1. GENERAL SITUATION. CALM.
2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. NTR
3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

A. RPA. RPA ESCORTED TODAY 14 JUL 95 AT 1200 HRS 225 PRISONERS TRANSFERRED FROM GITARAMA PRISON TO NYANZA PRISON (IN BUTARE PREFECTURE).

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. GITARAMA TEAM

1) THE MOVEMENT OF PRISONERS FROM GITARAMA PRISON TO NYANZA PRISON (IN BUTARE PREFECTURE) STARTED AT 1200 HRS ON 14 JUL 95. THERE WERE SOME SERIOUS DELAYS IN THE LOADING OF THE PRISONERS DUE TO A RUMOUR THAT WAS CIRCULATING IN THE PRISON TO THE EFFECT THAT BOUTROS GHALI WAS GOING TO VISIT THE PRISON TODAY. THEREFORE NOBODY WANTED TO LEAVE IN THE HOPE THAT THE SECRETARY GENERAL COULD FREE THEM. THE SECTOR COMMANDER HAD TO USE A LOUD SPEAKER INSIDE THE JAIL TO QUASH THAT RUMOUR. AFTER ADVISING THE CROWD THAT HE WAS BOUTROS BOUTROS GHALI'S REPRESENTATIVE, HE EXPLAINED TO THEM THAT HE WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR SAFE TRANSPORTATION TO NYANZA PRISON. THIS INTERVENTION PROVED VERY SUCCESSFUL AND THEN IT WAS A MATTER OF REACHING AN AGREEMENT ON VARIOUS LISTS WHICH WERE PREPARED BY THE ICRC AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE PRISON. THE VEHICLE WHICH PROVIDED FOR THIS TASK WERE:

- 1) SIX UN TRUCKS FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF PRISONERS (A SEVENTH WAS KEPT IN RESERVE).
- 2) FOUR ESCORT VEHICLES / UNAMIR (PICK UP) DRIVEN

BY MALICOY SOLDIERS WITH ARMED RPA TROOPS IN THE BACK.

3) TWO ESCORT VEHICLES / R.P.A

4) ONE AMBULANCE FOLLOWED BY NUMEROUS VEHICLES OF THE ICRC, HE, MINISTER OF JUSTICE REPRESENTATIVE, ETC

ONE MILOB TEAM, INCLUDING THE COMMANDER SECTOR 1B MONITORED AND ACCOMPANIED THE CONVOY. THE CONVOY ARRIVED AT NYANZA PRISON AT 1300 HRS AND THE 50 PRISONERS IN THE WORSE MEDICAL CONDITION WERE SEGREGATED AND IMMEDIATELY TAKEN TO THE PRISON CLINIC. THE MORALE OF THE PRISONERS WAS QUITE HEIGHTENED DESPITE THEIR TERRIBLE STATE. ONE MUST UNDERSCORE, HOWEVER THE ABSOLUTE PRIORITY THAT SHOULD BE GIVEN TO THIS KIND OF OPERATION. THE SECTOR COMMANDER'S ESTIMATION IS THAT AT LEAST 3000 MORE PRISONERS WOULD HAVE TO BE SENT TO OTHER PRISONS IN THE COUNTRY TO BRING THE CONDITIONS IN THE GITARAMA PRISON AT A HUMANLY ACCEPTABLE LEVEL. IN A DISCUSSION WITH THE GITARAMA PRISON DIRECTOR, IT WAS LEARNED THAT THE GISENY PENITENTIARY FACILITIES COULD BE THE NEXT DESTINATION. THE DIRECTOR OF PENITENTIARY SERVICES IN RWANDA, MR NZAGONTIMANA CASSIEN, EXPLAINED THAT BUTARE WAS ALSO CONSIDERED AS THE NEXT POTENTIAL DESTINATION OF THE GITARAMA PRISON OVERFLOW. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT UNAMIR HQ ACTIVELY PURSUE THIS FILE WHILE THERE IS SOME MOMENTUM.

ii) ONE MILOB TEAM VISITED MUKINGI COMMUNE (7160) AND FOUND THE GENERAL SITUATION TO BE CALM. THE TEAM ALSO VISITED BYIMANANA HEALTH CENTER. IT IS THE ONLY CLINIC IN MUKINGI COMMUNE AND SERIOUS PATIENTS ARE REPORTED TO KAGAYI HOSPITAL. IT IS RUN BY MSF WHICH SUPPLIES DRUGS. THE CAPACITY IS 18 BEDS, OUT OF WHICH FIVE ARE FOR MATERNITY CASES AND THE REMAINDER FOR GENERAL CASES. AN AVERAGE OF 100 PATIENTS ARE TREATED EVERYDAY. THE MOST COMMON AILMENTS ARE MALARIA, RESPIRATORY PROBLEMS, DIARRHEA AND PNEUMONIA. THE TOTAL STAFF STRENGTH IS 12, OUT OF WHICH SEVEN ARE QUALIFIED MEDICAL ASSISTANTS AND FIVE ARE GENERAL HELPERS. AT PRESENT, NO ELECTRICITY NOR PIPED WATER IS AVAILABLE.

iii) THE CLINIC AUTHORITIES REQUESTED THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) ANTIBIOTICS DRUGS AND ANTIMALARIAL TABLETS.
- 2) WATER PUMP AND GENERATOR.
- 3) ONE AMBULANCE.
- 4) LABORATORY EQUIPMENT.
- 5) MATTRESSES, BLANKETS AND BEDS (THIS SHORTAGE CURRENTLY PREVENTS THEM FROM ADMITTING MORE PATIENTS).

iv) ONE MILOB TEAM VISITED MUCINA COMMUNE (9267) AND FOUND THE GENERAL SITUATION CALM. IT WAS REPORTED THAT CARITAS DISTRIBUTED AGRICULTURAL MATERIAL FOR LOCALS. THE HEALTH CENTRE WAS ALSO VISITED AND IT CONTAINS 60 BEDS AND AN AVERAGE OF 70 TO 100 PATIENTS ARE TREATED EVERYDAY. IT IS RUN BY MEDICUS MUNDO WHICH SUPPLIES DRUGS AND MEDICATION. CHILDREN WERE VACCINATED TODAY AGAINST COMMON DISEASES IN THE REGION. THE AUTHORITIES REQUESTED THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) INFANT FOOD
- 2) POTABLE WATER
- 3) A GENERATOR
- 4) ONE AMBULANCE
- 5) STATIONARY FOR THE CLINIC

v) THE TEAM VISITED NTERO SECTOR AND REPORTED THAT A MAN CALLED BADJOURI BIRA JEAN WAS KILLED ON 9 JULY 95 BY FOUR RPA SOLDIERS AS HE WAS EXITING THE CHURCH AT 1300 HRS. NO INVESTIGATION WAS CONDUCTED. THE BURIAL TOOK PLACE ON 10 JULY 95. CIVPOL AND HUMAN RIGHTS HAVE BEEN SEIZED OF THE MATTER AND A JOINT PATROL WITH MILOBS WILL BE LAUNCHED.

vi) ON 12 JUL 95 NINE LOCALS WERE ARRESTED IN THE SAME SECTOR BY THE BOURGHESTRE AND TWO RPA SOLDIERS. NO MOTIVE FOR THE ARRESTATION WAS GIVEN, THEIR WHEREABOUTS ARE NOT KNOWN AND THEY HAVE NOT BEEN SEEN SINCE THEN. AGAIN, A JOINT MILOB/HUMAN RIGHTS AND CIVPOL WILL BE LAUNCHED.

vii) LOCALS IN THE AREA COMPLAINED ABOUT SHORTAGE OF SEEDS AND SECURITY PROBLEMS TO THE EXTENT THEY ARE AFRAID TO CULTIVATE THEIR FIELDS.

A. MALI COY PROVIDED TWO BEDFORD TRUCKS TO TRANSPORT 14 TONS OF FOOD AND A HALF FROM GITARAMA TO MUSHUBATI COMMUNE OFFICE (6970) FOR THE PRIMARY SCHOOL INSPECTOR.

B. ALSO, MALI COY PROVIDED TWO BEDFORD TRUCKS TO TRANSPORT TEN TONS OF CEREAL FROM GITARAMA PREFECTURE TO RUHANGO COMMUNE OFFICE (6254).

C. THE COMPANY PROVIDED TWO PICK-UPS AND ONE AMBULANCE FOR THE MOVEMENT OF THE GITARAMA PRISONERS. THEY WERE VERY EFFICIENT THROUGHOUT THE OPERATION.



RPA CONTINUES TO CONDUCT VEH AND FOOT PATROLS IN THE AOR BOTH  
BY DAY AND NIGHT.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED IN THE FOLLOWING COMMUNES AND AREAS:

- a. GATUNA BORDER POST (GR 0143)
- b. KAGITUMBA BORDER POST (GR 5184)
- c. BUYOGA COMMUNE (GR B0113)
- d. KIVUYE COMMUNE (GR A9532)
- e. CYUMBA COMMUNE (GR B0133)
- f. BWISIGE COMMUNE (GR B1727)

4. HUMANITARIAN AFFAIRS

a. KIVUYE COMMUNE. AMREF AND CARITAS ARE THE ONLY NGOS STILL OPERATING IN THE COMMUNE. AMREF RUNS THE COMMUNE HEALTH CENTRE. IT HAS COMPLETED TRAINING FIVE LOCAL NURSES WHO NOW MAN THE CENTRE. SIX PATIENTS WERE FOUND ON ADMISSION. COMMON DISEASES TREATED HERE INCLUDE MALARIA, DIARRHOEA AND BRONCHITIS. THE BOURGREMESTRE HELD A MEETING WITH AMREF OFFICIALS TODAY. DETAILS OF THE MEETING ARE UNKNOWN. CARITAS DISTRIBUTES HIGH PROTEIN FOOD TO MALNOURISHED CHILDREN AND FARMING IMPLEMENTS TO FARMERS.

b. CYUMBA COMMUNE. AMREF SPONSORS THE CYUMBA HEALTH CENTRE AND HAS NINE NURSES, THREE OF WHOM ARE QUALIFIED. THREE PATIENTS ON ADMISSION WERE VISITED BY MILOB PATROL. COMMON DISEASES HERE ARE MALARIA, BRONCHITIS, PNEUMONIA, KWASHIORKOR AND RHEUMATISM.

c. BWISIGE COMMUNE. THREE NGOS, CARITAS, WORLD VISION AND REMANIE PALANTINA, OPERATE IN THIS COMMUNE. CARITAS DISTRIBUTES SEEDS AND AGRICULTURAL TOOLS TO THE LOCALS. WORLD VISION RUNS THE BWISIGE HEALTH CENTRE AND PROVIDES DRUGS WHILST PALANTINA GIVES TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO THE NYAGAHANGA SECONDARY SCHOOL.

d. BUYOGA COMMUNE. MILOB PATROL CONVEYED ELECTROGAS WORKERS TO THE BUYOGA COMMUNE TO INSPECT ELECTRIC POLES AND LINES IN ORDER TO RECTIFY FAULTS. THIS ASSISTANCE WILL CONTINUE FOR THE NEXT THREE DAYS.

5. CIVILIAN AFFAIRS

a. WATER PUMP. THE WATER PUMP SERVING THE BWISIGE COMMUNE HAS BROKEN DOWN. NIBATT ENGRS INSPECTED THE ENGINE BUT COULD DO NOTHING ABOUT IT.


b. RETURNEES. EIGHT (08) RETURNEES WITH 78 COWS FROM UGANDA CROSSED THE BORDER TO GATSIBO IN BUTARO COMMUNE OF SECTOR 5. THE RPA IN THAT LOCATION GAVE THEM PASS TO GO TO NYAGATARE THROUGH KIVUYE AND MUKARANGE TODAY.

a. THEFT. THREE ARMED MEN FORCIBLY ENTERED AND STOLE A PORTABLE GENERATING SET, FREEZER AND REFRIGERATOR FROM THE HOUSE OF MR JERRY RAY OGDEN, A BROWN AND ROOT SECTOR COORDINATOR IN BYUMBA TODAY AT 0630 HRS LT. STATEMENT OF AN EYE-WITNESS TO BE FORWARDED TO MP FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. CALM.
2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. NTR
3. FACTIOAL ACTIVITIES

A. RPA. RPA ESTABLISHED NEW CHECK POINTS ON THE ROADS LINKING GITARAMA TO KIGALI, MASANGO (6254) AND NTONGWE (9057). RPA PLATOONS DEPLOYED IN MALI COY AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY WERE REINFORCED BY AT LEAST TEN SOLDIERS EACH DURING THE LAST TEN DAYS.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. GITARAMA TEAM

i) ONE MILOB TEAM, JOINED BY CIVPOL MEMBER, WENT TO MUGINA COMMUNE(9267) AND INVESTIGATED A SUSPECTED MURDER AND ARRESTS IN BUTEKO SECTOR (9669). THEY INTERVIEWED FOUR PARTIES: LOCALS, THE CELLULE RESPONSIBLE (MR RUMAYIZA ALOYE), THE MOTHER OF THE VICTIM WHOSE NAME WAS BAGIRUWIRA JOHN AND THE RPA PLATOON CDR IN MUGINA, SGT JOHN.

ii) IT IS CONFIRMED BY ALL PARTIES MENTIONED ABOVE THAT MR BAGIRUWIRA, AGED 23, WAS SHOT BY AN RPA SOLDIER ON 09 JUL 95 AT ABOUT 1300 HRS IN THE VICINITY OF HIS HOUSE (9669). THE VERSION OF THE FIRST THREE PARTIES WAS THAT THE VICTIM HAD BEEN APPROACHED BY FOUR SOLDIERS OF THE RPA TO HAVE HIS IDENTITY CHECKED AS HE WAS RETURNING FROM THE CHURCH. THE RPA WAS LOOKING FOR UNKNOWN PEOPLE FROM BUGABERA COMMUNE (BUTARE PREFECTURE). THE VICTIM WAS FORCED TO SHOW THE RPA WHERE HIS HOME WAS. ON THE WAY TO HIS HOUSE, HE WAS SHOT BY ONE OF THE RPA SOLDIERS WHEN NO LOCAL WAS WATCHING. THE MOTHER OF THE VICTIM STATED THAT

HER SON MIGHT HAVE BEEN SHOT AS HE WAS ATTEMPTING TO ESCAPE. THE RPA PLATOON COMMANDER INITIALLY DENIED THAT ANYBODY WAS KILLED IN HIS AREA OF OPERATIONS. UPON THE RETURN OF THE INVESTIGATING TEAM FROM THE MURDER SCENE, THE RPA PLATOON COMMANDER WAS CONFRONTED WITH DETAILED FACTS AND HE RECOGNIZED THAT THE KILLING TOOK PLACE. HOWEVER, HE DEFENDED HIS TROOPS' ACTION BY STATING THAT THEY ACTED IN SELF-DEFENCE WHEN MR BAGIRUWIRA JOHN ATTEMPTED TO GRAB ONE OF THE SOLDIERS' WEAPON.

iii) IN THE CASE OF THE NINE ARRESTS THAT WE REPORTED YESTERDAY IN THE SAME SECTOR (NTEKO - 9669), IT WAS FOUND OUT THAT THEY OCCUR ON 7 JULY 95 VICE 12 JUL 95 AS INITIALLY BELIEVED. ACCORDING TO THE CELLULE RESPONSIBLE, ONLY FOUR PEOPLE WERE ARRESTED:

- 1) MR GAHIGI MICHAEL: ACCUSED OF REFUSING TO GIVE INFORMATION TO RPA;
- 2) MR MUNYETABARO: ACCUSED OF SELLING BEER TO NON-LOCALS, AN ACTION PROHIBITED FOR SECURITY REASONS;
- 3) MR NTIBTEGERA: ACCUSED OF GENOCIDE;
- 4) MR MUTAMBURA: NO MOTIVE.

ALL THESE FOUR PEOPLE SHOULD BE IN THE COMMUNE CACHOT BUT THIS INFORMATION COULD NOT BE VISUALLY CONFIRMED BY THE TEAM. LOCALS BELIEVE THAT THESE PEOPLE WERE ARBITRARILY ARRESTED. IT IS BELIEVED THAT THE REMAINDER FIVE ARRESTEES WERE FROM THE KANZENEE COMMUNE IN THE JAMATA SECTOR (OUTSIDE OF GITARAMA PREFECTURE). ONCE MORE DETAILS ARE AVAILABLE, WE WILL CONTACT THE CONCERNED SECTOR TO FOLLOW-UP ON THIS CASE. A COMBINED MILOB/HR TEAM WILL BE DISPATCHED IN THE NTEKO SECTOR TO CHECK THE SITUATION AT COMMUNE CACHOT AND A FURTHER REPORT WILL BE SENT. THERE IS NO CONNECTION BETWEEN THESE ARRESTS AND THE PREVIOUSLY REPORTED KILLING.

iv) A SECOND MILOB TEAM VISITED NYAMABUYE COMMUNE (7570) AND VISITED SIX SECTORS: GIHUMA (7067), SHYOGWE (7466), RUKAZA (7865), RULI (7470), GAKOGO (7370) AND MUSUMBA (7969). THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS FOUND TO BE CALM, EXCEPT FOR SMALL THEFTS OF COWS, CLOTHES AND FOOD. NO ARBITRARY ARRESTS WERE REPORTED, NOR IS THERE ANY FOOD SHORTAGE. LOCALS COMPLAINED OF SHORTAGE OF SEEDS AND AGRICULTURE MATERIAL.

v) A THIRD MILOB TEAM, ACCOMPANIED BY THE SECTOR COMMANDER, VISITED THE BULINGA COMMUNE (6679) AND INTERVIEWED STAFF AT TWO DIFFERENT HEALTH CENTERS IN THE AREA. THE FIRST ONE, AT MUSHISHIMO, IS GOVERNMENT OWNED AND HAS A STAFF STRENGTH OF 11 (FOUR HEALTH AUXILIARIES, ONE MEDICAL ASSISTANT, ONE SOCIAL ASSISTANT, ONE NURSE AND FOUR GENERAL WORKERS). IT IS SUPPORTED BY THE ICRC



WHICH PROVIDES SUPPLIES AND MEDICATION. IT HAS 16 BEDS BUT CURRENTLY DOES NOT HOLD ANY IN-PATIENTS, HOWEVER THEY HOPE TO ADMIT SOME AS OF NEXT WEEK. AN AVERAGE OF 80 PATIENTS VISIT THE CLINIC EVERY DAY. THE SECOND ONE, AT BULAMBA, IS ALSO GOVERNMENT OWNED AND HAS A STAFF STRENGTH OF TEN (ONE MEDICAL ASSISTANT, ONE SOCIAL ASSISTANT, THREE HEALTH AUXILIARIES, ONE LABORATORY TECHNICIAN AND FOUR GENERAL WORKERS). THE CENTER IS SUPPORTED BY THE ICRC WHICH PROVIDES SUPPLIES AND CURRENT MEDICATION. IT HAS FIFTEEN BEDS WHICH IS NOT CONSIDERED SUFFICIENT BY THE STAFF. AN AVERAGE OF 80 PATIENTS VISIT THE CLINIC EVERY DAY. TWO TYPES OF DRUG ARE IN SHORT SUPPLY:

- 1) ANTI-VOMIT DRUGS; AND
- 2) DRUGS FOR GASTRITIS OTHER THAN ALUMINUM HYDROXIDE WHICH IS NOT CONSIDERED A VERY EFFICIENT DRUG.

ELECTRICITY HAS NOT BEEN AVAILABLE IN EITHER CENTER SINCE THE 1994 WAR EVEN THOUGH THEY HAVE THE REQUIRED INFRASTRUCTURE. THERE IS NO RESIDENT DOCTOR AND HE VISITS THE CENTER ONCE EVERY THREE MONTHS AND ONLY SPENDS A FEW MINUTES IN PLACE WHEN DOES SO.

vi) LOCALS REPORTED THAT SOME ARRESTS WERE CONDUCTED IN THE BULAMBA SECTOR AND THE ARRESTEES WOULD APPARENTLY NOT BE IN THE COMMUNE CACHOT. LOCALS WHO WERE REPORTING THIS KIND OF INFORMATION WERE THOSE WHO WERE ISOLATED ON THE ROAD AND WHO COULD FEEL THAT THEY WOULD NOT BE REPORTED SPEAKING TO UNAMIR PERSONNEL.

B. MALICOY : MALI COY COMMANDER CONDUCTED A RECCE PATROL WITH PLT COMMANDERS TO THE NEW AREA WHERE MALICOY WILL BE DEPLOYED NEXT MONTH.

ii) THE TEAM ALSO VISITED KIGESE (9677) AND KINYANBI (9177) SECTORS. THE SITUATION WAS CALM. LOCALS COMPLAINED ABOUT FOOD SHORTAGE IN BOTH SECTORS, THE CURRENT HARVEST BEING QUITE MEAGRE AND THE LAST FOOD DISTRIBUTION HAVING BEEN CARRIED LAST

FEB 95. THERE WAS NO ELECTRICITY IN EITHER SECTOR AND RIVER WATER IS USED AS DRINKING WATER.



(ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO NYAMABUYE COMMUNE 7570 AND VISITED GIHUMA SECTOR 6774. THE TEAM WAS TOLD BY THE SECTOR COUNCILLOR THAT, ABOUT 2000 PEOPLE IN HIS SECTOR ARE STARVING DUE TO POOR

YEIDS. HE SAID THESE PEOPLE REQUIRE FOOD AND AGRICULTURAL ASSISTANCE. IT HAS DONATED 2,413,000 FRW TO THE COMMUNE FOR THE REHABILITATION OF THE RUVUNE SECONDARY SCHOOL (GR 1820). AN AVERAGE OF 15 - 20 CHILDREN ARE VACCINATED EVERY DAY. THE CENTRE IS HOWEVER, FACING PROBLEMS LIKE WATER SHORTAGE, LACK OF ELECTRICITY AND FURNITURE. THE WATER PUMP LOCATED AT (GR 1218) HAS BROKEN DOWN.


(b) EXPLOSIVES. ADRA REPORTED TO MILOB PATROL AT NGARAMA THAT EXPLOSIVES WERE FOUND AT GAKIRAGE (GR 0144). PATROL, ACCOMPANIED BY NIBATT PLATOON, VISITED THE LOCATION TODAY. THE EXPLOSIVES WERE FOUND IN A GRAVE NEAR A PRIMARY SCHOOL PREMISES. NIBATT BOD HAS BEEN INFORMED.



(b) **KIYOMBE COMMUNE.** GOAL IRELAND SPONSORS THE COMMUNE HEALTH CENTRE. THE CENTRE TREATS APPROXIMATELY 250 PATIENTS DAILY. COMMON DISEASES TREATED INCLUDE MALARIA, DYSENTERY, URTD AND TB. THE CLINIC HAS A GOOD QUANTITY OF DRUGS.

(c) **MUVUMBA COMMUNE.** MSF (SWISS) IS RENOVATING THE GAKIRAGE HEALTH CENTRE (GR 3444). WHEN COMPLETED, MSF INTENDS TO REFURNISH AND PROVIDE ALL THE MEDICAL FACILITIES THE CENTRE REQUIRES FOR ITS OPERATION. THE CENTRE HAS ONE QUALIFIED MEDICAL ASSISTANT, ONE NURSE AND FIVE NURSING AIDS. MSF PAYS THE SALARIES OF ALL THE HEALTH WORKERS. COMMON DISEASES IN THE AREA INCLUDE MALARIA, RESPIRATORY TRACT INFECTION AND WORMS, MOSTLY FOUND IN CHILDREN. THE CENTRE HAS ALSO BEGUN VACCINATION OF CHILDREN AGAINST MEASLES, POLIO, DIPHTERIA AND BCG. ABOUT 40 TO 50 CHILDREN ARE VACCINATED DAILY.

(a) **LAW AND ORDER.** MILOB PATROL TO RUTONGO OBSERVED SIXTY (60) PRISONERS WERE IN A CELL AT THE COMMUNE OFFICE. THE BOURGREMESTRE REFUSED TO TELL THE PATROL THE OFFENSES COMMITTED NEITHER DID HE ALLOW THE PATROL TO TALK TO ANY OF THEM.

SERIOUS CASES ARE NORMALLY REFERRED TO RWESERO HEALTH CENTRE (GR 1901). THE CLINIC HAS A GOOD STORE OF DRUGS WITH 8 HEALTH WORKERS.

(c) NYAGATATARE. AMERICAN REFUGEE COMMITTEE, WHICH HAS A HEALTH CENTRE IN THE NYAGATARE TRANSIT CAMP, TODAY CARRIED OUT VACCINATION OF CHILDREN AGAINST MEASLES, POLIO, BCG, DIPTERIA TETANUS. THE COMMON DISEASES IN THE CAMP ARE MALARIA, DIARRHOEA AND DYSENTERY. THE NGO CONFIRMED HAVING ENOUGH MEDICINE TO TREAT THE MENTIONED DISEASES. THERE IS ALSO FOOD DISTRIBUTION BY ADRA TO RETURNEES AND ORPHANS AT MUHURA INTER SOS, NGARAMA SOS AND GAKONI ORPHANAGE IN MURAMBI. THE RETURNEES ARE BEING GIVEN FOOD AT THE FOLLOWING SCALES PER PERSON PER MONTH :

- (1) 11.2 KGS MAIZE GRAIN.
- (2) 3.6 KGS BEANS/PEAS.
- (3) 0.56 LTS COOKING OIL.

AS AT NOW, THERE ARE 800 PEOPLE IN THE TRANSIT CAMP. APPROXIMATELY 40 RETURNEES COME IN EVERY DAY. THEY ARE ONLY ALLOWED TO STAY IN THE CAMP FOR A MAXIMUM OF 4 WEEKS WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THOSE WHO ARE NOT ABLE TO FIND IMMEDIATE RESETTLEMENT AREAS.

(d) NGARAMA COMMUNE. THERE ARE THREE NGOS NAMELY *ACCORD*, ADRA AND ICRC OPERATING IN THIS COMMUNE. *ACCORD* PROVIDES ROOFING MATERIALS AND GENERAL REHABILITATION OF SCHOOLS. IT ALSO PROVIDES AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS, SEEDS AND CLOTHES TO THE ORPHANS AND THE POOR. ADRA PROVIDES FOOD TO RETURNEES AND REHABILITATES ROADS. ICRC PROVIDES RECEPTION AND FOOD DISTRIBUTION TO RETURNEES.

5. CIVILIAN AFFAIRS

(a) LAW AND ORDER. IN BOTH GITI AND MUGAMBAZI COMMUNES, THE BOURGREMESTRES SIT ON COMMON CIVIL OFFENSES. THE OFFENSES RANGE FROM STEALING FARM PRODUCE, EXTORTION TO FIGHTING. THIRTY (30) PRISONERS ARE BEING HELD IN MUGAMBAZI CELL PENDING TRANSPORTATION TO KIGALI.

(b) THREAT. DESPITE THE WARNING ISSUED BY CO RPA OF NYAGATARE BATTALION, THE NEW MILOB PATROL DESPATCHED TO NYAGATARE, WENT ABOUT THEIR NORMAL PATROLS TODAY WITHOUT ANY INTERRUPTION BY THE RPA CHECKPOINTS. THE NEW TEAM LEADER REQUESTED TO SEE THE RPA CO THIS MORNING TO DISCUSS THE ISSUE BUT HE WAS TOLD THE CO HAD LEFT TO KIGALI AND WOULD NOT RETURN TILL NEXT WEDNESDAY. FURTHER DEVELOPMENTS WILL BE COMMUNICATED.


(c) NGARAMA COMMUNE. PATROL REPORTED THERE ARE TWENTY-FIVE (25) PRISONERS IN THE COMMUNE CELLS, FIVE (5) OF WHOM ARE FEMALES COMPRISING THREE (3) ADULTS AND TWO (2) CHILDREN. THESE PRISONERS ARE ALLEGED TO HAVE COMMITTED GENOCIDE DURING THE CIVIL WAR. THE SANITARY CONDITIONS OF THE CELL ARE BAD. ARRANGEMENTS ARE MADE TO TRANSFER THEM TO KIGALI.






