THE GENERAL SITUATION IN THE AREA WAS CALM.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

a. SECTOR HQ.

(1) NORMAL MORNING BRIEFING WITH MILOBS WAS HELD AT 0800 HOURS.

(2) THE AFC ACCOMPANIED BY THE CMO AND SOME STAFF OFFERS PAID A WORKING VISIT TO THE SECTOR FROM 1100-1200 HRS. HE WAS CONDUCTED TO THE RUSUMO BORDER POST WHERE HE WITNESSED THE RECEPTION OF RETURNEES FROM TANZANIA.

b. TEAMS.

(1) ONE (1) TEAM CONDUCTED A PATROL TO THE RUSUMO BORDER POST AND ALSO VISITED THE NYAKARAMBI 7449 AND BIRENGA 5958 TRANSIT CAMPS AND REPORTED THE SITUATION TO BE CALM.

UN RESTRICTED

THREE HUNDRED AND SIXTY ONE (361) RETURNEES ARRIVED AT THE RUSUMO BORDER POST ESCORTED BY TANZANIAN POLICE. THE IOM VEHICLES SINCE RETURNED BACK TO FETCH MORE RETURNEES. THE MILOBS TEAM INTERACTED WITH THE RETURNEES WHO CONFESSED THAT THEY HAVE BEEN COERCED TO RETURN AFTER THE VISIT OF THE PRIME MINISTER OF RWANDA. SOME OF THE REFUGEES HAD CROSSED OVER FROM BURUNDI.

(2) ONE (1) TEAM CONDUCTED A PATROL TO KANZENZE 8010 AND REPORTED THE SITUATION TO BE CALM. IN KANZENZE IT WAS LEARNT THAT 15 REFUGEES FROM TANZANIA, ZAIRE AND BURUNDI CAME ON THEIR OWN TO THE COMMUNE BETWEEN 01 AND 14 FEB 96 WITHOUT UNHCR ASSISTANCE.

(3) ONE (1) TEAM PATROLLED BYUMBA COMMUNE AND VISITED THE BYUMBA TRANSIT CAMP. THE SITUATION WAS CALM AND IT WAS LEARNT THAT THE PRESIDENT OF RWANDA WILL BE VISITING THE COMMUNE TOMORROW 15 FEB 96.

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. LOCALS IN BYUMBA ARE ENGAGED IN CLEARING AREA FOR NEW SETTLEMENT OF REFUGEES AT GR 095205. WORK LIKELY TO BE COMPLETED IN 4 DAYS TIME AFTER WHICH THE PROMISED UNAMIR BULLDOZER WILL BE REQUIRED.
