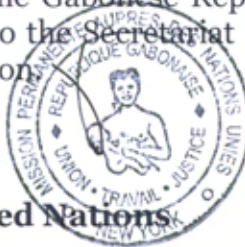

DRAFT DECLARATION

Considering the effects of global warming on planet earth, particularly in developing countries, Committed to advancing current negotiations on COP21 conference.

We, head of states and government of the countries that are listed in annex of this declaration.

Gathered on September 27, 2015 in New York, in the margin of the Seventieth Session of the General Assembly,

- 1- Emphasize the necessity to keep global warming below 2°C.*
- 2- Renew our commitment to reach a universal and binding agreement on climate change in Paris on December 2015.*
- 3- Reaffirm the necessity that this agreement takes into account the concerns of developing countries especially on **Financing, Technology transfer and Capacity building**.*
- 4- Reiterate our attachment to the principle of common but differentiated responsibilities.*
- 5- Encourage France and other key international actors, to take necessary steps to ensure a successful outcome of COP21 negotiations.*
