### **UNAMIR and Information on Genocide**

SRSB stated that renewed accusations were being made in the Belgian press that UNAMIR had not informed UN about plan for genocide and that proposals by Gen. Dallaire to neutralize the "genocide" cells had been rejected by United Nations Headquarters. SRSB appointed a committee that would consist of: a) An appointee of FC b) Ms. Isel Rivero and c) Col. Tikoca who should examine all relevant documents and report on it.

**Action: ED**

### **Follow-up to the Genocide Conference**

1. The SRSB requested that Mr. Diego Zorrilla prepare a draft report on the Conference outlining the major points and recommendations. A code cable would be sent to New York.

**Action: ED**

### **Commission of Inquiry on Arms Flow**

2. The SRSB would like the Programme of the Inquiry Commission to be finalized in collaboration with the Rwandese Government. He requested to be informed of the exact time of arrival.

**Action: ED/CAO**

### **Use of Helicopters**

3. Following the reduction of helicopters allocated to UNAMIR from 5 to 3, the SRSB had sent a letter to the Prime Minister informing him that UNAMIR will be constrained to assist the Government by this medium of transportation in the future. He instructed the meeting that

helicopters are to be used only by UNAMIR and only in cases of **real emergency** by other users.

**Visit of Gen. van Kappen and Ms. Lindenmayer**

4. The Programme for Gen. van Kappen has already been prepared by the military. A Programme for Ms. Lindenmayer should also be prepared.


Ms. Elizabeth Lindenmayer called this afternoon with certain instructions some of which I have relayed directly to the CAO.
