WHEN HE STARTS TO TALK IN TERMS OF EXPENSE AND U.S. PAYING FOR BOTH DESTRUCTION AND RESTORATION HE SEEMS TO FORGET THAT ONUC MILITARY PERSONNEL WHO GIVE THEIR LIVES GIVE SOMETHING INCALCULABLE IN TERMS OF DEAN'S MATERIALISTIC THINKING. MOREOVER EYE AM SURE THAT WE DO NOT WANT TO HAVE AMERICAN ASSISTANCE HELD AS A THREAT TO US ALL THE TIME. IF THE APPROACH TO TSHOMBE NEED NOT BE MADE BY THE U.N. US CONSUL VISITED SHERRY 13-1 AND RETURNED TO THE
CHARGE ON POLITICAL SETTLEMENT WHICH WOULD INDUCE TSHOMBE
NOT TO BLOW UP KOLWEZI. HE REPEATED THAT THIS WOULD BE
CHEAPER THAN OBTAINING THE EXPENSIVE BRIDGING WHICH UN

JUST RETURNED FROM LULUABOURG AND BAKWANGA WHERE EYE REVIEWED CURRENT DEVELOPMENTS WITH PACKHAM, BRIGADIER OGUNDIPE, PRESIDENT NGALULA AND LOCAL DIRECTOR OF MIBA. IT APPEARS THAT PRO-KALONJI JEUNESSE AND UNITS OF KALONJI GENDARMERIE NOT FULLY INTEGRATED IN ANC ARE IN REVOLT IN WESTERN PART OF SOUTH KASAI. SOME VILLAGES HAVE BEEN BURNED AND WHOLE POPULATIONS HAVE TAKEN SHELTER IN BUSH. WWWHHOOD DOCTOR PUTS THE FIGURE OF POPULATION IN BUSH AT 200.000 WITHOUT ANY VISIBLE SOURCE OF FOOD SUPPLY. HOSPITALS FROM WHICH PATIENTS HAVE ESCAPED ALSO NEED SUPPLIES TO AWAIT RETURN OF PATIENTS AND RESUMPTION OF NORMAL WORK.

AFTER DISCUSSIONS EYE HAVE DECIDED TO EXAMINE THE FOLLOWING WITH FORCE COMMANDER, COLLEAGUES IN LEO AS WELL AS CENTRAL GOVERNMENT :

1. WARN REBELS BY LEAFLETS AND RADIO TO SURRENDER ARMS WITHIN A WEEK.
2. SEND SIERRA LEONE CONTINGENT TO BAKWANGA AND ANNOUNCE THAT THIS IS FIRST OF SERIES OF MEASURES WHICH ONUC WILL TAKE TO RESTORE LAW AND ORDER.
3. ARRANGE FOR QUICK DESPATCH AND DISTRIBUTION OF FOOD AND MEDICAL SUPPLIES.
4. SEND JETS FOR TWO OR THREE DAYS RUNNING FOR RECCE AND A FEW ACROBATIC TURNS TO FRIGHTEN RUSTIC REBELS TO THEIR SENSES.

WHILST IN BAKWANGA EYE WAS INFORMED THAT TWO ~~quote~~ JOURNALISTS ~~unquote~~ WHO WORKED FOR KALONJI AND HAD RETURNED TO SUPPLY SECRET INFORMATION TO SOCIETE GENERALE AND OTHER ORGANIZATIONS IN BELGIUM, WERE ARRESTED IN NOVEMBER AND WERE STILL DETAINED BY NGALULA ADMINISTRATION. EYE PUT IN A PLEA FOR THESE MEN AND THEY WERE

RELEASED TO ME AND ARE NOW IN THE MERCENARIES CAMP. EYE WILL NOTIFY THE
BELGIAN AMBASSADOR TONIGHT AND DISCUSS THE MATTER WITH ADOULA TOMORROW.
EYE UNDERSTAND CHARGES HAVE BEEN PREFERRED AGAINST THESE GENTLEMEN, DILOS AND
BURLION, AND IF THIS IS TRUE EYE WILL URGE FOR A SPEEDY TRIAL. WILL DO MY
BEST TO PREVENT THESE PEOPLE ^{from} BEING SENT TO MAKALA OR SOME OTHER CONGOLESE GAOL.
THE BELGIAN EMBASSY MAY BE ABLE TO ARRANGE A BAIL.

THE MOST ENCOURAGING ASPECT OF MY DISCUSSIONS TODAY IS THAT EVERYBODY
WELCOMED U.N. INTERVENTION. MY CONVERSATION WITH ADOULA AND KAMITATU BEFORE
MY DEPARTURE ALSO GAVE ME SOME INDICATION THAT THERE WILL BE NO OPPOSITION
FROM CENTRAL GOVERNMENT OR ANC TO THE PROPOSALS SET OUT ABOVE.

THE SOLDIER. (MR DISTER SAID THAT HE DID NOT STRIKE THE SOLDIER BUT BELIEVED THAT HIS GESTURE MIGHT HAVE PROVOKED THE SOLDIER TO FIRE). THE 2 SOLDIERS THEN BEGAN TO LEAVE THE HOUSE IMMEDIATELY AND WHEN THEY WERE ON THE DOORSTEP 1 OF THE MEN FIRED WITH A PISTOL AND STRUCK MRS DISTER IN THE HEAD KILLING HER INSTANTLY. MR DISTER STATED THAT THE MEN FIRED 2 OR 3 SHOTS WHICH IS THE NUMBER GIVEN BY A NEIGHBOUR. THE 3 DISTER CHILDREN WERE PRESENT IN THE HOUSE DURING THE INCIDENT.

PARA AFTER THE SOLDIERS LEFT MR DISTER CLOSED THE DOOR AND KEPT IT CLOSED FOR SEVERAL MINUTES, FEARING THAT THE MEN MIGHT RETURN. HE THEN RAN INTO THE STREET AND KNOCKED AT THE DOORS OF 5 NEIGHBOURS IN ORDER TO OBTAIN HELP. HE IS REPORTED TO HAVE YELLED QUOTE THEY HAVE MURDERED MY WIFE UNQUOTE. QUESTIONS HE WAS NEVERTHELESS SURE THAT TSHOMBE COULD CONTROL AND STOP
DEMOLITIONS HE ASSERTED THAT TSHOMBE SHOULD BE CREDITED WITH LIMITED AMOUNT
