S E C R E T ELLEO 713 GARDINER ROLZ BENNETT FROM BACK.

ACCOMPANIED BY LOSSKY I VISITED KIMBA TODAY IN ORDER TO CLARIFY SITUATION OF HOUSES BELONGING TO GOVERNMENT AND OCCUPIED BY UN. KIMBA WAS WITH SECRETARY GENERAL OF MINISTRY OF PUBLIC WORKS MWEWA AND NGOIE, CHIEF OF CABINET OF KITENGE. IN REPLY TO OUR OFFER TO REGULARIZE SITUATION BY EXCHANGE OF LETTERS AND PAYMENT OF RENT KIMBA REFUSED SAYING HIS POPULATION WOULD NOT UNDERSTAND THAT HOUSES OCCUPIED BY FORCE BY UNATIONS SHOULD NOW BE RETURNED TO THEM WHEN ACUTE HOUSING SHORTAGE EXISTS HERE AND HIS OFFICIALS CANNOT BE ACCOMMODATED. HE EXPRESSED HIS READINESS TO ACCEPT OUR OFFER IF WE WOULD LIBERATE CAMP MASSART. I OBVIOUSLY DID NOT ENTERTAIN HIS PROPOSAL.

NGOIE THEN WITHDREW AND KIMBA BROACHED SUBJECT OF WILLIAM ROSE INCIDENT. IN THE MORNING HE HAD BITTERLY COMPLAINED ON THE TELEPHONE OF THE TONE OF OUR LETTER OF PROTEST AND HAD EXPRESSED THE HOPE THERE WOULD BE NO STATEMENT TO THE PRESS. I AGREED TO WITHHOLD RELEASE UNTIL I SAW HIM THIS AFTERNOON. KIMBA REITERATED HIS APOLOGIES STATING THAT CULPRITS WOULD BE PUNISHED AND SAID THAT A LETTER OF EXCUSE WAS READY. HIS INTENTION WAS TO LOCATE KALUME JEAN SAMUEL MENTIONED IN YOUR UNCLAS DFC-110. VEHICLE WAS SURROUNDED BY CROWD OF CIVILIANS, POLICEMEN AND GENDARMES AND KADIMA WAS BEATEN UP.
