SUBJECT: French Political Mission

1. The Deputy Permanent Representative of France has confirmed today the request made through your common liaison channels for UNAMIR's assistance and support for the high-level French political mission due to arrive in Rwanda tomorrow at 0710 hrs via aircraft GLAM Falcon 50 COTAM 0006.
2. He has confirmed that the officials arriving are as follows:
- a) Mr. Bertrand DUFOURCO, Secretary-General of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs;
 - b) General GERMANOS, Deputy COS of the Army;
 - c) Mme. Catherine BOIVINEAU, Deputy Director, Central and East Africa, Ministry of Foreign Affairs;
 - d) Two communications technicians; and
 - e) 1 army officer.
3. Arrangements to meet with members of the Transitional Government of National Unity have already been conveyed to you; however, they would like confirmation that appointments have been made with the President of the Republic, the Prime Minister, the Deputy Prime Minister, as well as yourself and the Force Commander.
4. The Deputy Permanent Representative recalled that the French Government was counting on UNAMIR's providing transport and security. Please confirm all of the above as soon as possible. Best regards.

1. You will recall that paragraph 15 of resolution 912 (1994) invites the Secretary-General to report fully to the Security Council on the evolution of the situation in Rwanda within 15 days, i.e. by 6 May 1994.

2. We would, therefore, be grateful if you could send us, by 9:00 a.m. on Monday, 2 May (New York time) a draft covering the main developments since the last report on 20 April. The report need not be very long, but it should cover the activities undertaken by UNAMIR to fulfil the mandate described in paragraph 8 of resolution 912 (1994), including the Arusha meeting, the reduction of the UNAMIR force level and the military situation. It should also cover your efforts on the humanitarian side, including your efforts to ensure the safety and security of the civilians who have sought refuge with UNAMIR.

An initial list of United Nations military observers who are now in Mulindi is herewith attached. They will cross the border as soon as permission is granted by the Ugandan authorities. We would appreciate your Government's coordination with UNOMUR in Kabale through the usual channels.
