WHO PEOPLE CONFIRM 5 CASES OF RAPE AND 1 WOMAN WITH SPINE INJURY CAUSED BY JUMPING FROM WINDOW. UN STAFF ALL TREATED CORRECTLY AS SOON AS IDENTITY ESTABLISHED.
