Dear Byrochef Lindecrona,

In reference to our discussion about future dealings with Germany regarding D.P.s, I am pleased to send the following addresses.

As you know, any requests for transport through Germany, or permission to enter military zones, must be secured from the Allied Control Commission, Berlin. I believe the British Passport Control Office will be willing to forward any such requests.

I have advised UNRRA headquarters in Germany that you have given assurance that bus transport will be provided for the remaining D.P.s on the approved list, if they are assembled and cleared. On the last two convoys arrangements were made directly with the Swedish Red Cross at Hamburg. I have told UNRRA, and also American Joint Distribution Committee in Hamburg, (who are assisting in the assembly), that if the Red Cross is not able to provide the transport, that they can communicate directly with you. I have given both agencies your name, address and phone number.

In case the Swedish Government prepares another list of approved names, your lists and instructions should be forwarded to UNRRA Headquarters, Germany. Communications regarding any matters pertaining to the present or future lists of D.P.s should be addressed as follows:- Relief Services, UNRRA, Central Headquarters, Arolsen, Germany.

As you suggested, I am giving you my personal address, in the event that you wish my long distance cooperation. I am giving it also with the strict understanding that you get in contact with me in case you visit America.

Subject: Reuniting of Families.

As the Stockholm Office is closing on August 21st, I should like to advise you of the situation regarding the procedure of reuniting families.

- 1) D.Ps. with Permits to Enter Sweden: Your office and the office of the American Joint Distribution Committee in Hamburg have lists of all D.Ps. with permits to enter Sweden. I believe that the A.J.D.C. is still in the process of assembling these persons. Two bus convoys were brought to Sweden during the last 6 weeks. I am not sure whether enough persons are now assembled for another bus, but I think this is likely.

Arrangements were made by the A.J.D.C. and the Swedish Red Cross in Hamburg to provide the bus transport. The person in Hamburg to contact in relation to transport is Hr. Lundberg, Swedish Representative, Alster Ufer, Hamburg.

→ Yesterday I spoke to the Aliens Commission and was assured that the Swedish Government would undertake to provide bus transport for any persons on the list who are assembled and cleared. If for any reason the Swedish Red Cross is not able to make a bus available, the Aliens Commission will make other arrangements. This can be done by contacting Byråchef Lindencrona of the Swedish State Aliens Commission, Birger Jarlstorg 5, Stockholm, by letter or cable, or telephone (telephone number 23 31 20), and notifying London.

- 2) D.Ps. wishing to return to Germany: We sent forward to you a list of 49 names of D.Ps. who wish to return to Germany (through Miss Pollak when she visited Stockholm). These D.Ps. wish to be reunited with their families in Germany. As you will recall, the proposal was discussed with you when I visited Arolsen. These persons are most anxious to be reunited with their families and the Swedish officials feel that the plan to reunite families should be a reciprocal one. The Swedish Government has been most cooperative in bringing the D.Ps. to Sweden, and I should therefore like to urge that every effort possible be made to secure permits for the persons on the list to be given to enter Germany.

In case of favourable action, I would suggest that you communicate direct with the Social Bureau, Swedish State Aliens Commission, Valhallavägen 135, Stockholm, (Telephone number 67 93 00), notifying London at the same time.
