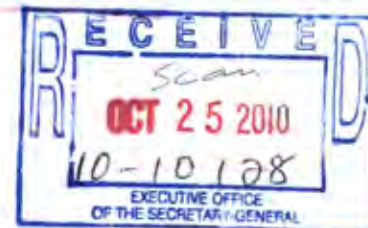

# **Note to the Secretary-General**

**Subject: Date of the Fourth United Nations Conference on LDCs  
(UN LDC IV) proposed by Turkey**

I was informed by the Permanent Representative of Turkey on 22 October 2010 that Turkey is considering to reschedule the Fourth United Nations Conference on the Least Developed Countries (UN LDC IV) from 9 to 13 May 2011, instead of earlier proposed dates from 30 May to 3 June 2011. It may be recalled that the ECOSOC welcomed the offer of Turkey to hold it from 30 May to 3 June 2011.

As informed by the Turkish delegation, the change of date has become necessary due to a recent development in Istanbul regarding possible dates for parliamentary elections in Turkey.

I am consulting to assess the overall implications of this change in dates. However, the General Assembly will decide on the specific dates in its resolution to be adopted this year.

I will keep you apprised of the developments.
