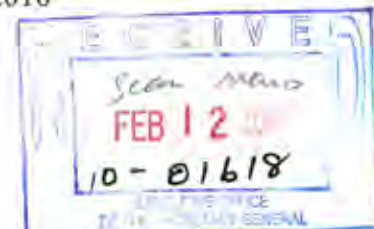

Subject: **Implementation of the resolutions and decisions adopted by the General Assembly during the sixty-fourth session** ✓

1. Please find in annex II a listing of the resolutions and decisions adopted during the sixty-fourth session of the General Assembly to date, together with an indication of responsibilities assigned for their implementation.
2. The department or office indicated first beside each resolution or decision would bear primary responsibility for implementing the resolution or decision and for initiating action in respect of it, including contacting, as expeditiously as possible, those departments listed subsequently **and any others not specified but deemed necessary to ensure appropriate action**. In cases where the primary responsibility is shared, the departments concerned are listed in alphabetical order with no functional priority implied. Departments and offices with secondary responsibility are also listed in alphabetical order or grouped as United Nations programmes in cases where the resolution or decision does not include explicit identification of a particular programme or organization.
3. Any comments or questions regarding the assignment of responsibilities contained herein, should be communicated to Mr. Kenji Nakano, Officer-in-Charge of the General Assembly Affairs Branch, Room S-2925, facsimile: (212) 963 4230 or email to nakano@un.org copied to Annotation-GAAB@un.org.
4. Questions that may arise in the course of implementing resolutions and decisions in the economic and social field should continue to be referred to the Under-Secretary-General for Economic and Social Affairs, who will ensure that all relevant resolutions and decisions with any reference to the specialized agencies are brought to their attention.

5. It is imperative that documents for consideration at the sixty-fifth session of the General Assembly be submitted and communicated to all units concerned in strict accordance with the schedule and length of documentation established by the Documents Planning Unit of DGACM in order to ensure that those documents will be available in all official languages in due time for the consideration of the Plenary and Main Committees of the General Assembly.

6. I should like to recall again for your attention that the General Assembly, in paragraph 7 of annex B to Assembly resolution 58/126, requested the Secretary-General to continue his efforts to make proposals to Member States for the consolidation of reports on related subjects in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 20 of resolution 57/300. The Secretary-General in implementing this provision has indicated that he would like each of us to actively pursue reducing the number of reports prepared for intergovernmental bodies. The General Assembly, in paragraph 6 of the annex to Assembly resolution 58/316, reiterated that the heavy volume of documentation that is submitted to the Assembly for its consideration should be reduced. Also, at its sixtieth session, the General Assembly, in paragraph 29 of the annex to Assembly resolution 60/286, requested the Secretary-General to implement further the measures set out in resolutions 57/300 and 58/316. In this connection, your continued support and cooperation towards this end will be most welcomed (see Annex I for more details on submission of reports).

7. In paragraph 17 (b) of annex II to General Assembly resolution 2837 (XXVI), the Secretary-General is requested "to communicate to Member States, not later than 15 June, an annotated list of items which would indicate briefly the history of each item, the available documentation, the substance of the matter to be discussed and earlier decisions by United Nations organs". Departments and offices bearing primary responsibility for the implementation of the resolutions and decisions listed herein will also be responsible for the preparation of corresponding contributions to the annotated preliminary list of items to be included in the provisional agenda of the sixty-fifth regular session of the General Assembly. The annotated list for the sixty-fifth session will be issued as document A/65/100. The memorandum requesting departments and offices to prepare their contribution to the annotated list will be sent in due course. The preliminary list of items to be included in the provisional agenda of the sixty-fifth session of the General Assembly will be issued as document A/65/50.

8. Thank you for your attention and cooperation.

Annex I

Relevant decisions of the General Assembly on the reports of the Secretary-General

Summary of reports

In accordance with paragraph 24 (a), Section B, of General Assembly resolution 52/214 of 22 December 1997, reports of the Secretary-General should contain a summary, irrespective of the length of the draft.

With effect 1 April 2002, draft reports, which would not conform to the above-mentioned legislative requirement, will be considered incomplete for processing.

Consolidated conclusions, recommendations and other proposed actions

In accordance with paragraph 24 (b), Section B, of Assembly resolution 52/214, reports of the Secretary-General should contain conclusions, recommendations and/or other proposed actions. In accordance with paragraph 25, Section B, of the same resolution, all documents submitted to legislative bodies for consideration and action should have conclusions and recommendations in bold print.

Please note that editorial services are not authorized to determine which part of the draft should be in boldface typesetting. With effect 1 April 2002, draft reports, which would not conform to the above-mentioned legislative requirement, will be considered incomplete for processing.

Footnotes in case of late submission

In paragraph 8, Section B, of Assembly resolution 53/208 of 18 December 1998, the General Assembly “*Decides* that if a report is submitted late to the conference services, the reasons for this should be included in a footnote to the document”.

Whenever a draft document submitted for processing after the established submission deadline that would not include the required footnote, the competent service of DGACM will include the following standard note:

“The footnote required in accordance with paragraph 8, Section B, of resolution 53/208, by which the General Assembly decided “that if a report is submitted late to the conference services, the reasons for this should be included in a footnote to the document”, was not included in the original submission”.
