1.A. CALM.

1.B. ZAIRIAN/RWANDESE BORDER IS OPEN FOR ALL TRAFFIC EXCEPT UNAMIR PERSONNEL. NORMAL BORDER TRAFFIC BETWEEN UGANDAN / RWANDESE BORDER AT CYANIKA BORDERPOST. TRAFFIC STILL CLOSED FOR HUMANITARIAN AID TO COMA CAMPS.

2.A. NTR.

2.B. THE BRIGADE COMMANDER OF THE RPA BRIGADE AT RUHENGARI HAS INDICATED THAT HELICOPTER FLIGHTS ARE NOW PERMITTED AS LONG AS THE RPA LO AT GISENYI IS KEPT INFORMED OF OUR PLANS AND ROUTES. THIS IS NO CHANGE FROM OUR PRESENT POLICY THEREFORE WE WILL RECOMMENCE HELI VISITS/RECCES AS OF 01 JUN 95.

3.A. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED ROUTE A, GISENYI, RUBAVU (GS2313) - KAYOVE (GS2892). THE ROUTE IS CONSIDERED AS GOOD. IN THE NYUMBA COMMUNE (GS5506) THE BOURGMEISTER COMMENTED THAT THEY DID NOT YET HAVE POWER. THE ELECTRO GAZ PLANT AT GS 538084 APPEARS TO BE THE CLOSEST. THIS HAS BEEN PASSED TO THE UNHCR REP. LOCALS REPORT THAT THERE IS SOME DISPUTE REGARDING LAND CLAIMS (HR REP SO INFORMED). THIS INVOLVES APPROX 40 PERS. AT GR262976 THERE ARE APPROX 300 RETURNEES WHO WERE TRANSPORTED FROM THE COLLEGE AT NYUNDO (GS2511). THEY ARE AWAITING ALLOCATION OF LAND. THERE DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE ANY PROBLEM AT THIS TIME. THE AUSTRIAN WATER PROJECT AT KIVUMU (GS2403) IS COMPLETED WITH THE TANK IN PLACE AND AWAITING THE RETURN OF THE POPULATION. CONTACT WAS NOT MADE WITH THE PROJECT SUPERVISOR DUE TO HIS ABSENCE THIS DATE.

3.B. ONE MILOB PTL TO KIGALI TO PICK UP TWO REPAIRED VENS.

3.C. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED ACCOMPANIED THE RPA EOD TEAM TO THE SITE OF THE PREVIOUSLY REPORTED UNEXPLODED ORDINANCE NEAR THE RUHENGARI ELECTO GAZ STATION. THE TEAM WAS UNABLE TO DEFINITELY IDENTIFY THE SPECIFIC TYPE OF ORDINANCE AS IT HAD BEEN IN LOCATION FOR SOME TIME AND WAS COVERED BY APPROX 20-30mm OF DIRT. THE ORDINANCE WAS SUCCESSFULLY DETONATED.

- 4.A. TUNBATT PROVIDED ONE TRUCK FOR THE TN OF BLANKETS AND KITCHEN UTENSILS TO GASEKE (GS4911), SATINSKI (GS5900) AND KIBILIRA (GS5785).
- 4.B. ONE HR TEAM VISITED TUNBATT HQ TO FOLLOW UP ON A REPORT OF AN IDP WHO WAS SEEKING POLITICAL ASYLUM. THE IDP HAS SINCE LEFT THE TUNBATT HQ CAMP. FOLLOW UP REPORT TO FOLLOW FROM RUHENGARI.
- 5.A. THE NUMBER OF RETURNEES THROUGH CYANIKA BORDER-POST WAS 13.
- 5.B. NUMBER OF RETURNEES FROM ZAIRE AT GISENYI\GOMA BORDER-POST WAS 99.
6. A. FOUR VEHICLES FROM THE SECTOR 487,1032, 1115 AND 1012 PRESENTLY IN WORKSHOP KIGALI FOR REPAIRS.

- 7.B. THE BASE RADIO HAS DEVELOPED FAULT. THE FAULT DOES NOT SEEM TO LIE WITH THE BASE STATION BUT IN THE INSTALLATION OF THE RADIO WHEN THE OFFICE VENUE WAS SHIFTED. THE FAULT BASICALLY LIES IN THE FEED COMING FROM THE ANTENNA AS HAS BEEN ANALYZED BY THE SIGNAL REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE FORCE SIGNAL. IT IS THEREFORE MANDATORY THAT THE COMMUNICATIONS IN THE UNAMIR HQ BE CONTACTED TO REACH THIS LOCATION ASAP AND REPAIR THE SYSTEM TO ENSURE THAT FOOL PROOF COMMUNICATION IS RESTORED AT THIS HQ. AT PRESENT THERE IS A ADHOC ARRANGEMENT IMPROVISED TO KEEP THE SYSTEM GOING HOWEVER THE SAME CANNOT BE USED AS A RULE AND WILL REQUIRE A PROMPT RESPONSE FROM COMMUNICATIONS SECTION.
- NOTE - THIS FAULT HAS BEEN REPORTED FOR THE PAST 10 DAYS WITHOUT RESPONSE. ALL COMMS ORIGINATING FROM THE OPS ROOM ARE BY MOTOROLA WITH LIMITED SUCCESS ON CH10 AND NO SUCCESS ON CH12. REQUEST THAT THIS BE ACTIONED AS A SAFETY/SECURITY CONCERN ASAP.

1.B. ZAIRIAN/RWANDESE BORDER IS OPEN FOR ALL TRAFFIC EXCEPT UNAMIR PERSONNEL. NORMAL BORDER TRAFFIC BETWEEN UGANDAN / RWANDESE BORDER AT CYANIKA BORDERPOST. TRAFFIC STILL CLOSED FOR HUMANITARIAN AID TO GOMA CAMPS.

2.A. NTR.

2.B. THE ATTEMPTS TO CONTACT THE BRIGADE COMMANDER OF THE RPA BRIGADE AT RUHENGARI ARE STILL ON TO CLARIFY THE ISSUE OF HELICOPTER RECCE IN THE AOR. THE REPLY IS STILL AWAITED FROM THE BRIGADE COMMANDER AND THE SAME WILL BE COMMUNICATED TO YOUR END ASAP.

3.A. A MILOB TEAM PATROLLED THE AREAS OF GISENYI, MUKINGO (5029), KAREBA (4424), MUTURA (3223) AND RWERERE (2922). THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO LIAISE WITH THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND THE LOCAL POPULACE IN THE AREA AND ASSESS THE SECURITY SITUATION IN THE AREA. THE TEAM WAS ALSO TASKED TO ASSESS THE CONDITIONS OF THE ROADS AND TRACKS IN THE AREA. THE TEAM WAS ALSO TASKED TO LIAISE WITH THE MSF CLINIC LOCATED AT KAREBA AND CHECK THE CONDITIONS PERTAINING TO THE MEDICAL AID AVAILABLE TO THE LOCAL POPULACE IN THE AREA. THE PATROL REPORTED THAT THE SITUATION IN THE AREA WAS CALM AND THE LOCALS ARE GOING ABOUT THEIR DAILY CHORES. THE PATROL ALSO WITNESSED A NUMBER OF MEETINGS IN THE SECTOR AND THESE WERE REPORTED AS ROUTINE MEETINGS HELD IN THE SECTORS ON TUESDAYS. THESE MEETINGS ARE PRESIDED BY THE CONSEILLERS AND DEAL WITH SECURITY AND DAY - TO - DAY MATTERS. THE PATROL ALSO REPORTED THAT THE MSF CLINICS AT KAREBA AND AT KABATWA WERE FUNCTIONING SATISFACTORILY HOWEVER THE CLINIC AT KABATWA REPORTED SHORTAGE OF DRUGS. THIS MATTER WILL BE TAKEN UP WITH THE MSF AUTHORITIES DURING THE MORNING PRAYERS ON 31 MAY 95 AND THE MATTER RESOLVED AT THE EARLIEST. THE ROAD CONDITION ENROUTE WAS DESCRIBED BY THE PATROL AS DIFFICULT.

3.B. A JOINT MILOB /HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM PATROLLED THE AREA

GISENYI, NYAMYUMBA (2006) AND KAYOVE (2995). THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO ASSESS THE SECURITY SITUATION IN THE AREA AND THE CONDITION OF THE ROADS / TRACKS.

- 3.C. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED THE AREAS OF RUHENGARI, CYANIKA (7152), KIDAHU (7247), BUTARO (8243), KIRAMBO (8335) AND BUSHOKA (7223). THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO LIAISE WITH THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND ASSESS THE SECURITY SITUATION IN THE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY. THE TEAM REPORTED THE SECURITY SITUATION IN THE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY TO BE CALM.
4. THE UNHCR TODAY TRANSPORTED A TOTAL OF 411 1959-60 CASE LOAD RETURNEES FROM GISENYI RECEPTION CENTER TO THEIR NEW RESETTLEMENT AREAS. A TOTAL OF 100 FAMILIES WERE TRANSPORTED FROM GISENYI TO KAYOVE. THE CONVOYS WERE ACCOMPANIED BY TRUCKS CONSISTING OF FOOD AND NONFOOD ITEMS.

- 5.B. NUMBER OF RETURNEES FROM ZAIRE AT GISENYI\GOMA BORDER-POST WAS 113.

- 7.C. THE INVESTIGATION INTO THE KILLING OF THE THREE PERSONS IN THE COMMUNE OF NYAMYUMBA CONTINUES.THE KILLING INVOLVED THE GUNNING DOWN OF THREE PERSONS TO INCLUDE A GRAND PARENTS AND THE GRAND SON (AGED 17 YEARS) BY A LONE RPA SOLDIER.THE MOTIVE

BEHIND THE KILLING HAS NOT BEEN ASCERTAINED HOWEVER THE RPA SOLDIER HAS BEEN ARRESTED BY THE RPA AUTHORITIES. ATTEMPTS ARE BEING MADE PRESENTLY TO INTERVIEW THE SOLDIER. INVESTIGATION REPORT WILL BE SENT ON THE COMPLETION OF THE INVESTIGATION.

- 7.D. ONE EOD DEVICE HAS BEEN DISCOVERED IN RUHENGARI NEAR THE MAIN ELECTRO GAZ STATION. THE TYPE IS UNKNOWN HOWEVER THE DEVICE LOOKS LIKE A RIFLE GRENADE. THE RPA HAVE BEEN INFORMED.

2.B. THE RPA BATTALION COMMANDER AT RUHENGARI WAS CONTACTED BY THE MILOBS TODAY TO SEEK CLARIFICATION ON THE RESTRICTION ON THE HELICOPTER RECCE IN SECTOR 5. THE BATTALION COMMANDER STATED THAT THEY WERE WAITING FOR GUIDE LINES FROM THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE ON THE POLICY REGARDS THE MATTER AND TILL SUCH TIME HE COULD NOT PERMIT ANY HELICOPTER RECCE IN THE AREA OF THE OPERATIONS. THE MILOBS ARE AT PRESENT MAKING ATTEMPTS TO CONTACT THE BRIGADE COMMANDER AT RUHENGARI TO GET A CLEARER PICTURE REGARDING THE SAME. ANY FURTHER INFORMATION RECEIVED WILL BE COMMUNICATED TO YOU ASAP.

3.A. REF YOUR REQUEST ABOUT MOVEMENT OF RPA SOLDIERS OVER THE WEEKEND. IT HAS BEEN DETERMINED THESE MOVEMENTS WERE ASSOCIATED WITH THE VISIT OF HIGH LEVEL OFFICIALS HERE TO GISENYI.

3.B. A JOINT MILOB /HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM PATROLLED THE AREAS OF GISENYI, JABA (4521) ,KABAYA (5006) ,SATINSYI (6100) AND NGORORERO (6095). THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO ASCERTAIN THE CONDITION OF THE ROUTE WHICH HAD BEEN DAMAGED DUE TO RAIN DISRUPTING THE MOVEMENT OF THE RELIEF TRUCKS TO THE COMMUNE OF RAMBA (5093). THE TEAM WAS ALSO TASKED TO VERIFY IF THE FOOD DISTRIBUTION TO THE POPULACE OF RAMBA HAD BEEN CARRIED OUT AT NGORORERO. THE TEAM ALSO LIAISED WITH THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES AT THE VARIOUS COMMUNE OFFICES ENROUTE. THE PATROL REPORTED THAT THE ROAD CONDITION WAS POOR BUT WAS PASSABLE BUT IN SOME PLACES THE TEAM HAD TO BE ASSISTED BY THE LOCALS. THE TEAM ALSO REPORTED THAT THE FOOD DISTRIBUTION AT RAMBA TOOK PLACE ON THE 24 MAY 95. THE GENERAL SITUATION IN THE AREA WAS

REPORTED CALM.

4. THE UNHCR TODAY TRANSPORTED A TOTAL OF 394 1959-60 CASE LOAD RETURNEES FROM GISENYI RECEPTION CENTER TO THEIR NEW RESETTLEMENT AREAS. A TOTAL OF 56 FAMILIES CONSISTING OF 186 PEOPLE WERE TRANSPORTED FROM GISENYI TO KIBUNGO AND A TOTAL OF 51 FAMILIES CONSISTING OF 208 PEOPLE WERE TRANSPORTED TO KIBUYE. THE CONVOYS WERE ACCOMPANIED BY TRUCKS CONSISTING OF FOOD AND NONFOOD ITEMS. THIS CONVOYS ARE THE INITIAL CONVOYS SCHEDULED BY THE UNHCR AND THE MINISTRY OF REHABILITATION IN THE PROCESS OF RESETTLING THE 1959-60 CASE LOAD RETURNEES AT THE EARLIEST AND EMPTYING THE COLLEGE RECEPTION CENTER AT GISENYI WITHIN A TIME SPAN OF TWO WEEKS.

GENERAL SITUATION

1. The general situation in the sect remains calm. The major humanitarian problems facing the sect continue to be the resettlement of the old case loads(over 10,000 housed in the College reception centre) to land identified by the MINRIESO, and the scattering of the IDPs in the different communes of the sect.

OWN HAC ACTIVITIES

2. The Ministry of Family and Promotion of Women, approached MILOBS, seeking assistance in transporting non food items to the widows and the destitute in the communes. MILOBS and HCDH has since helped to transport blankets and kitchen sets to Kayove and Giciye communes, in integral transport. Additional transport is being requisitioned from TUNBATT to transport the considerable amount of aid material held by the ministry, to the various communes.

3. On a request from the MILOBS, the Force Engineers carried out a recce of the Gihira Hydro-electric centre run by the Electrogaz to examine the possibilities of removing a blockage in the outlet of the hydro-electric plant, by means of a tracked dozer. This is crucial to ensure that the production of electricity is not stopped. The dozer has since been approved and is on its way to the sect to start work. The dozer will also be used to dig another garbage pit, in the College Reception centre, and possibly remove some mud heaps in the Gisenyi prison.

4. The MILOBS assisted the HCDH in distribution of office equipment including 5 typewriters, to the Gisenyi judiciary. These were acquired from Kigali by the HCDH.

5. On a request from the MILOBS, the Force HQ, sanctioned two tents, for use by the Gisenyi judiciary, on loan basis, for a period of two months. These tents will be used as office accomodation by the judiciary for their work within the premises of the Gisenyi prison.

6. A joint MILOB -UNHCR-MERLIN(medical) patrol was carried out on helicopter to visit areas made inaccessible by rains. The

activity was coordinated by the MILOBS and enabled the UNHCR to inspect food stock dumped by them at Ngororero commune. This food is meant for 10,000 people in the Ramba commune, which remains cut off due to rains. The food is now being collected by the people of Ramba. They are moving down to Ngororero by foot to collect the same. The patrol also enabled the MERLIN to ascertain the medical condition in these remote areas. The MERLIN staff also distributed some medicines in Ngororero and Kibilira communes. More such patrols are being planned in the future.

GENERAL LIVING CONDITIONS

7. No change.

PEOPLE WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

8. Orphanages. An NGO, SALEM, has requested food for 50 children at St. Vincent Transit Centre at Ruhengeri. The orphanage at Nyundo shelters 587 orphans and are in dire need of food and non food items. Though the MILOBS have recently arranged to procure some supplies through the WFP, the requirement, here is, vast and NEEDS ATTENTION AT A HIGHER LEVEL to enable the orphans to survive.

9. Hospitals. MILOB patrols found that the following areas require additional health centres/posts. The same has been brought to the notice of the MSF:

a). The people of Ngororero commune have to walk for more than 20 km to get medical treatment at commune Gaseke. A dispensary being constructed in this area lies unfinished since the genocide days.

b). In Kinigi commune people living in the foothills of the volcanic region have to walk long distances in the rains with their sick, to go to the hospital at Kinigi. This is due to the fact that the existing health post at Bisate has closed down. MSF has been apprised.

10. IDPS. The IDPS at Nemba have refused to go back to their home communes in Gitarama, because they fear of reprisals. When presented with a deadline of 24 May as the last day for them to move back pending arrests by the RPA, they have reacted by slipping away to the neighbouring communes.

11. Old caseloads. About 10,000 of these people are languishing in the College reception centre for want of land. So far only 342 families have been moved to different places. The Ministry of Education has given just 2 weeks to close down this centre.


12. a). ARP. Carrying out water rehabilitation of commune Nyamyumba.
- b). ICRC. In conjunction with IFRC, they have united 20 separated children with their parents. Their water rehab programme in Kinigi has stopped because of suspected presence of mines in this area.
- c). COOPI. Continuing two major tasks of rehabilitating primary schools, training teachers and running the College reception centre, especially it's sanitation.
- d). MERLIN/MSE. Staffing of hospitals and health posts, rehabilitation of dispensaries and vaccination are the major tasks.

UN Agencies

13. WFP. Provided food for 8447 old caseloads in Ruhengeri. They also supplied one month's ration to 50 families of old caseloads who were sent to Kayova region. They continue to provide food-for-work to the Rwerere road construction project.
14. UNHCR. Organised repatriation from Zaire remains suspended. Main work this week was food distribution to the communes and moving of old case loads to the communes.

Local Authorities.

15. Relation with the local authorities is cordial. The humanitarian team has meetings with bourgemestres and the Prefects on need basis to coordinate various activities.

THE COUNCELLOR WILL HAVE A LIST OF VICTIMS AND WITNESSES READY BY NEXT WEDNESDAY. THE TEAM VISITED THE VUMBI SECT NEXT AND LEARNT ABOUT THE ARRESTS OF THREE PERSONS IN THE MONTH OF MAY. THESE ARE ACCUSED OF CONNIVING WITH THE INTERHAMWE. ON THEIR VISIT TO CYMBILI CELLULE OF SECT KIGEYO THE TEAM LEARNT OF 4 ARRESTS, OF WHICH ONE WAS MADE IN MAY. THESE PRISONERS STATED THAT THEY DO NOT KNOW AS YET THE REASON AS TO WHY THEY HAVE BEEN ARRESTED. NGABO SECT AND NYAMYUMBA COMMUNE REPORTS OF CASES OF ARMED BANDITRY WHICH OCCURED LAST WEEK. THE ABOVE INCIDENTS ARE BEING MONITORED.

THE BOURGEMESTRE OF NGORORERO INFORMED THE TEAM THAT THE PEOPLE OF RAMBA WOULD NOW MOVE ON FOOT TO RECEIVE THIS FOOD STOCK. UNHCR MONITORING THIS EVENT. THE BOURGEMESTRE INFORMED THE MEDICAL REP THAT THE PEOPLE OF THE COMMUNE HAD TO WALK VERY LONG DISTANCES TO GASEKE COMMUNE TO GET MEDICAL TREATMENT. A DISPENSARY WHICH WAS BEING CONSTRUCTED HERE LIES UNFINISHED SINCE THE GENOCIDE DAYS. THE TEAM VISITED KIBILIRA NEXT. THE BOURGEMESTRE REPORTS THAT THE LAW AND ORDER SITUATION HAD DETERIORATED EVER SINCE THE RPA PULLED OUT OF THIS PLACE. IDPS WHO HAD PREVIOUSLY NOT COME TO THIS PLACE DUE TO PRESENCE OF THE RPA, HAVE NOW GOT INTO THIS AREA, AND AS PER HIM ARE CARRYING OUT ACTS OF BANDITRY. THERE HAVE BEEN TWO CASES WHEREIN ONE MAN WAS BADLY INJURED AND ANOTHER KILLED BY MACHATE ATTACKS ON 09 AND 13 MAY 95. THESE ACTS HAVE ALSO, REPORTEDLY BEEN COMMITTED BY THE IDPS. DETAILS BEING CONFIRMED. MEDICAL ADVICE WAS GIVEN AND DRUGS DISTRIBUTED BY MERLIN REP, WHO ACCOMPANIED THE FLIGHT.
- 3.D. MILOBS RUHENGARI REPORTED OF YET ANOTHER EXPLOSION IN RUHENGARI IN WHICH ANOTHER ELECTRIC PYLON IN MUKINGO COMMUNE HAS BEEN DAMAGED. 

1. Ndusu - IDPS. Refer our report on the IDP situation dated 17 May 95, the IDPS, have since moved out of the Ndusu area and relocated themselves in the neighbouring villages, hiding in the houses of the locals, sympathetic towards them. While it is true that some of the IDPS have gone back to their homes, it is also true that most of them have not returned, due to fear of reprisals by the locals(survivors of genocide) and the militia. The only two concentration of IDPS seen are a group of 50 people at Ndusu and about a hundred people at Namba 7719. These people have asked shelter from UNAMIR and co-located themselves with the TUNBATT troops there. TUNBATT is now in the process of transporting 71 IDPS to Kigali sect in UNAMIR transport. They have been stopped enroute at Shyironzi 9695 by the RPA battalion operating there ex Kigali. The matter is being sorted out.

2. Old Caseload. The College reception centre housing over 11000 old case loads continues to be a major headache. In absence of enough land these people continue to languish here. Now some land has been identified in Kayove commune of Gisenyi and Kigali sect, allowing about 450 families to be moved out.

3. Food distribution to the needy in the communes is being carried out by UNHCR and WFP.

4. The ICRC arranged the reunion of 10 separated minors with their families.

5. The ARP has started work on establishing a water system in Nyamyumba commune 2007, where old case loads are being settled. MILOBS assisted in the recce.


6. Work on the Kinigi water system 4054 has stopped due to suspected presence of mines here. The same has been earlier referred to UNAMIR hq, for assistance in clearing the area. No progress so far.

7. The digging of garbage pits in the college complex, by the force engineers has since been completed. A tracked dozer has now been demanded to help the ELECTROGAZ in carrying out some dredging work in their Gihira hydro-electric project.

8. The MILOBS liaised with TUNBATT and the MERLIN to assist

in evacuation of three seriously injured soldiers to Kigali on separate occasions.

9. MILOBS liaised with ICRC to monitor a report of an outbreak of dysentery among the inmates of the Ruhengeri prison. There were some deaths reported earlier due to this. The ICRC has assured, that the condition is under control. A MILOB team also visited the Gisenyi prison to monitor the health situation there. The conditions are satisfactory.

THEREAFTER HE WAS BROUGHT TO THE TUNBATT HQ AT MARERU AND RELEASED TO ESCAPE TO ZAIRE ON HIS OWN. UN COMPLICITY IN THE MATTER HAS BEEN ALLEGED. ACCORDING TO THE LO THE NEWS WAS GIVEN OUT IN THE RADIO. DATE OF THIS SUPPOSED INCIDENT IS BELIEVED TO BE 15 MAY. THE TRUTH OF THE INCIDENT MAY PLEASE BE CLARIFIED AT THE EARLIEST TO PREVENT DAMAGE TO UN IMAGE.

3.A. ONE TEAM WHICH PATROLLED THE KARISOKE RESEARCH CENTRE WITH THE DFGF, CONFIRMED EARLIER REPORTS OF EXTENSIVE DAMAGE CAUSED TO THE RESEARCH CENTRE BY BANDITS/INFILTRATORS, ON 26 APRIL. IT IS REPORTED THAT 85% OF THE ROOFS HAVE BEEN STOLEN BY BANDITS AND MISCREANTS. THE POPULATION FEELS INSECURE BECAUSE OF THE INCREASE IN BANDITRY INCIDENTS IN THIS AREA. THERE ARE REPORTS OF 5 ARRESTS MADE BY THE RPA ON 03 MAY IN THIS AREA. THE SAME IS BEING INVESTIGATED BY THE RCDH.

3.B. THE RPA BATTALION COMD HAD A CORDIAL MEETING WITH TUNBATT INTELLIGENCE OFFICER AT THE MILOBS SUB-SECTOR OFFICE IN RUHENGARI TO DISCUSS THE MOVE OF IDPS TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES. LAST NIGHT, 71 IDPS, BEING TRANSPORTED IN 5 UNAMIR TCVS, WERE STOPPED AT SHIYONGI CHECK POINT 9605 BY RPA EX KIGALI SECT. FOLLOWING INTERVENTION BY TUNBATT AND MILOBS, THE IDPS WERE ALLOWED TO PASS THROUGH LATER IN THE AFTERNOON. THE PREFECT RUHENGARI AND THE RPA BRIGADE COMD HAVE BOTH EXPRESSED SATISFACTION OVER TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS MADE BY UNAMIR TO MOVE THE IDPS TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES. EFFORTS ARE ON TO CONVINCE THE IDPS TO MOVE BACK.

3.C. ONE TEAM MONITORED THE NEMBA IDPS. NO CHANGE IN THE SITUATION. BESIDES THE MASS GRAVES IN GITARAMA SECT REPORTED BY THESE IDPS(REFER LAST SITREP), THEY ALSO REPORT OF SECRET PRISON CELLS IN THAT SECT, NAMELY-- NTONGWE(INSIDE IGA HOUSE) AND AT MUGINA (COOPERATIVE KOPROKONU). GRID REF NOT KNOWN. MAY BE REFERRED TO GITARAMA SECT. THE IDPS FURTHER REPORT THAT IN GITARAMA, THE HUTU POPULATION BEING MORE THAN THE TUTSIS, THE TUTSIS WANT TO MAINTAIN EQUILIBRIUM BY KILLING THE HUTUS. THEY FURTHER REPORT THAT THE RPA ARE ASKING THEM FOR MONEY. THOSE NOT ABLE TO PAY ARE BEING INCLUDED IN THE HIT LIST.

3.D. ONE MILOB-HCDH TEAM VISITED THE KINIGI AREA TO MONITOR THE SECURITY SITUATION THERE. THE TEAM REPORTED THAT THE SITUATION APPEARED TO BE NORMAL THERE. RPA IS REPORTEDLY THINNING OUT FROM THIS LOCATION. THE LOCALS IN GENERAL AREA NORTH OF KINIGI WERE SEEN CARRYING SICK PEOPLE FOR TREATMENT. THEY ASKED FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF HEALTH POSTS IN THIS AREA. THE MATTER IS BEING REFERRED TO MSF.

3.A. ONE TEAM PATROLLED AREA GISENYI- KARAMBO 3309. PATROL COULD NOT PROCEED BEYOND AREA 3809, DUE TO THE BAD STATE OF ADHOC BRIDGES ENROUTE. PATROL REPORTED OF COMPLAINTS FROM OLD CASELOADS (59-60 RETURNEES) TO THE EFFECT THAT THEY WERE LANDLESS. IT SEEMS THAT THEY HAD OCCUPIED LAND AND PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE PEOPLE WHO HAD MIGRATED TO ZAIRE DURING THE GENOCIDE AND HAD TO VACATE THE SAME ON THEIR RETURN. CASE BEING REFERRED TO UNHCR. OTHERWISE, SITUATION REPORTED TO BE CALM.

3.B. ONE JOINT HUMAN RIGHTS AND MILOB TEAM CARRIED OUT AN INVESTIGATION OF A MINE EXPLOSION IN GENERAL AREA NGOROERO 5995. THE INVESTIGATION REVEALS THAT THE INCIDENT WAS A CASE OF AMBUSH BY PERPRATATORS OF, RPA ROUTINE PATROLS TRAVELLING ON ROUTINE PATROLS ON THE ROUTE. THE INCIDENT HAPPENED ON 11 MAY 95 AND THE MINE IN QUESTION WAS AN ANTI TRANSPORT MINE WHICH HAD BEEN PLANTED RIGHT ON THE MIDDLE OF THE ROAD BY THE MISCREANTS AROND DUSK. THE MINE EXPLODED AND KILLED TWO RPA SOLDIERS AND INJURED THREE OTHERS. THE CULPRITS HAVE NOT BEEN TRACED. NO OTHER MINE WAS FOUND IN THE VICINITY OF THE INCIDENT.

3.C. THE NDUSU SITUATION WAS MONITORED BY THE MILOBS TODAY. THEY COULD NOT FIND ANY IDP CONCENTRATIONS ANYWHERE IN THE NEIGHBOURING AREAS OF NDUSU PROPER. AS PER THEIR REPORT THE IDPS WERE NOT STAYING IN SEPERATE AREAS BUT IN HOUSES OF THE LOCALS WHO SEEM TO BE HELPING THEM OUT. AS A RESULT OF THIS

THE TEAM WAS ALSO NOT ABLE TO VERIFY PREVIOUS REPORT THAT THE RPA HAD PHYSICALLY MARKED THE HOUSES OF THE IDPS TO ENABLE THEM TO DISTINGUISH THEM FROM THE HOUSES OF THE LOCALS, COULD NOT BE VERIFIED. THE TEAM HEARD OF ARRESTS OF IDPS BY THE RPA AND WENT TO THE COMMUNE PRISON TO VERIFY THE REPORT. THEY FOUND 12 IDPS LOCKED UP IN THE COMMUNE PRISON ON CHARGES AS VARIED AS GENOCIDE, ADVENTIST TENDENCIES AND THEFT. THEY TALKED TO THE 50 ODD IDPS WHO ARE NOW IN NDUSU AND CO- LOCATED WITH THE TUNBATT. CONTRARY TO THE REPORTS RECEIVED FROM TUNBATT, THESE IDPS, WHEN INTERVIEWED BY THE MILOBS, EXPRESSED UNWILLINGNESS TO RETURN TO THEIR HOMES AND REQUESTED FOR UNAMIR PROTECTION.

- 3.D. THE MILOB PATROL THAT VISITED THE IDPS IN NEMBA NOW REPORTS THAT THESE PEOPLE ARE NOT NEW IDPS WHO WERE PREVIOUSLY REPORTED TO HAVE COME FROM GITARAMA DIRECTLY, BUT PART OF THE GROUP OF NDUSU IDPS WHO HAD RELOCATED THEMSELVES HERE. THE GROUP SPOKE TO THE MILOBS AND REPORTED THAT THEY WERE BEING ASKED TO PAY MONEY TO THE RPA TO ESCAPE ARRESTS THESE PEOPLE HAVE PROVIDED INFORMATION ABOUT MASS GRAVES IN GITARAMA (FROM WHERE THEY COME) IN MUGIRA COMMUNE, AT NYAKABUNDA (NEAR THIS COMMUNE), RUNDA COMMUNE AND NEAR A SECONDARY SCHOOL AT REMEARA (GR NOT KNOWN). THE SAME MAY BE REFERRED TO MILOBS GITARAMA. THE IDPS AGAIN ASKED FOR PROTECTION FROM UNAMIR.
- 3.E. SIX UNAMIR TRUCKS REPORTED TO TUNBATT HQ TODAY IN RESPONSE TO EARLIER REQUEST FOR TRANSPORTATION OF IDPS WILLING TO GO BACK TO THEIR HOMES. THE TUNBATT IS NOW LIAISING WITH THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND THE RPA BATTALION COMD IN RUHENGARI TO TIE UP THE MODALITIES OF TRANSPORTING THESE IDPS.
- 3.F. THE INVESTIGATION ON THE SHOOTOUT AT LAK KIVU CONFIRMS THE FACT THAT THE VICTIMS WERE FISHERMEN WHO WERE FISHING IN THE LAKE LONG BEYOND THE PERMITTED TIME OF 1800H, AND DID NOT HAVE ANY PERMISSION FOR THE SAME. THE RPA SHOT AT THEM PRESUMING THEM TO BE INTERHAMWE. THE NUMBER OF DEAD IS NOW BELIEVED TO BE NO MORE THAN TWO. THE BODIES ARE YET TO BE FOUND.
4. THE GISENYI PRISON WAS VISITED BY THE DOCTORS FROM THE GISENYI HOSPITAL, FOR THE GENERAL CHECKUP OF THE PRISONERS. THE VISIT WAS MONITORED BY MILOBS.

AT KIVUMU THE TEAM FOUND THE NGO, CARITAS CONSTRUCTING A NEW DISPENSARY. ON REACHING NYABIRASI THE TEAM VISITED THE DISPENSARY, BEING REHABILITATED THERE BY THE MERLIN. THE LOCAL STAFF COMPLAINED OF SHORTAGE IN DRUGS FOR MALARIA, etc. THEY ALSO REPORTED BEING UNDERSTAFFED. THE TEAM ALSO HEARD OF REPORTS ABOUT A RPA CORDON OPERATION EARLIER THIS MONTH, TO RECOVER WEAPONS FROM SUSPECTED CACHES. NOTHING WAS FOUND.

3.B. REFERENCE THE SUPPOSED KILLING OF 10 PERSONS IN THE LAKE SHOOTOUT AS REPORTED YESTERDAY. IT HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED BY THE JOINT HUMAN RIGHTS- MILOB INVESTIGATING TEAM THAT THE VICTIMS WERE FISHERMEN SHOT BY MISTAKE BY THE RPA. THESE FISHERMEN WERE OUT FISHING IN THE NIGHT WITHOUT ANY AUTHORISATION, AND APPARENTLY THE RPA HAD NO INFORMATION ABOUT THEIR PRESENCE IN THE AREA. DETAILS OF CASUALTIES STILL NOT CONFIRMED. THE TEAM ALSO VISITED VILLAGE GAHUNDO 2397 AND REPORTS THE ARREST OF 11 PERSONS, SINCE AUGUST LAST, ON CHARGES OF GENOCIDE.

3.C. ONE MILOB TEAM IS MONITORING THE CONDITION OF THE IDPS IN NDUSU. THE TEAM REPORTS A MEETING BETWEEN THE PREFECT RUHENGIERI, BOURGEMESTRES AND COUNSELLORS OF NDUSU TO DETERMINE THE NUMBER OF IDPS REMAINING AND DISCUSS THEIR

UNHCR TRANSPORTATION TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES. THE TEAM ALSO REPORTS CONCENTRATION OF RPA IN NDUSU. DETAILS AWAITED. LATER IN THE DAY, THE MILOBS RECEIVED A REQUEST FROM TUNBATT TO UNHCR FOR PROVIDING TRANSPORT TO 1109 IDPS IN NDUSU, WHO APPARENTLY HAVE AGREED TO GO BACK TO THEIR HOMES. MILOBS CONTACTED ~~HUMAN RIGHTS~~ ON THE ISSUE, AND WERE TOLD THAT AS PER UNHCR KIGALI, UNHCR MANDATE DOES NOT EXTEND TO IDPS. THE TIGHTENING OF SECURITY BY THE RPA AND THE SUPPOSED HARDENING OF ATTITUDE BY THE ZAIRIAN GOVT TOWARDS THE FRGF APPEARS TO ACCOUNT FOR THIS MARKED CHANGE.

3.B. ONE MILOB PATROL VISITED NDUSU. THE COMMUNE OFFICE AGAIN REITERATES THAT ONLY 161 IDPS REMAIN, OF WHICH, SOME HAVE STARTED LEAVING TODAY. THE TEAM LATER INTERVIEWED AN EYE WITNESS WHO HAD SEEN 30 IDPS LEAVING TOWARDS GITARAMA TODAY FROM SECT MATABA OF NDUSU COMMUNE. THE TEAM SUSPECTS THAT MANY OF THE IDPS MAY HAVE NOT GONE BACK TO THEIR HOMES BUT WOULD HAVE GOT INTO NEIGHBOURING COMMUNES. IT IS SUGGESTED THAT THE GITARAMA PREFECTURE BE CONTACTED TO FIND OUT AS TO HOW MANY OF THESE IDPS HAVE ACTUALLY GONE BACK HOME. THE SITUATION MAYBE WORTH MONITORING BY THE MILOBS IN GITARAMA.



1. NDUSU COMMUNE 6213, HAS OVER THE PAST MONTH SEEN A GRADUAL CONCENTRATION OF IDPS DRIFTING IN FROM GENERAL AREA GITARAMA. THE FIGURES HAVE SWELLED marginally AFTER THE KIBAHU INCIDENT. AS OF NOW THE FIGURE STANDS AT APPROXIMATELY 1000. IN THE PREVIOUS MONTH THERE HAD BEEN SOME ARRESTS AMONG THESE PEOPLE ON CHARGES OF GENOCIDE. THE SITUATION WAS BEING MONITORED BY THE HUMAN RIGHTS AND MILOBS. IT HAD BECOME ALLRIGHT. NOW WITH INCREASE IN THIS STRENGTH, THE AUTHORITIES HAVE SHOWN A GROWING CONCERN FOR THE LOT. THE PREFECT OF RUHENGERI PREFECTURE ALONG WITH THE MILITARY ARE ADDRESSING THE IDPS TODAY. A MILOB TEAM HAS BEEN SENT TO MONITOR THE SAME.

2. OUT OF THE 9000 OLD CASE LOADS PRESENTLY HOUSED IN THE COLLEGE RECEPTION CENTRE, 607 WERE RESETTLED IN GOVERNMENT LANDS AT MUTURA 3223 AND KANAMA 2712. LACK OF IOM TRANSPORT, WHICH HAS YET TO RETURN FROM KIBEHO/BUTARE AND THE SHORTAGE OF GOVERNMENT LAND FOR RESETTLEMENT HAS SLOWED DOWN THE RESETTLEMENT PROCESS TO A CONSIDERABLE EXTENT. THIS IS NOT DESIRABLE, CONSIDERING THE VOLATILE NATURE OF THESE PEOPLE. IN RUHENGERI PREFECTURE, THE AREAS AROUND KINIGI 5540 TO INCLUDE GIFUMBA 5243, NYARUGINA 4938 AND KABWENDE 5342 HAVE BEEN EARMARKED FOR RESETTLEMENT.
