

General Alexander called to see me to-day and made the following suggestions:

1. It might ease the situation if a liaison officer from the Congolese army could be stationed with each Battalion.
2. There is a possibility, if pressure is put on the Ghana army, that they might have to withdraw their British officers.
3. In the future it will be necessary to relieve the Chaga unit which will be replaced with fresh units, but this will result in the loss of one sub-unit.
4. The Ghana Army have offered to train 120 Congolese cadets a year with the assistance of a French-Canadian staff supplied by the Canadian Government. Canadian Government are willing to provide this staff, provided the United Nations agrees.
5. The Russian aircraft are running an air service between Accra and Leopoldville. It was arranged that they would discontinue this when the route was taken over by Air Congo on behalf of the United Nations. General Alexander is anxious to have the original arrangement implemented.
