(1) TEAM: PATROLLED NYAMUTERA AND NDUSU COMMUNES. SITUATION IS CALM IN BOTH COMMUNES.

NYAMUTERA: THE TEAM WAS INFORMED BY A REP OF THE MINISTRY OF REHABILITATION THAT A TOTAL OF 28000 RETURNEES (1994) AND 97 FAMILIES OF 59/60 HAVE BEEN RECORDED IN THE COMMUNE. REF OUR SITREP FOR PERIOD 091700 TO 101700 OCT 95 UNDER FRGF. FIVE OF THE FRGF VOLUNTARILY DROPPED OUT DURING SCREENING COMPLAINING OF INADEQUATE FOOD AND THAT THEY HAD NO CHANCE TO VISIT THEIR FAMILIES. THEY RETURNED TO NYAMUTERA THEIR HOME COMMUNE. THE BRIDGE IN NYAMUTERA GR6608 IS BEING GUARDED BY RPA COY OF 11BN FROM GITARAMA.

NDUSU: FOUR PERSONS WERE ARRESTED FOR GENOCIDE AND ARE AT THE COMMUNE PRISON. AT MATOBO HEALTH CENTRE THE TEAM WAS TOLD THAT THERE WAS A SHORTAGE OF DRUGS. THE CENTRE ALSO HAS INADEQUATE BLANKETS AND MATTRESSES.

(2) TEAM: PATROLLED KINIGI AND NKUMBA COMMUNES.

NKUMBA COMMUNE: PEOPLE WERE CONSTRUCTING A ROAD FROM RUHONDO SECTOR GR 6837 TO RUHENGIERI. TOTAL DISTANCE IS 8 KMS AND WFP SPONSORS THE PROJECT. NTARUKA HYDROELECTRIC POWER STATION IS

REPORTED OPERATIONAL AS FROM 2 NOVEMBER 95.ONLY ONE TURBINE IS FUNCTIONAL AND IT SUPPLIES RUHENGERI.

KINIGI: TEAM MET RPA LOCAL COMD WHO REPORTED THAT SITUATION WAS CALM.

NYARUTOVU COMMUNE: SITUATION IS CALM. 10 PEOPLE WERE IN THE COMMUNE PRISON. THREE WERE ARRESTED FOR GENOCIDE, THREE FOR STAYING IN THE COMMUNE AFTER RETURNING FROM ZAIRE WITHOUT REPORTING TO THE AUTHORITIES, TWO FOR HARBOURING A FRGF LT NAMED NDIZEYE JUVENAL WHO CAME FROM ZAIRE, STAYED FOR SOME TIME AND RETURNED TO ZAIRE AND TWO FOR PAYING 50 000 FRANCS TO A SOLDIER SO THAT HE COULD KILL SOMEONE.

NYAMUGALI COMMUNE: SITUATION IS CALM. FIVE FRGF MEMBERS ARE REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN ARRESTED FOR INFILTRATION. THE TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT THEY HAD COME TO KILL RPA COMDS AND TO LAY MINES IN THE AREA. THIS INFORMATION REQUIRES FOLLOW UP TO CONFIRM IF THE ARRESTED PERSONS CONCUR WITH THIS REPORT. FOURTEEN OTHER PEOPLE WERE IN COMMUNE PRISON, 4 LADIES FOR POISONING, 2 FOR GENOCIDE, 3 FOR DRUGS AND 5 FOR MURDER.

(2) TEAM: PATROLLED CYERU COMMUNE. SITUATION IS CALM. THE COMMUNE PRISON HAS TWENTY PEOPLE. 5 ARE SUSPECTS OF GENOCIDE, 4 WERE ARRESTED FOR RETURNING UNREGISTERED AND OTHERS ARE FOR MINOR OFFENCES. THERE ARE 816 REGISTERED ORPHANS WHO STAY WITH

RELATIVES.THE TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT AID AND ACTION WILL BUILD 5 SCHOOLS IN THE COMMUNE.THEY ARE LIKELY TO COMMENCE IN JANUARY.MSF IS REPORTED TO BE REPAIRING WATER POINTS AT NDAGO GR 7935 AND RUYANGA GR 7835.

REF OUR SITREP FOR PERIOD 231700 TO 241700 OCT 95 PARA 2 b (2) THE TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT A RPA PLATOON HAS BEEN PLACED 500 METRES AWAY FROM THE SUBSTATION AT MUCACA MARKET TO CONDUCT PATROLS AROUND THE SUBSTATION AREA.THE TEAM WAS FURTHER INFORMED THAT SOME PEOPLE WHO WERE ARRESTED IN NYAMUGALI(PARA 3 b (1) ABOVE) WERE INVOLVED IN THE ATTEMPTED SABOTAGE.

HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES: HUM OFFR ACCOMPANIED UNHCR TEAM FROM GISENYI TO RUHONDO COMMUNE.UNHCR IS MONITORING THE CURRENT SITUATION OF RETURNEES.40 RETURNEES(HEADS OF FAMILIES) WERE INTERVIEWED.ALL CONFIRMED SITUATION WAS GOOD LESS FOR THEIR PROBLEMS OF FOOD AND BUILDING MATERIAL. NICOY ASSISTED RPA WITH AN AMBULANCE TO CONVEY TWO PATIENTS WHO WERE INJURED DURING THE ACCIDENT REPORTED IN YESTERDAY SITREP.

 - (2) FRGF: REF OUR SITREP COVERING PERIOD 301700 TO 311700 OCT 95. RPA BN COMD OF RUHENGIRI CAME TO OUR OFFICE TODAY AT 1230 HOURS AND COMPLAINED THAT RADIO UNMIR HAS EXAGGERATED THE INCIDENT THAT TOOK PLACE IN NYAMUTERA COMMUNE. ACCORDING TO HIM, RADIO UNAMIR SAID " FRGF ATTACKED RPA DEFENCE POSITION AT NYAMUTERA AND OVER RAN THE DEFENCE POSITION AND ALSO FRGF CAPTURED FEW WEAPONS". BN COMD EXPRESSED HIS DISSATISFACTION FOR SUCH EXAGGERATED NEWS AND APPARENTLY HE BLAMED THIS SECTOR FOR THE NEWS. HE ALSO SAID TO OUR INTERPRETER THAT " YOUR PEOPLE DO NOT KNOW HOW TO INTERPRETER AN INCIDENT CORRECTLY". IT IS WORTH MENTIONABLE THAT SUCH EXAGGERATED NEWS WILL BRING NEGATIVE RESULT FOR UNAMIR PARTICULARLY IN THIS SECTOR AND MAKE THE RELATIONSHIP VERY STRAINED WITH RPA WHEN THIS SECTOR HAS EXTREMELY COORDIAL RELATION WITH RPA.

(3) OTHERS:

(a) TODAY AT 1650 HOURS SECTOR HAS RECEIVED ONE LEAFLET FROM SOME ONE IN RUHENGIRI. A COPY OF THAT IS FORWARDED TO YOU WITH THIS SITREP.

(b) THE COUNCILLOR OF RWERERE SECTOR 8534 IN CYERU COMMUNE HAVE INFORMED TO OUR TEAM THAT THERE WAS A ROBBERY IN GAKO VILLAGE 8631 ON 30 OCT 95. THERE WERE 3 ROBBERS, ONE WITH GUNS AND OTHERS WITH KNIVES WHO TOOK 49000 FR OF PREVIOUS CURRENCY AND 2000 FR OF PRESENT CURRENCY. ROBBERS ALSO TOOK SOME VALUABLE CLOTHINGS AND HOUSE HOLD ITEMS.

BUTARO COMMUNE: RECEIVED TOTAL 927 RETURNEES OF 59/60 AND MOST OF THEM ARE STAYING IN THE VACANT HOUSES OF THOSE WHO ARE STILL IN ZAIRE. BUT THE COMMUNE HAS GIVEN 1 HECTOR OF LAND TO EACH FAMILY FOR CULTIVATION AND ALSO TO BUILT HOUSES. THE TOTAL NUMBER OF RETURNEES OF 1994 ARE 689 FAMILIES CONSISTING OF 2348 PERSONS AND MOST OF THEM HAVE GOT BACK THEIR OWN HOUSES.

CYABINGO COMMUNE: ON 31 OCT UNHCR HELD A MEETING WITH NEWLY RETURNEES AND AROUND 60 PEOPLE ATTENDED THE MEETING. THE MAIN PROBLEMS GIVEN BY THE RETURNEES TO UNHCR WERE FOOD, FARMING IMPLIMENTS AND CONSTRUCTION OF HOUSES. COMMUNE HAVE 1209 ORPHANAGES REGISTERED AND AMONG THEM 151 ARE DUE TO LAST YEAR WAR. COMMUNE HAVE ALSO 434 HANDICAPED AND 432 WIDOWS.

GATONDE COMMUNE: TODAY AUSTRIAN RELIEF PROGRAMME DISTRIBUTED SEEDS (WHEAT AND BEANS) TO 1000 FAMILIES BUT FERTILIZER WAS SOLD TO THE LOCALS.

(2) FRGF: REF OUR SITREP COVERING PERIOD 291700 TO 301700 OCT '95. THE JOINT INVESTIGATION REPORT BY TEAMS FROM THIS SECTOR AND FROM 5B ON THE REF INCIDENTS ARE STATED BELOW:

ON 292330 OCT A DETACHMENT OF RPA ON GUARD AT GICIYE RIVER BRIDGE GR 591175 SAW 2 FRGF AT ABOUT 150 METERS AWAY ON THE NYAMUTERA- NDUSU ROAD. THE FRGF WERE IN MILITARY UNIFORM WITH EXPLOSIVES AND GRENADES. WHEN FRGF WERE CHALLENGED BY RPA THEY TRIED TO REMOVE THE GRENADES WHILST RUNNING SOUTH WARDS. THEN THEY EXCHANGED FIRE FOR ABOUT 15-20 MINUTES. FRGF MANAGED TO WITHDRAW AND NO CASUALTIES ON BOTH SIDES. NEXT MORNING AT 0700 3 STUDENTS WERE TRAVELLING ON SHYIRA - NYAMUTERA ROAD AND SERIOUSLY WOUNDED BY ANTI-PERS MINES AT GR 591169. ONE LOST HIS LEFT LEG WHILE OTHER TWO SUSTAIN SERIOUS INJURIES. FROM THE SITE, IT APPEARS THAT THOSE WERE FRESH ANTI-PERS MINES SINCE THE ROAD IS USED REGULARLY BY RPA AND LOCALS AND MINES WERE LAID TO PREVENT REINFORCEMENT FROM THE RPA CAMP AT SHYIRA GR 588137. ON THE OTHER HAND IT SEEMS THAT WITHDRAWING FRGF LAID THOSE MINES TO DELAY THE RPA SOLDIERS FROM PURSUING THEM. PLEASE FIND ONE MAP OF THE SITE OF INCIDENTS AS ANNEX A TO THIS SITREP. THE TEAMS ALSO OBSERVED THAT A SECURITY MEETING WAS HELD BEING ATTENDED BY LOCAL RPA, COUNCILLORS, FAMILY HEADS OF THE VILLAGE AND THE BOURGMESTER OF NYAMUTERA COMMUNE. THE AIM OF THE MEETING WAS TO BRIEF LOCALS ON SECURITY BY THE RPA PARTICULARLY ABOUT THE ABOVE INCIDENTS.

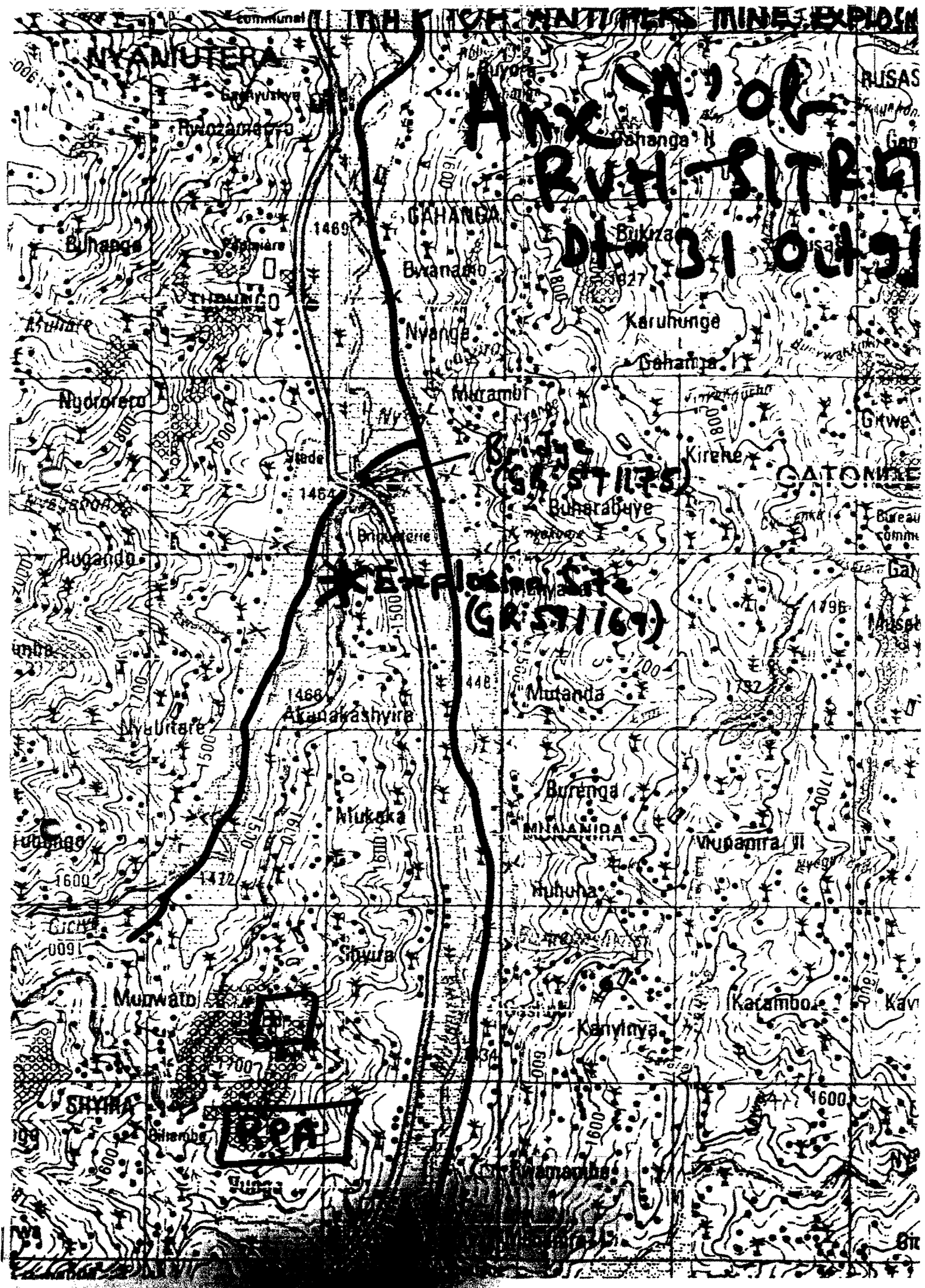

FRGF HAVE LAID THOSE MINES FOR RPA BUT UNLAKILY STUDENTS WERE FIRST TO USE THAT

ROAD. ONE OF THE STUDENT HAD LOST HIS LEG AND OTHER TWO WERE SERIOUSLY INJURED WITH SPLINTERS. NOW THEY ARE UNDER TREATMENT IN RUHENGERI HOSPITAL. LATER BOURGMESTER OF NYAMUTERA COMMUNE WAS TRANSPORTED TO KINIGI COMMUNE FOR INFORMING THE PARENTS OF THE STUDENTS. IT IS MENTIONABLE THAT THE BRIDGE FALLS UNDER OUR AOR BUT SHYIRE FALLS UNDER SECTOR 5B AND THE MATTER WAS INFORMED TO THEM OVER TEL. TOMORROW MILOBS FROM THIS SECTOR AND ALSO FROM SECTOR 5B WILL MAKE JOINT INVESTIGATION. FURTHER DETAILS IF ANY WILL BE INTIMATED TO YOU.
