DOMINICA - Housing Sector Plan 1977-1982

1. The Premier of Dominica, Mr. Patrick John and two cabinet ministers met with Mr. Maluko on 16 June. Discussion centres mainly on CHBP inputs to a new project - DMI/76/002 for which CDPPP will be the executing agency. The project includes a Physical Planning Expert for 3 years and provision for 15 mm of consultant services.
2. The Premier informally gave us the attached copy of the Housing Sector Plan 1977-1982. We would appreciate your review and comments on this plan with particular emphasis on the potential consultant inputs by CHBP.

Sir,

This will acknowledge the receipt of your cable of 11 September concerning a proposed pilot demonstration project for low-income housing, slum improvement and clearance within the Roseau area, for which we understand your Government may require the technical assistance of the United Nations.

We are pleased that your Government is proposing to undertake this project, which would undoubtedly be of great benefit to the people in your country through an improved environment. We should also be pleased to assist your Government in the technical development of this project and to discuss this possibility with Mr. Joseph, Chief Technical Officer in your Ministry, as you have suggested, following its approval by the United Nations Development Programme.

Procedurally, the formal request for any assistance should be made by your Government through the Officer-in-Charge of the United Nations Development Programme, Mr. Toshiyuki Nima, P.O. Box 726, Georgetown, Guyana. Any final approval would depend upon a number of factors, including the availability of unassigned technical assistance funds in the Caribbean Undistributed Indicative Planning Figure for Country and Inter-country Programming of the UNDP technical assistance programme.

I would suggest, therefore, if your Government wishes to explore this possibility, that the appropriate ministry in Dominica should communicate directly with the UNDP Officer-in-Charge in Guyana, who has responsibility for assistance to your nation.
