HAVE COME FROM GITARAMA AND GISENYI PREFECTURES . ON 11 JULY 95 , SEVEN THIEVES ARMED WITH WPNS RAIDED RUTONDE , THREW A GRENADE AT MR RUZIDANE WHO DIED ON THE SPOT . 



KIBUYE MILOBS ASSISTED IN THE EVAC OF THE PATIENT WITH MSF TO THE HELIPAD. UPON ARRIVAL THE IEM DIAGNOSED THE PATIENT WHO HAD SLIPPED INTO COMMA HAS HAVING INSUFFICIENT BLOOD PRESSURE TO BE AIRMEDEVACED, AS THIS WOULD SURELY AGGRAVATE HER CONDITION TO THE POINT OF DEATH. A. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED BUDAHAMAGARWA GR (2962) IN GITESI COMMUNE , SITUATION IS CALM ALTHOUGH FEAR AND APPREHENSION IS STILL PREVAILING AMONG THE LOCALS . LOCALS IN BADAHAMAGARWA TOLD THE MILOB TEAM THAT THERE IS CONTINUOUS HARASSMENT AND FEAR OF ARREST ARE PREVAILING IN GITESI SECTOR GR (3366) AND RUBAZO GR (2963) BY RPA AND TUTSIS . IN RUBAZO SECTOR 10 PEOPLE ARE REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN ARRESTED IN THE MONTH OF JUNE FOR ALLEGED PARTICIPATION IN LAST YEAR'S GENOCIDE AND ARE CURRENTLY BEING DETAINED IN KIBUYE PRISON .THE MILOB TEAM WAS FURTHER TOLD THAT IN BUDAHAMAGARWA ON 17 JUNE THREE PEOPLE WERE ARRESTED NAMELY , BAVAKURE , RWADINDA AND NIKOBATUYE , THEY ARE ALSO ACCUSED OF GENOCIDE . THE TEAM WAS TOLD THAT THERE ARE NO RETURNEES COMING BACK BECAUSE OF THE HARASSMENT AND FEAR OF BEING ARRESTED . THE TEAM ALSO LEARNED THAT 10 FAMILIES ARE STARVING AND HAVE NO SHELTER BECAUSE THEIR HOUSES WERE DESTROYED DURING THE WAR .

B. SECOND MILOB TEAM PATROLLED MUHAVU GR (1056) IN RWAMATAMU COMMUNE , SITUATION IS REPORTED CALM ALTHOUGH CASES OF ARRESTS ARE STILL CONTINUING . LOCALS TOLD THE TEAM THAT THREE WEEKS AGO RPA
