- Following telecon FMO UNAMIR / DPKO Med 27 Oct 95 discussions were undertaken between FMO and Med Director NORMED ref a downsized NORMED group to provide 2 / 3 level med support for an extension immediately prior to mission closure.
- Plan as outlined assumes the following:
 - Extension is not longer than 4-6 weeks.
 - Humanitarian medical work and emergency care to non-entitled individuals ceases mid -Dec.
 - Adequate notice is given to Norwegian Refugee Council to source replacements for individuals unable to extend, (minimum one month).
- Suggested downsizing would be from 28-20 ^{to} Norwegian medical personnel. The dentist would go (support available from Indbatt), pharmacist (Cdn military pers would assume duties), and 3 nursing teams downsized to 2.
- It is emphasized that this plan would NOT be workable for longer than 4-6 weeks. Replacement by another unit is relatively untenable

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



- Recent UNNY decision to delay any troop departure from UNAMIR to beyond 8 Dec 95 has generated closure planning at UNAMIR.
- Present plan envisions closure process into March 96 with requirement for 2 / 3 level medical support to mid or end Feb /96.
- Informal communication with NORMED pers indicates approximately 50% would be willing to extend. Overall indicators are that Norwegian Refugee Council could source required replacement if given adequate notice.
- FMO has ~~I~~ have been unable to get through via telephone over past week but would appreciate hearing from you vis a vis your contingency planning for med support to closure or alternatively a possible mandate renewal.
